CORPORATION OF MOBILE COUNTY

A nonprofit public corporation organized pursuant to the provisions of Code of Alabama, Section 11-97-1, et seq. The determining subdivision for this corporation, within the meaning of Code of Alabama, Section 11-97-2(8) is Mobile County. The governing body of Mobile County is the Mobile County Commission.

The period for the duration of this corporation is perpetual, subject to the provisions of Code of Alabama, Section 11-97-23.

Mobile County Commission adopted a resolution authorizing formation of corporation at its regular scheduled meeting held June 12, 1995, for the purpose of utility services to the citizens of Mobile County.

The term of office of each director shall be six (6) years. If at any time there should be a vacancy on the board, a successor director to serve for the unexpired term applicable to such vacancy shall be elected by the Mobile County Commission. If the term of office being served by any director shall expire prior to the election of such director for a new term or prior to the election of his successor by the Mobile County Commission, such director shall continue to serve until his successor is elected and qualified, and if such director is elected for a new term after the expiration of the immediately preceding term which he has been serving, his new term of office shall be deemed to have commenced as of the expiration of such immediately preceding term.
