### MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session (Combined Conference/Meeting) in Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, December 12, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Connie Hudson, President, Randall Dueitt and Merceria Ludgood, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

#### INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Commissioner Merceria Ludgood, District 1.

President Connie Hudson: Today is a very special day. We have a lot going on. First of all, I hope you had an opportunity as you were walking through the atrium to listen to the Cranford Burns Middle School band. They did a great job. Let's give them a round of applause. This has turned into an annual event. We have Band Director Stephen Berry. It's hard to see up there. We have the principal of Cranford Burns Middle School. This is his first year at the school, and we're happy to welcome him as well. This is Principal Todd Knight. The band will be continuing the concert after the meeting, and I encourage you to stop and listen. This is one of the projects that some of our education money goes to. I have contributed money for a number of years to the Cranford Burns Middle School, as well as the band for band equipment. This is the very reason that we have this funding available to help our schools to be able to provide this quality of entertainment and education for our young people. Thank you all, Cranford Burns Middle School band members, for being here today. We love your music, and we look forward to hearing some more.

> SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS/AZALEA CITY QUILTERS/QUILTS OF VALOR

**President Connie Hudson:** Next, we have two (2) special presentations today. Joyce Reed is an avid quilter and a member of several quilting groups in Mobile, Alabama. I think the Azalea City Quilters Guild is her primary one, and

she is here with her husband, Harold Reed. This is also an annual event. She is here to make two (2) presentations to veterans. Joyce Reed, please join us.

Joyce Reed, Azalea City Quilters: Thank you for welcoming me here today. I'm here representing mostly the Quilts of Valor Foundation. We're now a national organization of over ten thousand (10,000) quilters, founded in 2003 by Blue Star mom Catherine Roberts, Quilts of Valor Foundation in Seaford, Delaware. Her son was a gunner in Iraq sitting atop a Humvee. In one of her dreams, she felt very strongly that quilts would be healing. She saw her son sitting atop that Humvee and clustered around in his war demons in that dream. She could tell that there were many The next scene in her dream showed him sitting, problems. wrapped in a quilt. She felt things were much better. His demeanor had totally changed. She decided that maybe if I do quilts and I make one for my son or for some of his friends or those at Walter Reed, things would be a lot better for some of our soldiers returning home.

She did this, and her year-long commitment to make quilts with her friends turned into what is now known as the Quilts of Valor Foundation. Nineteen (19) years later, and as of December 3, 2022, they are at six thousand nine hundred thirteen (6,913) quilts awarded last month. Thev are at thirty thousand nine hundred seventy-eight (30,978) awarded year-to-date. Nationally, the total is three hundred thirty-three thousand six hundred ninety (333,690) quilts in the last nineteen (19) years. Our mission is to cover all combat service members and veterans touched by war with comforting and healing Quilts of Valor. It's the way we say thank you for your service, your sacrifice, and your Here are a couple of thank you's that I've received valor. recently.

Donald was one (1) of nine (9) children. He writes all five (5) boys were allowed to join the service, even though mom knew what they were signing their name on that dotted line meant. They were offering it all up to defend our freedom, even if it meant they might not come home. Four (4) of these five (5) young men did come home. But only after each had given twenty (20) or more years serving their country. Donald said he had been studying the Book of Daniel in Sunday School and how God wrapped His arms around Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego to protect them in the fiery furnace. He wondered about Quilts of Valor when he was offered to come to his presentation. He looked this up on the web and was impressed with what we do. He said he feels like God has him wrapped up in His arms every time he uses his quilt, just like God did for Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

Greg was awarded locally alongside several other war veterans from the Quilts of Valor Program. His wife said

the gift of time and love from Quilters, who helped honor those who have served. It's an awesome, very emotionally moving program as they use these beautiful handworks to represent a hug of thanks. An act of service for a time of service. It's the kindness that leaves a happy squeeze on the hearts of the service members and their family members. I know it did on ours.

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Today, we have two (2) outstanding citizens of our County that we would like to represent and present with a Quilt of Valor. The first is the current County Administrator; he was Coast Guard Petty Officer Glenn L. Hodge, who was cited for superior performance. One of the accommodation letters he got was for his duties while serving as a National Strike Force Response member and a storekeeper at the Gulf Strike Team from May 1995 to September 2004. He displayed exceptional leadership skills, technical expertise, and great dedication to his crew. He expertly supported his management of over seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000.00) in annual operating funds and a four million dollar (\$4,000,000.00) response to equipment inventory, always ensuring that every member of the Gulf Strike Team's complement was fully equipped and ready to respond. With his superb support, the Administrative Department consistently provided stellar customer service, efficiently processing thousands of travel orders and travel claims, a multitude of certifications, letters, and memorandums. On his own initiative, Petty Officer Hodge invested in hundreds of off-duty hours coordinating Reserve Force lodging arrangements for service duty weekend. Whether serving as a first responder or storekeeper, he consistently distinguished himself as a caring, dedicated leader who always focused on supporting those around him. His diligence, perseverance, and devotional duty are most orderly commended and are in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States Coast Guard. He was awarded the Commandant's Letter of Commendation Ribbon bar with the distinguishing operational device. He also received the Coast Guard Unit Accommodation Award, the Coast Guard Meritorious Unit Accommodation Award, the Armed Forces Reserve Medal with the M device, the Bicentennial Unit Accommodation Ribbon, the Coast Guard Rifle Marksman Ribbon, the Commandant's Letter of Commendation with a Bronze Star, a Humanitarian Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal with a Bronze Star, the Secretary's Outstanding Unit Award, and the fifth Coast Guard Reserve Good Conduct Medal. He was called to involuntary active duty in support of Operation Noble Eagle, associated with the World Trade

Center and the Pentagon attacks. Today, we'd like to thank Coast Guard and County Administrator Glenn L. Hodge for his service to our country if he could come forward.

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Today, we also honor Mayor David Baker from the City of Semmes, Alabama. He served in the Army as a Second Lieutenant while working as the Logistics Officer and Quartermaster. I do believe he moved almost every six (6) months. He served in Bosnia, Japan, Germany, South Korea, Puerto Rico, Hawaii, Alaska, Georgia, Washington, Virginia, Kentucky, California, and Alabama during his twenty (20) years in the Army. He was awarded the Army Commendation Medal, the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Medal, the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Armed Forces Service Medal, and the National Defense Service Medal. Locally, he has served on the Semmes City Council for five (5) years and has been the Mayor of Semmes for four (4) years. He has served as a deacon of his church for many years and is currently president of the Mobile Pop Symphony. He's married with two (2) children and four (4) grandchildren. Today, we proudly

award him his Quilt of Valor from the Quilts of Valor Foundation under a grateful nation. David, would you please come forward to receive your quilt.

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**President Hudson:** This is always a great presentation. Thank you to both gentlemen and all other veterans. Thank you for being here today and for your service to our country. I think Joyce Reed, Azalea City Quilters, said it best; we are a grateful nation. We are free because of individuals like you willing to serve and put your life on the line for us. Thank you again.

**President Connie Hudson:** We'll give everybody from the Cranford Burns Middle School band time to go out so they can get set up. Thank you again for being here, Principal Todd Knight. Thank you, Joyce Reed, Azalea City Quilters, and Harold Reed, for being here too. Okay, I think we are ready to move on to our agenda. Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator, we'll put you back to work here.

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Sharee Broussard, Public Affairs Director: We have some speakers, ma'am.

**President Hudson:** Okay. That's right, I'm sorry. Please come forward. Who is our speaker?

Sharee Broussard: Valerie Longa, Public Relations Officer, Mobile Public Library System.

**President Hudson:** Oh yes. Valerie, it's so good to have you here today.

Valerie Longa, Public Relations Officer, Mobile Public Library System: Good morning, Commissioners. Throughout 2022, Mobile Public Library has been celebrating one hundred twenty (120) years of service with a variety of signature events. We are wrapping up the anniversary with a special history exhibit that will be on display in the front lobby of Mobile Government Plaza later this week. It will showcase the evolution of the library system as well as some key moments in time and what occurred to bring Mobile Public Library to this present day as a leader in promoting literacy and connecting our community. From the start of Mobile Public Library in 1902, with the little library on the corner of Conti Street and Hamilton Street in downtown Mobile, Alabama, to the opening of the newest library, the Grand Bay Library in 2020. The history exhibit highlights past and current locations that comprise the library system. The City of Mobile and Mobile County leaders working in Mobile Government Plaza makes it an ideal place to launch the history exhibit and share the stories of how our stakeholders helped the library to succeed in serving the community.
