This means if someone is staying the night with you they are still considered a visitor. The people you checked in with, including yourself are the only ones allowed to use the pool.

**All children are to be supervised by an adult at ALL times while inside the fenced area of the pool and inside the pool.**

This means any unsupervised child found alone inside this area will no longer be allowed to use the pool. Remember, we do not have any life guards on duty and we are not responsible for your child.

**A wristband MUST be worn by ALL PERSONS INSIDE the FENCED IN POOL AREA and SWIMMING POOL.**

A paper color wristband for each day are available at the office for Campers and Cabin Renters Only.
