The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, March 27, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Connie Hudson, President, Randall Dueitt and Merceria Ludgood, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

PRESENT RESOLUTION/RAPE CRISIS
CENTER/PROCLAIM APRIL 2023 AS SEXUAL
ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH (SAAM)

WHEREAS, the Mobile County Commission proclaims April 2023 as Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM) in Mobile County; and

WHEREAS, SAAM calls attention to the fact that sexual violence is widespread and impacts every person in this community. We applaud the efforts of the Rape Crisis Center of Mobile for providing a compassionate presence and listening ear to victims; and

WHEREAS, the Rape Crisis Center, a program of Lifelines/Family Counseling Center, has provided comfort and support to sexual assault victims in this community for years, bringing awareness and education to the masses, while offering high-quality assistance to those in need; and

WHEREAS, the Rape Crisis Center provides 24-hour support to sexual assault victims and their families through direct services, prevention education, and professional training to all residents of Mobile County; and

whereas, the Rape Crisis Center serves a cross section of people of various races, socio-economic and educational levels; in 2022, the Center provided 473 crisis phone calls, 146 hospital calls, office visits, follow-up/victim support calls, court advocacy, family/friends support, clothing bank, dolls/bears given to child victims, transportation, information, and referrals to community agencies; and

WHEREAS, in awareness of SAAM, the Rape Crisis Center will have an exhibit on display in the atrium of Mobile Government Plaza;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED; we commend the Rape Crisis Center for the services it provides to the community. Furthermore, the Mobile County Commission joins advocates and

communities across the country in taking action to prevent sexual violence. Also, we remind residents that each day of the year is an opportunity to create change for the future.

# PRESENT RESOLUTION/PROCLAIM APRIL 2023 AS NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, the Mobile County Commission proclaims April 2023 as National Child Abuse Prevention & Awareness Month in Mobile County; and

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect is a serious problem affecting every segment of our community, and finding solutions requires input and action from everyone; and

WHEREAS, child abuse can have long-term psychological, emotional, and physical effects that have lasting consequences for victims of abuse; and

WHEREAS, protective factors are conditions that reduce or eliminate risk and promote the social, emotional, and developmental well-being of children; and

WHEREAS, child abuse prevention programs succeed effectively because of partnerships among agencies, schools, religious organizations, law enforcement agencies, and the business community; and

WHEREAS, our society has a responsibility to protect our children and help them thrive in a safe environment; every child is entitled to be loved and cared for, feel secure, and be free from verbal, sexual, emotional, and physical abuse and neglect;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, the Mobile County Commission acknowledges that we must work together as a community to increase awareness about child abuse and contribute to promoting the social and emotional well-being of children and families; furthermore, we urge all citizens to recognize National Child Abuse Prevention and Awareness Month by dedicating themselves to the task of improving the quality of life for all children and families.

Commission President Connie Hudson: Danyele, would you like to introduce your team?

Danyele Schmidt, Gulf Coast Family Center: We have representatives from Big Brothers Big Sisters, Mobile County Health Department, and Children's Trust Fund because child abuse isn't a single problem that any one agency can fix. This is a Mobile County problem, a State of Alabama problem, and a national problem. The way we truly can rectify this is by working together as a community, not only identifying it but by putting the services in place. Everything from mentors

to the Mobile County Health Department is involved in this. That is how we begin to beat this epidemic that we're facing. Just in Mobile County alone, last year, they had over 2,500 reports of child abuse and neglect. That led to over 200 children being placed in out-of-home care. That doesn't even begin to capture the number of safety plans put into place and services through the community. We appreciate the Commissioners allowing us to be here. April is Child Abuse Awareness Month, and we'll all wear blue to show our support. We invite you to do that. Tag us on social media.
