#### MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, October 24, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Connie Hudson, President, Randall Dueitt and Merceria Ludgood, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Martha Durant, Chief Staff Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

#### INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain Phillip Snodgrass, Mobile County Sheriff's Office.

President Connie Hudson: Thank you so much, Chaplain Phillip Snodgrass, Mobile County Sheriff's Office. It's always a pleasure to have you here. This morning, we have some retirees we would like to recognize. Then we have a resolution.

President Hudson: Yes. Please join us. We have a resolution recognizing Breast Cancer Awareness Month. I know you ladies in Mobile Infirmary work very hard with breast cancer and try to help the victims and those afflicted with it. All of us know somebody who is a family member, friend, or colleague who has had this fight. I have a very close friend right now in the middle of that, and it's very hard. Having an institution and people who understand, who help, and whatever they need, like holding hands as they go through treatment, means everything. We appreciate you.

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# PRESENT RESOLUTION/MOBILE COUNTY RECOGNIZES BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month; during this time, we stand with our mothers, daughters, sisters, and friends to recognize all those fighting their own battle with breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, while considerable progress has been made in the fight against breast cancer, it remains the most frequently diagnosed type of non-skin cancer; however, thanks to earlier detection and better treatments, mortality rates for breast cancer have steadily decreased in the last decade; and

WHEREAS, knowing what may contribute to breast cancer, symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment are important parts of its prevention; and having affordable access to screenings and early detection for all women is an essential component in the fight against breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, by educating ourselves and supporting innovative research, we will improve the quality of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED the Mobile County Commission proclaims October 2022 as:

in Mobile County. We applaud the vital role of advocates, researchers, and health care providers — including the American Cancer Society of Mobile, Cares Health and Wellness, Mobile Infirmary, Mitchell Cancer Institute, and Franklin Primary Health — whose care and hard work gives hope to those living with breast cancer. Furthermore, we encourage our fellow citizens to become aware of the impact that breast cancer has on our community and to support the fight against breast cancer so that we may one day defeat this terrible disease.

President Hudson: Keep up the good work, ladies. Thank you so much for all that you do.

President Connie Hudson: Sharee Broussard, Public Affairs Director, do we have anyone signed in to speak today?

Sharee Broussard, Public Affairs Director: Yes, ma'am. We have three (3) speakers signed in. Our first is from the Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office.

President Connie Hudson: If you would please give us your name and the names of those who are with you today.

Skandan Ananthasekar, Outreach Educator, Mobile County Health Department: My name is Skandan Ananthasekar, and I am the Outreach Educator with the Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office.

Sequayah Chaney, Outreach Educator, Mobile County Health Department: Sequayah Chaney and I am also an Outreach Educator with the Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office.

Sherita Anderson, Program Administrative Support Specialist, Mobile County Health Department: Good morning. My name is Sherita Anderson, and I am the Program Administrative Support Specialist with Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office.

Melissa McKnight, Senior Program Administrator, Mobile County Health Department: I am the newest addition to the Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office. My name is Melissa McKnight, and I am a Senior Program Administrator.

President Hudson: Thank you. Welcome.

Skandan Ananthasekar: Thank you. Our presentation is about the Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office. Our most recent event was an environmental cleanup event. We just wanted to make sure the County Commission is aware of the work we are doing and the existence of our office. The Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office was founded about a year and a half ago thanks to the funding of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) that came from the Alabama Department of Public Health. We do our work in targeted areas. These are areas that are underserved and have a high amount of social vulnerability and also low COVID-19 rates. These are four (4) areas in Mobile County comprised of fifteen (15) zip codes.

When we are talking about health equity, I think it is important to have a fair definition of what that exactly means. Health equity is achieved when everybody has the opportunity to be as healthy as possible. We give people these tools to be as healthy as possible. It is not about

what sickness you have or disease you have; we know there are a number of other factors at play, and we call them the Social Determinants of Health. These are where you live, where you work, how much income you have, the parks available to you, and the grocery stores available to you. A lot of these things are decided at the policy level to make sure people are as healthy as possible. When we talk about these different health disparities and why certain zip codes in certain areas have higher rates of diabetes, higher rates of cancer, or higher rates of different chronic diseases, it is important to start upstream at the policy level to make sure these people have all of the resources they need to be as healthy as possible. important thing to emphasize is that these health disparities are preventable if we work more at the upstream That is why our office is in existence. model.

We want to make sure Mobile County residents have the resources to be well, get well, and stay well. We do this in a number of ways. We are partnering with different organizations in the community to go to their events to pass out resources and educational materials. We do these in a targeted area to make sure the residents needing the most help are getting the most help. Our most recent event was an environmental cleanup day. The way health equity relates to environmental cleanup and waste is that a lot of trash and litter discarded in our streets, in our parks, and on our general grounds goes into our sewage and our waterways. It is affecting mostly disadvantaged people who rely on those waterways to make a source of living and as a source of diet. We organized an environmental cleanup with the Town of Mount Vernon and the MOWA Community. I will turn it over to Sherita Anderson, Program Administrative Support Specialist, Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office to speak a little more about the cleanup event.

Sherita Anderson: We partnered with the Internal Department of the Environmental Health Team and hosted our first Mobile County Health Department Cleanup Day on September 17, 2022. That day consisted of one hundred forty-four (144) volunteers from the Town of Mount Vernon joining the MOWA Community. We cleaned fifty-one (51) miles in four (4) hours, collecting three thousand two hundred fifty (3,250) pounds of trash. Our next focus is to look at waste and recycling so we can go out there again to do the same thing. We are very excited.

President Hudson: That is fantastic.

Skandan Ananthasekar: To wrap it up, I want to tell you about our future projects and what we are working on now. We are working with community partners to put together a mental health event. Our goal is to do a school tour. We have several schools already on board. The event

will be a talent show for the kids, plus a mental health fair for the kids and parents to get resources about mental health. As we all know, mental health issues were exacerbated due to the COVID-19 pandemic. People are still feeling the effects of mental health. The other big project we hope to present to the Mobile County Commission and Mobile City Council is declaring racism a public health crisis in the City of Mobile. At the Mobile County Health Department - Health Equity Office, we identify racism as one of the root causes of many of these health disparities and health inequities that lead people to have different health conditions. We want to work to make sure people are aware of this disparity, and we have items in hand to mitigate the effects of racism. Thank you for this opportunity. We look forward to working with you in the future.

President Hudson: Thank you so much for being here today. I gotta say you are a high-energy group. You have a lot going on. I think it's wonderful. It's great. I look forward to hearing more about all of your accomplishments and how you're reaching out to the community to help alleviate some of those disparities in getting the message out. Thank you for being here today.

Skandan Ananthasekar: Thank you.

Sharee Broussard, Public Affairs Director: Next, we have Joy Logan, who is the Director of Crittenton Youth Services.

President Connie Hudson: Good morning, Ms. Joy. I noticed you have a great-looking group of young people here, and you're going to tell us all about who they are, right?

Joy Logan, Director, Crittenton Youth Services: I am. We thank the three (3) of you for your support over the last many years. It has meant so much to us. It has enabled us to expand our program from sixth, seventh, and eighth grade into fifth grade. Charlotte Hill, Assistant Director, Crittenton Youth Services, is here with me, and together, our agency has existed for over one hundred (100) years. We are very thankful for all three (3) of you. For the first time in my life, I think I am nervous. Forgive me. Many times our program is labeled as a program that is so different because we deal with topics that are builders. When I say builders, they are builders for classroom behavior, classroom feelings, feelings in their environment, and different behaviors that occur in their environment.

We use our juniors and seniors from high school, and we train them to work with our students. I have to introduce them first. They are the main goal and the main part of our program. All of these students represent fourteen (14) high schools in Mobile County. Mobile County Public Schools, city schools, parochial schools, and private schools. They work very hard, and their communication with the students is outstanding. You can imagine when a young person walks in, and they are the ones who are working with the students. Thank you so much.

President Hudson: Let's give them a round of
applause. When they work with students, what exactly do
they do?

They are teaching emotional and social Joy Logan: skills. Many parents, grandparents, and teachers will say I do not understand why my child is not able to control their emotions, control their behaviors, have empathy for others, develop positive relationships with friends, and the list goes on. There are twelve (12) to fifteen (15) social and emotional skills that kids know. They have the knowledge, but it is very difficult for them to put them into action in everyday life. Our ambassadors not only talk about these skills, but they interact with the students, and the students interact with each other, so they get samples and examples of how this is done in real life. For example, just decision-making alone, they practice how you do it? What steps do you take? What are the goals that you finally want to reach? We think they are awfully wonderful.

President Hudson: I think so.

**Joy Logan:** Usually, we have anywhere from thirty-five (35) to forty (40) students representing public school programs.

President Hudson: It means so much to have a role model and someone to look up to. Especially someone that is not that much older and that isn't somebody that's not too far from their own age group and peer group. Somebody whom they can look up to as a role model and try to emulate. I think it's fantastic. I am so proud. I know I speak for the Commission, we are all proud of you and what you're doing in helping the younger people in the schools, the youth you're interacting with. It's so very important. Please keep up the good work. Thank you to Crittenton for sponsoring this.

Charlotte Hill, Assistant Director, Crittenton Youth Services: I just wanted to add that they are supervised in the classroom. We have instructors that go along with them just in case there is something they may not understand. We are there to help them. They are a great group of kids.

You hit it on the head when you say they relate so well with young people. They look forward to seeing our ambassadors. They develop relationships. They are like big brothers and big sisters to them. We are very proud of them. Thank you.

President Hudson: I appreciate you all being here
today. Thanks.

President Connie Hudson: Do we have any other
speakers today?

Sharee Broussard, Public Affairs Director: Yes, ma'am. One (1) more. Danny Corte with Mobile Sports Authority.

President Hudson: Okay. Good morning.

Danny Corte, Executive Director, Mobile Sports
Authority: Good morning, Madam President and Commissioners
Ludgood and Dueitt. It is another beautiful day in Mobile
County.

President Hudson: Amen to that.

Danny Corte: As a sports tourism for Mobile County and the City of Mobile, we are proud to represent the County and the City as we continue to work to bring those visiting sporting events to the Mobile area. We could not have achieved our recent successes without both of your investments and your blessings. I just want to say thank you so much for the confidence you have shown in us. What I wanted to do today is just give you a little update. Of course, we are in the same fiscal year as the City of Mobile and Mobile County. We just completed our Fiscal Year 2022.

As a summary to that, I want to let you know that the Mobile Sports Authority attracted, hosted, and supported thirty (30) sporting events over the last twelve (12) months, which generated an estimated fourteen million three hundred thousand dollars (\$14,300,000.00) economic impact to the Mobile area. That does not include our usually largest annual event, the Gulf Coast Challenge, because of an anomaly in the schedule. The last Gulf Coast Challenge was in September of the Fiscal Year 2021. The next one is coming up in a few weeks, which I will talk about in a few minutes. Those thirty (30) events involved twenty-two (22) different sports, such as basketball, gymnastics, volleyball, baseball, track and field, wrestling, football, soccer, and even a turkey calling championship, plus many others. As for another notable number, eight (8) of those

thirty (30) events held last fiscal year were either first or second-time events for us. Even more importantly, seventeen (17) of those thirty (30) events were what we call youth-oriented, and that means competitive, ranging from the ages of four (4) to nineteen (19) years old. That really is the gold standard in the sports event industry; the youth. They bring parents, grandparents, and siblings. Economically for us, they are always a lot better, but they are also sometimes tougher to get.

I mentioned the Gulf Coast Challenge. We are real excited about what is coming up in about two and one-half (2 1/2) weeks. Next month's Gulf Coast Challenge powered by the Mobile Sports Authority is our Fifth Annual Gulf Coast Challenge. Our future Football Coach Deion Sanders, otherwise known as Coach Prime, and his Jackson State Tigers will be hosting the Alabama A&M Bulldogs at Ladd-Peebles Stadium on Saturday, November 12, 2022, for the football kickoff. If you have kind of followed what's going on with Coach Prime, which is what he likes to be called, he has already raised the level of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) to great heights. We expect a huge crowd in town in two and one-half (2 1/2) There is a little history in the previous four (4) Gulf Coast Challenge games. We estimate that thirty-six thousand (36,000) visitors will come to Mobile, Alabama. It generated enough economic impact to estimate about seventeen million dollars (\$17,000,000.00) to our local economy, just on those four (4) games. This year's game, because of Coach Prime, could be the biggest of them all. As you might have heard, College Game Day will be at Jackson State this Saturday, which is the weekend before our game. Any kind of publicity that Coach Prime gets will hopefully help us to have a big crowd on Saturday, November 12, 2022.

That is not the only thing, just the games going on. We have a College and Career Fair for our local students on Wednesday before the game and a concert in Mardi Gras Square on Wednesday night. Comedian Kevin Hart is in town on Thursday night. Another concert with the Isley Brothers will be on Friday night at the Mobile Civic Center. A traditional Mardi Gras-style parade will be held on Saturday at 11:00 a.m. in downtown Mobile, Alabama. Of course, the Game Day tailgates culminate in the game itself. With all that stated, the Gulf Coast Challenge is the most economically significant annual event hosted by the Mobile Sports Authority. It's our largest event. We believe this year could be one of the largest single sporting events in Mobile, Alabama, in over a decade, if not longer. We are really excited about that.

In addition to the Gulf Coast Challenge, we already have about twenty (20) other confirmed events between now and the end of Fiscal Year 2023. We are putting your money

to work. We are really proud to be representing the City of Mobile and Mobile County as we tell our story. It would not happen without your investments. I want to thank you very much. Of course, we are always available to answer any questions or talk about anything you have on your mind. Thank you so much again.

President Hudson: Thank you so much, Danny Corte, Executive Director, Mobile Sports Authority, for giving us that update. This is exciting. A lot is going on, especially in the next couple of weeks, it sounds like. We look forward to that.
