

SENIOR COMPANION PROGRAM OF MOBILE COUNTY
ADVISORY COUNCIL

Established:

The name of the organization shall be: The Senior Companion Program of Mobile County Advisory Council an initiative of the Corporation for National and Community Services (CNCS) and sponsored by the Mobile County Commission. The Advisory Council will govern its affairs according to the By-Laws approved March 16, 2017.

The Mobile County Commission authorized the creation of the Advisory Council of the Senior Companion Program of Mobile County by appointing its members in the October 14, 1980 Minutes.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Advisory Council is to assist and advise the Senior Companion Program (SCP) sponsor and SCP staff on matters concerning planning, community support, project policies and operational issues; and participate in the evaluation of the program's effectiveness in meeting performance measures provided for in the approved grant application. The Advisory Council will help to promote better public understanding of the Senior Companion Program goals and objectives.

Membership:

The Advisory Council shall have a membership that includes persons knowledgeable of human and social needs of the community; competent in the field of community service and volunteerism; capable of helping the sponsor meet administrative and program responsibilities, including project assessment and data reporting requirements; with interest in and knowledge of the capability of older adults.

The Advisory Council shall be composed of a minimum of twelve (12) members but not more than eighteen (18) members who represent the population of the area served and the senior volunteers. One-fourth (1/4) of the membership must be fifty-five (55) or older, and some of these shall be volunteers in the SCP.

Members of the Board of Directors appointed by the Mobile County Commission may attend and participate in Advisory Council meeting, but will not have voting privileges.
