MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Monday, December 14, 2015, at 10:00 A. M. The following members of the Commission were present: Jerry L. Carl, President, Merceria Ludgood and Connie Hudson, Members. Also present were John F. Pafenbach, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and Joe W. Ruffer, County Engineer. President Carl chaired the meeting.

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INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Commissioner Merceria Ludgood, District 1.

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**License Commissioner Nick Matranga:** Good morning, Commissioners.

**Commission President Jerry L. Carl:** Good morning, Commissioner.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** Good morning.

**Commissioner Merceria Ludgood:** Good morning.

**License Commissioner Matranga:** Commissioners, the three principle attributes of my appointment were due to my education, my experience as a Commanding Officer of over 1,400 Marines and my expertise with major airline operations. Commissioners, I can see a flawed system when it is in front of me. The professional services agreement between the Mobile County Commission and APL Software provides for input of the Mobile County License Commissioner with reference to the contractor's performance, capabilities, and value. The persistent problems with APL remain valid, as reported in a collection of historical Public Examiners' reports and independent analysis. There remains a single programmer who controls all aspects of the licensing system without a backup, no simulation capability, persistent manipulation of the system to correct errors, high cost, unplanned budget expenditures, customer and staff aggravation and excess clerical time wasted. It is our duty as public officials to be good stewards of taxpayers' money while pursuing the most efficient service for the taxpayers. This is why I am requesting the Commission to terminate the contract with APL. Should the Commission not pass Agenda Items #23 and #24 then the citizens of Mobile County will continue to pay

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APL an average of \$46,000.00 per month instead of \$11,000.00 per month for a superior system. I thank you for your attention, and if you have further questions that I have not addressed at the conference, Mr. Hays and I will be glad to answer them.

**Commission President Carl:** Did you receive my list of questions that I emailed to you on Friday?

**License Commissioner Matranga:** No, sir.

**Commission President Carl:** Jay, did you receive the list of questions I emailed on Friday? You were cc'd [copied] on it.

**County Attorney Jay Ross:** No.

**Commission President Carl:** Okay, my fault.

**License Commissioner Matranga:** Any questions, sir? Would you like to hear a quick rundown on Ingenuity?

**Commission President Carl:** I apologize for not returning your call on Friday.

**License Commissioner Matranga:** That's okay, I understand.

**County Attorney Jay Ross:** Commissioner, I don't reflect that email, sir.

**Commissioner President Carl:** Okay.

**License Commissioner Matranga:** Thank you, Commissioners, I appreciate it.

**Commission President Carl:** Thank you.

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**Angela Goudreault, Resident, Grand Farms Subdivision, Grand Bay, Alabama:** Good morning, I'm back about dirt roads again. Since our last meeting, I did more research. Thanks to Mr. Ruffer's comment on vacating, he suggested vacating the public right-of-way for the road to help alleviate the problem during our last public meeting. At this time, I would like to file a formal complaint and deny that action from being unable to happen. The reason for this is it is my belief that Mobile County Commission and Mobile County Public Works/Engineering Department have denied the residents of Grand Farms Road West, road maintenance, since 1975. Within the purchase contract, there is mentioned a 60 feet roadway dedicated to Mobile County for maintenance, and there will be no release of the property until such action is completed. Well, obviously,

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there's been the release of sales which lead me to believe that is what's happened. Also, it is my belief that Grand Farms Road West is and has been a public County road since the establishment of the first addition of Grand Farms Subdivision recorded in 1979. This belief is supported by the purchase contract of 1975; the resolution made by the Mobile County Commission of the vacation of a right-of-way of a public street within the subdivision in 1993 in accordance with the Alabama Code Section 23-4-20. The action of the Mobile County Attorney and Public Works Department made public statements that the streets of the Grand Farms Subdivision are public. In 1993, when the Mobile County Commission acted in accordance with the Alabama Code Section 23-4-20 procedure that in itself, I believe set a precedent of the Mobile County Commission having jurisdiction over the roads within the Grand Farms Subdivision. We are demanding that the Mobile County Commission honor the dedication of the roads and begin road maintenance immediately upon Grand Farms Road West and the streets of Grand Farms Subdivision. I have a copy of the declaration and resolution that were done in 1993, where it shows the County has jurisdiction over those roads in the subdivision. I have a copy of the lien holders' agreement where there was supposed to be a satisfaction of a 60 foot road dedicated to the County before the roads were released for sale. What do I do next because it does not tell you in the statute?

**Commission President Carl:** I truly don't know.

**Ms. Goudreault:** The Alabama Code Section 6-5-20, that's all I got on how to file a formal complaint, and I believe y'all have 90 days to come back with an answer.

**Commission President Carl:** Okay.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** Mr. Ross would you prepare a response to that and in the meantime brief the Commissioners on what the status is in terms of the County's obligation.

**County Attorney Jay Ross:** We will do that and certainly well within the 90 days.

**Ms. Goudreault:** Do I give y'all a copy of this?

**Commissioner President Carl:** You can give Kelle a copy if you have a copy.

**Commissioner Hudson:** You can give it to Mr. Pafenbach, too.

**Commission President Carl:** Angela, that's not your only copy is it? That's not your only copy, right?

**Ms. Goudreault:** No.

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**Commission President Carl:** Okay.

**Ms. Goudreault:** I have copies of the maps and some other papers, but like I said I was having problems with my printer, and I've been really busy taking care of my father-in-law. If y'all have a copier, I will be glad for y'all to make copies.

**Commission President Carl:** Mr. Ross, can we get back to her before the next Commission meeting with a response.

**County Attorney Ross:** Actually, we will sit down and go over all that, and Ms. Baker will be happy to make copies for Ms. Goudreault if that would be a benefit after the meeting.

**Ms. Goudreault:** Thank y'all so much.

**Commission President Carl:** Thank you and Merry Christmas.

**Ms. Goudreault:** Merry Christmas to y'all.

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**Commission President Carl:** Jay did I read this right, you did find those notes?

**County Attorney Jay Ross:** Commissioner, Martha sent me a copy of it, so I did see it on Saturday, yes sir.

**Commission President Carl:** Okay, and you did receive the questions?

**County Attorney Ross:** It does show the questions. It was copied to me in your email to License Commissioner Matranga.

**Commission President Carl:** Okay, all right.
