- 3) APPROVE right-of-way and/or easement agreements for:
 - Tract 11, in the amount of \$250.00
 - Tract 12, in the amount of \$250.00

for Project MCR-2020-305, Holly Point Drive South, Sheffield Road and Wilson Road - Grade, Drain, Base, and Pave (GDBP).

- 4) APPROVE preliminary and final plat of Resubdivision of All of Lot 1, Eliza Jordan Corner. (2 lots, Airport Boulevard at Eliza Jordan Road South, District 3)

AND

preliminary and final plat of Grelot Oaks. (13 lots, Grelot Road at Dawes Road, District 3)

- 5) APPROVE annual contract renewal with Earl Dudley, Inc. for a one-year subscription for the iNet Service for the period from September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2023 for the Engineering and Public Works Department, in the amount of \$1,200.00.

- 6) ACCEPT the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Offer and Agreement, Project CCP-003-20/AIP Grant No. 3-01-0023-021-2022 for the Jeremiah A. Denton Airport and authorize the designated official/representative of the Mobile County Commission to execute the Grant Offer and Acceptance. This agreement covers the 90% federal funds reimbursement for the costs related to the design to improve Safety Area for Runway 12/30 (Reconstruction of Seawall Bulkhead) for the airport with a maximum obligation of \$201,288.00.

- 7) ACCEPT a drainage easement between McGehee Road and Alabama State Highway 188. This 20 foot drainage easement is adjacent to, and allows easier access to, a 30 foot drainage easement that Mobile County currently maintains.
