MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Randall Dueitt, president, Merceria Ludgood and Connie Hudson, members. Also present were E. Edwin Kerr, deputy county administrator, Jay Ross, county attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, county engineer. President Dueitt chaired the meeting.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Good morning, everyone. Welcome to the October 10, 2023, regular meeting of the Mobile County Commission. I hope everyone had a great long weekend. This morning we have Chaplain James Lyons from the Mobile County Sheriff's Office to do the invocation. Everyone, please remain standing afterward for the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain James Lyons, Mobile County Sheriff's Office, 510 South Royal Street, Mobile, Alabama.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: We have a few resolutions this morning, but before we present those, Evelyn DeAngelo is here from Love Your Community with announcements and presentations.

Evelyn DeAngelo, project coordinator, Love Your
Community: Good morning. Again, my name is Evelyn DeAngelo.
I am with Love Your Community. We are a project and grant funding program that helps support citizens in our community throughout Mobile County to encourage them to participate in helping us with litter abatement and sustainability programming in their communities. We are very excited, and we have been recruiting new teams. We voted for new teams in September 2023. It was a very hot summer, and our littering program was a little slow, but coming into fall, we have a lot of momentum. Today we want to honor three of our Love Your Community teams that have submitted over 150 volunteer hours. A lot of our volunteers, committed to picking up litter in the

community, are already partnering with some of our local nonprofits. Today, the volunteers who have acquired the hours are dedicating their funds and partnering with nonprofits for their projects. I want to speak individually about each project. The first project is Revitalizing the Dauphin Island Parkway (DIP). On their project, they will receive \$1,500.00 towards renovations on a pocket park at 3100 Dauphin Island Parkway, Mobile, Alabama, 36605, near the CVS on Dauphin Island Parkway. Some of their community events and fundraisers are held there throughout the year. This pocket park will have beautiful landscaping visible on the parkway. The website is revitalizeDIP.org, and we will be working on that project. Do you want me to call the representatives up one at a time or together?

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: Go ahead and tell us about all the projects, and we will take pictures.

Evelyn DeAngelo: Our second project is the Peninsula of Mobile. This volunteer group has been working hard in the Dauphin Island Parkway area and throughout the southern part of Mobile. They are working towards a project with some new Blue Way and Green Way signage that will be placed in the area to help encourage visitors and locals to get out and enjoy the community and have more education. It will also include a mural featuring native birds in our area, so it will be exciting to see a beautiful mural available in our community. The third project is Dog River Clearwater Revival. Our volunteers submitted 700 hours this year, so we are very proud of the team at Dog River Clearwater Revival. They are using their \$1,500.00 to purchase Eagle Reefs. Eagle Reefs are small reefs put under docks, boardwalks, and other areas to help attract fish, oysters, and shrimp. The Eagle Reef helps with water quality and makes the surrounding areas look nicer. The Eagle Reef will be in the Dog River Watershed. We are proud of our organizations and our teams. Like I said today, we represent over 1,000 volunteer hours between these three organizations and will present more throughout the remainder of the year. Last week we also presented at the Chickasaw City Council Meeting, Beautify Chickasaw, a volunteer citizen-based group working in Chickasaw. They received their check last week, so we are proud of our volunteers helping pick up litter and work on sustainability projects throughout our community.

Commissioner Hudson: Thank you all for being here today. It is always exciting to hear about these projects. It is a winning program because we are not only abating litter but helping beautify our community. These projects are increasing sustainability, environmental awareness, and beautification. I am thrilled to hear that over 1,000 hours

were performed by these groups and Beautify Chickasaw. I think that it is amazing. Evelyn, you do a great job. I see Diane is here today with Keep Mobile Beautiful. I know you are working in conjunction with them. Thank you for all you do to keep Mobile beautiful and for your partnership in these groups. They are just amazing, and we love you guys. Keep up the good work.

Evelyn DeAngelo: We appreciate the support; we do. I want to invite a representative from each of the organizations to come forth, and we will individually present you all with this large check that you cannot take to the bank, but we will get you a real check to take to the bank. We will do a photo with the Commissioners. Also, in November, we celebrate National Recycling Day. We will partner with Keep Mobile Beautiful and Ransom Ministries at the Archbishop Lipscomb Stadium. We will be hosting a Paper Shredding and Electronics Recycling Day. We will have several clean-ups going on with small groups around the community. On November 11, 2023, Veteran's Day weekend, we will celebrate National Recycling Day. Thank you.

President Dueitt: Thank you to all the groups for your hours of working in our community. None of this would be possible without Commissioner Hudson. She is the one who initiated this and brought it to the Commission, although we all support it. If it was not for her, none of this would be happening, so thank you, guys, and thank you to Dr. Timothy E. Hughes, who is here today. I asked him to come this morning and introduce himself to the Commission. I will introduce him briefly. Dr. Hughes is on Agenda Item #18. He will replace Dr. Stephen E. Bowen on the Communication Board of Mobile County, for the remainder of his term. Dr. Bowen had to resign because of health problems with his wife. Tim is here, and I could go through a whole litany of things about Tim, but I will let him do that himself. As you can see, besides being a doctor and active member of our community, he is also very active with the Sheriff's Office as a surgeon. Tim, go ahead and introduce yourself.

Dr. Timothy E. Hughes, MD, Mobile County Sheriff's Office: Thank you, Commissioner. My entire life beyond high school has involved some public safety and defense components. I graduated from Alabama Fire College and worked for the Birmingham Fire and Rescue Service Department for seven years. I finished college, went to paramedic school at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) through the fire department, and worked in fire

services. I moved to Mobile, Alabama, and attended the University of South Alabama College of Medicine. I left there and went to the University of Wisconsin for my residency training. I moved back to Mobile, Alabama, and served 14 years as a Senior Flight Surgeon in the Air Force. I finished out at Keesler Airforce Base and several other posts during my career with the Air Force. I have been a surgeon with the Sheriff's Office for about 14 years. I am assigned to Special Operations in Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT). I handle all the medical affairs for the Sheriff, but also deploy with the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team and Special Operations to make sure our deputies are safe and out of harm's way. Fortunately, knock on wood, we have done a good job with that. I also work about 10 shifts a month in Urgent Care and Emergency Medicine. I have a lot on my plate, but I enjoy staying busy. I like to work on my tree farm and hunt deer.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: I think he has
more hours in his days.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: He has time to deer hunt.

District 1 Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: Did you say you work in the Emergency Room (ER)?

Dr. Hughes: Yes, ma'am.

President Dueitt: Are you still involved with Greater
Mobile Urgent Care?

Dr. Hughes: Correct.

President Dueitt: The Sheriff's Office is volunteer
work. You have a real job, too.

Dr. Hughes: I am a contract worker for the Sheriff's Office, but if you saw my check, you would know I do not do it for the money.

President Dueitt: It is not like one of those big checks we just gave out that you cannot take to the bank.

Dr. Hughes: I do it as a passion. I do what I can to take care of our deputies.

Commissioner Hudson: It is a pleasure to meet you, Dr. Hughes, and I thank you so much for your service to the community.

President Dueitt: Thank you for being here.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: We have the two resolutions. The first is for Breast Cancer Awareness. The Mobile County Health Department will present to Dr. Stephanie Woods Crawford, the executive director for prevention and wellness. Next, we have the National Domestic Violence Awareness Month from the Penelope House. Tonie Ann Torrans is the executive director.

PRESENT RESOLUTION/BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH/OCTOBER 2023

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the second most diagnosed form of cancer for women in the United States and remains a leading cause of cancer deaths among American women; and

WHEREAS, early detection and improved treatment are believed to have significantly reduced the number of deaths caused by breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, researchers, scientists, and numerous nonprofit organizations are dedicated to discovering a cure for breast cancer. During the month of October, we acknowledge the extraordinary commitment and effort invested in this cause; and

WHEREAS, during National Breast Cancer Awareness
Month, we stand with other agencies, such as the Mobile
County Health Department, USA Health Mitchell Cancer
Institute, the Breast Center at Mobile Infirmary, and
Franklin Primary Health, whose care and hard work give hope
to those fighting this battle; and

WHEREAS, in observance of National Breast Cancer Awareness, special celebrations are planned throughout the month, including Family Health, the primary care division of the Mobile County Health Department, which provides breast screenings daily at all its locations. Also, as a long-time participant in the Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program, Family Health provides free breast and cervical cancer screenings for women who meet eligibility guidelines;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Mobile County Commission proclaims October 2023, as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Mobile County, Alabama. Furthermore, we extend our deepest respect for survivors and those who advocate for prevention and a cure.

Dr. Stephanie Woods Crawford, executive director of prevention and wellness, Mobile County Health Department:
As a breast cancer survivor, early detection is the key for us survivors. We continue to spread the knowledge and awareness of breast cancer. Family Health has been a long-time partner in the Mobile County Health Department with the Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program. We will continue to provide services and support throughout our community.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: Thank you for being here.

PRESENT RESOLUTION/NATIONAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, once a secret kept in families, domestic violence is recognized as a serious crime, one that has severe consequences for the survivors, their children, their employers, and the community; and

WHEREAS, the problems of domestic violence are not confined to any group or groups of people but cut across all economic, racial, and societal barriers and are supported by societal indifferences; and

WHEREAS, the impact of domestic violence is wide-ranging, directly affecting individuals, families, and neighborhoods in this community, throughout the United States and abroad; and

WHEREAS, one in four women and one in seven men aged 18 and older in the United States have been the victim of severe physical violence by an intimate partner in their lifetime; and

WHEREAS, stopping the cycle of this vicious crime requires not only the resolve and courage of survivors but also the support and involvement of all of us;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED in recognition of Penelope House and its 44 years of service in our community; the Mobile County Commission proclaims October 2023 as National Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Mobile County, Alabama. Furthermore, we urge all residents to actively partner with Mobile County, Penelope House, and the Domestic Violence Task Force to create a community where people thrive in safe and healthy relationships.

Tonie Ann Torrans, executive director, Penelope House: Dana Polk is the Board president. I want her to be a member of the District Attorney's Office and the Sheriff's Office because domestic violence is such a problem and affects everyone in our society. It takes all of us to address domestic violence when the problem is active, and we arrest people in the community. We are at justice in the system and providing services for the victims. It spills over to your coworkers, classmates, and everyone else, so we all need to be aware and ask people. Thank you for this.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Sharee, do we have any speakers?

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: Yes, sir, we have three speakers this morning. We have Danny Corte with Mobile Sports Authority, Inc., who would like to give an update. Two speakers want to speak about Agenda Item #53, the Creel Road Apartments. Danny Corte, would you come up? Each one has been informed that they have five minutes to speak. I will let them know when their time is almost up.

President Dueitt: I want to remind all speakers to state their name and address when they come to the microphone.

Danny Corte, executive director, Mobile Sports Authority, Inc.: Good morning, Commissioners. There is a lot of good news going on. Hopefully, I can add to it. Again, I am Danny Corte with Mobile Sports Authority, Inc. I want to update you about our Fiscal Year 2023 results, but before that, I want to tell you how much we appreciate the County Commission's support. We believe the investment turns into more dollars for the community, and hopefully, these numbers will illustrate that. Our recently completed Fiscal Year 2023, runs concurrently with the city and county. October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, the Mobile Sports Authority, Inc. attracted, hosted, and supported 39 sports events, which generated an estimated \$31,000,000.00 in economic impact to the Mobile, Alabama area. That is a brand-new annual record, smashing the old record by over 20 percent from Fiscal Year 2016. Again, that goes back to the investment the county and the city have made in us; otherwise, I do not know what I would be doing. I would be selling cars or something. Those 39 events involved 19 different sports, such as basketball, gymnastics, volleyball, baseball, track and field, wrestling, football, soccer, and even the world turkey calling championship, to name a few. To show the growth

over the last five years, the Mobile Sports Authority, Inc. has hosted an average of 32 sports events compared to 39 this year. Again, that is a 20 percent increase in the number of events and 15 of the 39 events. I know I am throwing a lot of numbers at you, and I apologize. Of the 39 events from this past fiscal year, 15 of those were either first or second-time events for Mobile, and 24 of those 39 were youth-oriented, which we define as anywhere from ages 4 through 19. We really like to go after youth events because they bring mom, dad, and sometimes grandparents, siblings, and friends. They create more of an economic impact, which we would always be going after. As a brief recap, this past weekend was our largest event that we host on an annual basis. Saturday was the 6th Annual Gulf Coast Challenge powered by the Mobile Sports Authority, Inc., which featured the Alabama A&M Bulldogs hosting the Jackson State Tigers at Ladd Stadium. An estimated 19,000 people were at this event. We do not have all the final numbers and how many visitors will come over the next 30 days, but we were happy with the turnout, and the weather was great. It was a great week for fans, and we had a College and Career Fair for our local students, several free concerts, a team luncheon, a traditional Mardi Gras-style parade, and game day and tailgating at Ladd Stadium. The game itself was won by Jackson State 45 to 30. For the previous five Gulf Coast Challenge games, we estimated that 47,000 visitors came through Mobile, which generated an estimated economic impact of about \$27,000,000.00 into our local economy, so this year, we are excited to be adding the Port City Classic to our calendar. That will take place November 4, 2023, at Ladd Stadium, with Alabama State hosting Grambling. We are adding a second Historical Black College and University (HBCU) game to the calendar. We are looking for another good crowd because both universities have strong alumni support. In addition to those two games, we already have 22 more sports confirmed for Fiscal Year 2024, including hosting the Alabama High School Athletic Association State Bowling Tournament for the first time, which we just announced last week. We hope to have more added events during the year. Your investment in us has made that possible as we market our unique area to those attending regional and national events. Business owners, as well, help to create and support our homegrown events. Thank you again for your support, and please feel free to contact us if you have any questions. Thank you so much for your time.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: That is all great news. Thank you, Danny.

President Dueitt: Thank you, Danny. You would starve
to death as a car salesman.

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: The next two speakers, Sharon Faile and Faye Smith, are here to address the Commission about Agenda Item #53, the final plat of Creel Wood Apartments. They have a letter that they made a copy of for the Commissioners. Sharon said she would be sending a video that I would send to you all as well.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: I think Matthew Barclift gave us a copy.

Public Affairs Director Broussard: Okay, very good. Five minutes, thank you.

Sharon Faile, 12800 Creel Road, Grand Bay, Alabama 36541: After being informed of the Commissioners' Meeting today, October 10, 2023, I came to review and discuss some of my concerns about the area. Number one, any multi-family dwelling or complex will decrease the value of the already established single-family dwellings. Number two, access to Creel Road from Grand Bay Wilmer Road, is situated between two businesses: a truck stop, which has several businesses, and an Amazon pick-up area. All these establishments have a continual flow of incoming and outgoing traffic. Several eating establishments and businesses on Grand Bay Wilmer Road are adjacent to these busy establishments. In conjunction with this, access to and from Interstate 10 at Exit 4 is only a few yards from the Creel Road access. The amount of incoming and outgoing traffic generated by additional vehicles is not feasible and increases the wreck potential at this site. When Interstate 10 is backed up or an evacuation is suggested or recommended, Grand Bay Wilmer Road at Exit 4 is frequently used. Number three, the addition of a large septic system being installed and residents using well water would potentially affect the quality of the drinking water. If the water quality is affected and higher levels of contaminants are found, proven by a water quality study, who would be held accountable for providing the clean-up and restoring the levels to a safe level? After purchasing and moving into our property on Creel Road in 2021, we have witnessed the challenges of water drainage and flooding on Creel Road when we have heavy rainfall. This is particularly apparent at the curve located at Arby's fast-food restaurant. Removing the natural drainage contributed by the trees, with established vegetation and soil to accommodate parking for an apartment complex, would accentuate the flooding issue. Number five, since 2021, I have observed the numerous varieties of birds, many of which may be migratory, that feed in my yard but house themselves in local trees. These, plus bats, which frequent our area, help to keep the mosquito population in check. An environmental impact study addresses how adding an

apartment complex to this fragile balance should be considered, with my residence being in proximity to the plat under consideration. I am requesting that my name be added to the list of those notified of any decision made to this matter. I appreciate the opportunity to present my initial concerns over the Creel Road Apartments proposal. I strongly oppose the approval of the plat submittal as given in the notice sent to the adjoining property owners on September 25, 2023. Thank you very much for your time.

Public Affairs Director Broussard: We also have Faye Smith to address the same issue.

Faye Smith 12750 Creel Road, Grand Bay, Alabama 36541: Good morning to all of you. For 40 something years, I have seen a lot of things happen in our area. We have several problems; one is the water problem when it rains. I am concerned about the apartments because our area has a traffic problem. One of the main problems is trying to get on Grand Bay Wilmer Road. I had to wait 10 minutes this morning to get to Grand Bay Wilmer Road because of the traffic. Our area has two school zones, one on Grand Bay Wilmer Road and another from the First Baptist Church. We have a truck stop across the road where trucks are coming in, trying to get on Grand Bay Wilmer Road. McDonald's customers are trying to get on the Grand Bay Wilmer Road and a Waffle House, Shell Gas Station, Subway Station, and a church on Creel Road. It is a massive problem, and I think it will get worse. We are concerned about the apartments coming in with the sewage, and I disapprove of it. We were just notified and did not have enough time to present ourselves. I took a video this morning at 7:00 a.m., and it took me 10 minutes to get from Creel Road to Grand Bay Wilmer Road. It is just not feasible to have more apartments. Thank you for your time.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Thank you. Matthew, if you do not mind, please come up. Correct me if I am wrong, but I think we are approving a subdivision of the property. It is called the Creel Road Apartments, but they have not submitted any plans for that property, just a subdivision.

Engineering Development Manager Matthew Barclift: That is correct, Commissioner. At this point, dividing the property is just a preliminary and final plat. We have not

received any plans for an apartment complex on that property yet.

President Dueitt: I think you guys have already been notified of what is going on and would like to know in the future when plans are submitted and follow the process. I have said this many times, and Matthew can correct me if I am wrong, but once these plans are submitted, we follow the state law. We do not have zoning or home rules in Mobile County, so it is very difficult for us to deny anyone building anything in Mobile County. We make sure they follow the rules and law, whether a commercial site plan or a residential site plan, and we will gladly notify you guys. Matthew, if you do not mind, make sure we have their address to notify them. I think it is adjacent properties that we are required by law to notify you about, but if you are not on an adjacent property in that general area, I will make sure that we notify you for future plans.

Engineer Development Manager Barclift: Leave us your address, and we will make sure that when the plans are submitted, we notify you and get your input.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: I have a question, Matthew. Suppose this goes forward, and the plans are submitted for an apartment complex. Would there be any requirement that could be placed on the developer to do a traffic study to determine what might need to be done to alleviate traffic congestion?

Engineering Development Manager Barclift: Yes, ma'am. A requirement for a traffic study would be unprecedented. We did so on the Cottage Hill Road apartments, so I do not think requesting a traffic study and requiring them to make any improvements their development would generate would be unreasonable.

Commissioner Hudson: The developers would have to submit plans regarding the drainage issue and how they will contain and handle any runoff from their property. That would have to be deemed suitable by our engineers.

Engineering Development Manager Barclift: They would need to submit a plan that addresses any drainage increases generated by their development.

Public Works Director Richard M. Mitchell: The intersection at Grand Bay Wilmer Road and Creel Road is all within the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) right-a-way and the area that floods down in the curved areas. That is also maintained by the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT).

Thomas Smith, 12750 Creel Road, Grand Bay, Alabama 36541: Okay, I am kind of hard of hearing. I get what everybody is saying.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Sir, can you
please state your name?

Thomas Smith: My name is Thomas Smith. So, no plans have been submitted for an apartment complex?

President Dueitt: No plans have been submitted for an apartment complex. The only thing submitted at this time is a subdivision of the property. They have it under the Creel Road Apartment Complex name as a subdivision, but they have not submitted it. Am I correct, Matthew? An engineering firm has not submitted plans to the County to build an apartment complex. That is probably the next step once they get the subdivision. When they do that, they will notify you guys in that area. By law, Ricky Mitchell or Matthew Barclift, is it 10 days before the public hearing? You guys will be notified 10 days before we approve this action. Thank you, sir. If you have any other questions, Matthew will be glad to answer them for you. Matthew Barclift is our engineer, and he approves the site plans and the subdivisions for the County. Matthew, please give one of them my cell phone number, and I will gladly come out and meet with you. Thank you.

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: There are no more speakers, \sin .

Commission President Randall Dueitt: I do not see Glenn Hodge here, so Eddie Kerr, I guess you will run the show today.
