

MOBILE COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER ADVISORY BOARD

Resolution adopted February 13, 2013

Established:

The Mobile County Commission created the Mobile County Animal Shelter Advisory Board by resolution adopted February 13, 2013.

Purpose:

To monitor shelter policies and practices and recommend best practices to meet legal obligations related to animals and animal control and the delivery of shelter services, and to act as a liaison between the County, rescue groups and the public.

Board Appointments:

The Board consist of seven (7) members which are as follows:

- Three (3) members appointed by the Mobile County Commission which each Commissioner to recommend a member;
- The president of the Mobile County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals;
- The director of the Mobile County Health Department or his designee;
- The Sheriff of Mobile County or a law enforcement officer designated by the Sheriff; and
- A practicing veterinarian licensed by the Alabama State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, then serving as a Mobile County Animal Shelter Medical Officer.

Indefinitely.
