**MOBILE COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AUTHORITY**

(MCC adopted Resolution on May 28, 1984)

**Established:**

Public Law 920 - 81<sup>st</sup> Congress created a Federal Civil Defense Program. This Act is cited as the Federal Civil Defense Act of 1950. Alabama Civil Defense Act was created by the Alabama Civil Defense Act of 1951. Act No. 14, Special Session of the Legislature of Alabama made it mandatory for each political subdivision of the State of Alabama to establish a Civil Defense Agency.

**Purpose:**

The Emergency Management Agency is divided into three levels of government; federal, state and local. Mobile County Emergency Management is the local level of this operation. Congress mandated the President, in the Federal Civil Defense Act, to work in partnership with the State and local governments to help preserve life and property from all major disasters.

**Members:**

One person to be appointed by resolution adopted by the governing bodies of: Mobile County, City of Mobile, Town of Satsuma, City of Prichard, City of Saraland, City of Chickasaw, Town of Mount Vernon, City of Citronelle, City of Bayou La Batre and the Town of Creola. Each said member shall have one vote on all matters except, however, the Mobile County member and the City of Mobile member shall have five votes each.
