The budget modification affects the funds budgeted from TIG. The construction costs increased by \$3,884,081.00, which are necessary to complete the project.

In the December 28, 2020 Mobile County Commission Minutes, Agenda Item #29, the Commission authorized the acceptance of a grant from the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the Bayfront Park Restoration and Improvement Project (Phases IIA and IIB) in the amount of \$4,648,304.00.

- 26) APPROVE Agreement for Relocation of Utility Facilities in Conflict with Proposed Roadway Improvements with South Alabama Utilities (SAU), for Project MCR-2018-204, McDavid Road - Grade, Drain, Base, and Pave (GDBP).
