- 3) project agreement among Mobile County, City APPROVE of Mobile, and Airbus Americas, Inc., whereby the County and City will each contribute up to \$10,000,000.00 for leasing, developing, constructing, and equipping a new facility for the expansion of A320 Aircraft production located at 320 Airbus Way at Brookley Aeroplex and for workforce training developed to specifically target residents of Mobile County, and to authorize the Commission President to sign all necessary documents associated with the project agreement.
