DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION was established by the CITY OF MOBILE to serve as an advisory board for the planning, direction and coordination of the development of downtown Mobile; and

WHEREAS, the MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION is granted one appointment to the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, with the two members of the COUNTY COMMISSION not serving as the County Appointee serving as Ex-Officio (non-voting) members of the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION; and

WHEREAS, the work of the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION is of vital interest to the MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION and the COMMISSION has, therefore, determined that the individual serving as the PRESIDENT of the COUNTY COMMISSION should serve as the COUNTY's representative on the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION; and

WHEREAS, the MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION's appointment to the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION is now open;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION hereby designates the MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION PRESIDENT to serve as its Appointee on the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.

2. The MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION further designates that, as the Presidency of the COMMISSION is rotated among the three Commissioners, the COUNTY's appointee on the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION shall rotate in synchronization so that the COMMISSIONER serving as the PRESIDENT OF THE COMMISSION shall also serve as the COUNTY's appointee on the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, with the two remaining COMMISSIONERS serving as Ex-Officio members of the MOBILE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.
