MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, May 23, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Connie Hudson, President, Randall Dueitt and Merceria Ludgood, Members. Also present were E. Edwin Kerr, Deputy County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Pastor Marvin Charles Lue, Jr., Steward Memorial CME Church, 1266 Martin Luther King Avenue, Mobile, Alabama 36604.

President Connie Hudson: This morning, we have a resolution and special presentation. Then we are going to invite some of our retirees up to accept their certificate.

PRESENT RESOLUTION/ BUILDING SAFETY MONTH

President Connie Hudson: First of all, I'd like to invite Tim Jordan, Tom Waters, and Paul Antoine from Mobile County Inspection Services to come down. We have a resolution in honor of recognition of Building Safety Month. These gentlemen are the unsung heroes of building inspections. We take it for granted a little bit, I think when we go into a building, we are going to be safe because it has been inspected, and you guys have done your job. It's a very important job, and it gives us and property owners the peace of mind that the building and their property are being well taken care of, inspected, and they don't have anything to worry about. It's important, and we want to recognize this month and the outstanding work that you do.

MOBILE COUNTY RECOGNIZES BUILDING SAFETY MONTH MAY 2022

WHEREAS, our County is committed to recognizing that our growth and strength depend on the safety and economic value of the homes, buildings, and infrastructure that serve our citizens, both in everyday life and in times of disaster; and,

WHEREAS, our confidence in the resilience of these buildings that make up our community is achieved through the devotion of vigilant guardians — building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, design professionals, laborers, plumbers, and others in the construction industry — who work year—round to ensure the safe construction of buildings; and

WHEREAS, our nation benefits economically and technologically from using the International Codes that are developed by national, voluntary consensus codes and standards developing organizations; our government is able to avoid the high cost and complexity of developing and maintaining these codes, which are the most widely adopted building safety and fire prevention codes in the world. These modern building codes include safeguards to protect the public from hazards such as hurricanes, snowstorms, tornadoes, wildland fires, floods, and earthquakes; and

WHEREAS, Building Safety Month is sponsored by the International Code Council to remind the public about the critical role of our communities' largely unknown protectors of public safety - our local code officials - who assure us of safe, sustainable, energy-efficient and livable buildings that are essential to America's prosperity; and,

WHEREAS, "Prevent, Prepare, Protect. Building Codes Save," the theme for Building Safety Month 2022, encourages all Americans to raise awareness about the importance of safe and resilient construction, fire prevention, disaster mitigation, energy conservation, and water safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Mobile County Commission does hereby proclaim May 2022 as:

BUILDING SAFETY MONTH

in Mobile County, Alabama; furthermore, we urge all citizens to consider the commitment to improve building safety, resilience, and economic investment at home and in

the community, and to acknowledge the essential service provided to all of us by local and state building departments, fire prevention bureaus, and federal agencies in protecting lives and property.

President Connie Hudson: I'll present that to you.
Did you want to make a comment or two?

Tim Jordan, Mobile County Inspection Services: Sorry, I won't take up too much time. You did a great job reading I was hoping you were going to take care of it and not me today. Thank you for doing that. I thank the Commission for allowing us to come up here and do this. Paul Antoine, Mobile County Inspection Services, and me both serve on multiple boards throughout the State of Alabama, and we volunteer. We believe it makes a difference. I'll share something really quick. colleague, who is the vice president and soon-to-be president of the International Code Council (ICC). He took a direct hit last year with Hurricane Ida. Some winds were up to one hundred seventy (170) to one hundred seventy-two (172) miles per hour. His house was just built by the adopted code at that time. Houses around him were torn off the foundation and lost in the flood. When you hear these stories, you know that it makes a difference when it happens to somebody close to you. I do believe that. just wanted to say that none of this happens without the support of the Commission and the team we have in Mobile County Inspections. The leadership is second to none. I'll start with Richard Mitchell, Public Works Director. He visits our office regularly and supports everything we do with a smile on his face. Matthew Barclift, Engineering Development Manager, I can't say enough about him. I believe every time he comes to our office, he makes us smarter. I really believe that. I love you, Matthew. Waters, Mobile County Inspection Services Director, when you hear people say that sometimes people put others before themselves, you won't find anybody else that does it better than Tom. He supports us, treats us as professionals, gives us the tools we need, and really respects family. think that's why Paul Antoine, Mobile County Inspection Services, and me serve and do what we do because of the leadership that supports us and takes care of us. can't find that in too many places in today's job workplace. I just want to thank y'all for what y'all do.

President Hudson: Well said.

Commissioner Ludgood: Today, we have this Certificate of Award to certify that Jakayla Armstrong has earned special recognition and is hereby granted this Certificate of Award for earning the rank of Eagle Scout as the first African-American female Eagle Scout in the State of Alabama. It's done this 23rd day of May 2022 and is signed by all three (3) Commissioners: Commissioner Hudson, who is our President; Commissioner Dueitt, who is behind you; and yours truly. Congratulations, and thank you. You make us proud.

Jakayla Armstrong: First off, I would like to thank the County Commission for this opportunity. My name is Jakayla, and I am a member of Troop 283 out of Liberty Missionary Baptist Church. As stated, I am a recent graduate of Murphy High School. In the Fall of 2022, I will be attending the University of Alabama. Thank you.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Good morning, Commissioners. The first speaker is Rhonda Gulledge, Design Engineering Manager.

President Connie Hudson: Oh, Rhonda. Okay. We know
her.

Rhonda Gulledge, Design Engineering Manager: wanted to thank y'all for supporting the Alabama Kidney Foundation. Currently, there are fourteen thousand (14,000) Alabamians on dialysis. One thousand (1,000) of them are on the wait list for a kidney. By designating on your driver's license that you are an organ donor, then if you're deceased, your organs can be harvested and given to people who are in need of organs. Six (6) out of ten (10) people receive their kidneys from deceased donors. There is a five (5) year wait list to get a kidney. The other four (4) people that receive organs receive them from living donors. These numbers really didn't mean a lot to me until my best friend told me she needed a kidney. She had been on dialysis for fourteen (14) months. In October 2019, I gave her my left kidney. Kidneys from deceased donors last ten (10) to fifteen (15) years. A kidney from a living donor can last fifteen (15) to twenty (20) years. I want to thank y'all for supporting the Alabama Kidney Foundation and encourage everyone to be an organ donor.

President Hudson: Thank you, Rhonda.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Our next speaker is Angela Goudreault.

President Connie Hudson: I think we know her too.
Welcome, this morning.

Angela Goudreault, Grand Farms Road West: Good morning, y'all. We are here today to give you an update on where Grand Farms Road West is at this stage. I am very happy to say we are installing our mailboxes to be able to receive mail there again. That's a big achievement. Thank y'all. We wanted to know when we would get speed limit signs. The road is drivable now, and it's a racetrack. I'm not complaining.

President Hudson: Okay. Well, I'll turn to W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. Do you know what the plans are in terms of getting speed limit signs up?

W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer: Commissioner, just as soon as we accept it for maintenance, we'll be installing speed limit signs.

President Hudson: Do you have a projection?

W. Bryan Kegley II: I'll have to get an update,
Commissioner. I don't know.

President Hudson: Okay.

Angela Goudreault: It's in the inventory. Is there another step? It's in the maintenance inventory. That was accepted earlier this year.

W. Bryan Kegley II: It's still under contract. We haven't accepted it from the contractor yet. As soon as we get the final documentation, we will do a final inspection. We'll take it in as ours.

President Hudson: Right. The contractor has to
release it before we can add any signs or do anything.

Angela Goudreault: I'm learning. Also, will there be a marking to show where the private road starts and the County maintenance start?

W. Bryan Kegley II: Yes, ma'am. We'll have an end of County maintenance sign installed also.

Angela Goudreault: Thank you very much. Y'all have a wonderful day. Y'all come out there and see it. It's awesome. By the way, Southern Land Development, LLC has an awesome crew. W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer, you were right. They have been patient with ones that weren't patient with them. They have just been really good. They're really good people. Thank y'all.

President Hudson: We're glad that it has all worked
out very positively.

Angela Goudreault: Don't forget to go out and vote
tomorrow.
