MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Monday, April 26, 2021, at 10:00 A. M. The following members of the Commission were present: Merceria Ludgood, President, Connie Hudson and Randall Dueitt, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Ludgood chaired the meeting.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Minister Queen Gregory, Public Affairs Information Specialist.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Dr. Eichold, will you please step to the front.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: Good morning. For those of you who do not know, this is Dr. Bernard H. Eichold II. We call him Dr. Bert Eichold. He has dedicated his life to public health and safety and the safety of our community. He is the longest serving public health officer in the State of Alabama, is that correct?

Dr. Bernard H. Eichold II: That is correct.

Commissioner Hudson: Today we are celebrating an anniversary, the thirty-first (31st) anniversary of him serving in the position. We are so very happy to have you here today. We are so grateful for you and for all you do. I don't think that has been illustrated any more so than over the last year with the pandemic and the public health crisis associated with that, and for the great job you have done in serving our county and our citizens. WHEREAS, Dr. Eichold has earned the respect and gratitude of his colleagues, as well as regional, state, and local leaders including the public at large for his adherence to the highest standards of ethical conduct, and for his steadfast devotion to the betterment of health and medicine in Mobile County; **NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE**

RESOLVED, the Mobile County Commission wishes to applaud Dr. Bernard H. Eichold II on his extraordinary professional achievements on the occasion of his thirty-first (31st) anniversary as Health Officer for the Mobile County Health Department; furthermore, we extend our congratulations and best wishes to him for continued success.

Commissioner Hudson: Congratulations, Dr. Eichold and thank you again.

Dr. Eichold: Thank you very much. It's an honor and a privilege to serve the people of Mobile County. This has been a very hard year for everyone for 2020 and 2021. It has been a team effort. It has been the community and the medical community working together to get to a position to where we are now. Today we have about twenty-one (21) persons in the hospital with COVID-19. Our high point was two hundred seventy-six (276). It's an amazing progress we have made together. We're about halfway with getting our community vaccinated. My suggestion as we move closer to the Fourth of July holiday, let's celebrate the Fourth of July in Mobile County, Alabama independent of COVID-19. Please everyone make an effort to get vaccinated. Celebrate the Fourth of July with your friends and family who are fully vaccinated and give everybody big hugs because the six (6) feet distancing and not wearing masks

goes away when everybody's fully vaccinated. Until then, we need to continue to be cautious. We have had an increase in activity of COVID-19 and community transmissions over the past two (2) weeks. It has not gotten terrible, but we've seen some impacts of spring break. A little bit of caution is still recommended as we move forward. Thank you and God bless Mobile County.

Commissioner Hudson: Thank you.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Good morning, Commissioners. The first speaker is Ed O. Bridgman.

Ed O. Bridgman, 10550 Pioneer Road, Theodore, Alabama 36582: That is a tough act to follow. Good morning. My name is Ed O. Bridgman and I don't want anything from you. I'm the owner of Homestead RV Community. It's the most technologically advanced recreation vehicle destination in the whole world. It is right here in Theodore, Alabama. I'd like to officially invite everybody in this room to our grand opening on May 8, 2021. We'll be serving food from 11:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. Commissioner Randall Dueitt has graciously offered to speak at noon. Even with that, I think there are more reasons why you should come. Over the past year as Dr. Eichold mentioned, we have seen a lot of differences and a lot of changes. Sixty-two percent (62%) of the work force will no longer return to a brick and mortar office. People are teaching their kids virtually. More people are staying home all of the time. Food and merchandise is being delivered by drones now. People and government agencies who embrace and are prepared for the future will flourish. People who are not ready or prepared and are continuing to hold on to the past will suffer as we pivot to the new norm. Everybody's telling us that we have to pivot to the new norm but very few people are telling us what that looks like. What is the new norm? At Homestead RV Community, we have one of the many solutions that will be coming. I'd like for you to come out and see it. As I mentioned earlier, it's the most technologically advanced recreation vehicle destination in the world. What you might not know is that in 2020, four million (4,000,000) new American households chose camping. That raises it up to eighty-six million one hundred thousand Americans (86,100,000) Americans who are choosing camping twenty (20) days out of the year. In 2021, that will be raised to twenty-five (25) days out of the year. In February of 2021, recreation vehicle sales were at forty-eight thousand two hundred eighty-six (48,286). That's for new recreation vehicle sales in February of 2021. There was a thirty point one percent (30.1%) increase over February of 2020 prior to the pandemic. What we are expecting is recreation vehicle sales to grow to over five hundred twenty-three thousand one hundred thirty-nine (523,139) and maybe up to

five hundred forty-three thousand five hundred seventy-two (543,572) units will be sold in 2021. That's a twenty-three percent (23%) increase over 2020. Now we all know that ten thousand (10,000) Americans are turning twenty-five (25) every day, but what you might not know is that the largest segment of the camping community is the millennials. Thirty-seven percent (37%) are now camping. Generation Z makes up fifty-two percent (52%). That's a total of fifty-nine percent (59%) of Americans under the age of fifty (50) are camping now. As I mentioned, there is twenty-three percent (23%) new recreation vehicle sales in 2021, but what you need to compare that to is that we're only creating fifty-two thousand (52,000) new sites to set these up on in America. That's an increase of zero point one seven eight percent (0.178%). That's a huge difference in supply and demand. Each of you are aware of strip centers that are vacant and are no longer producing revenue. Maybe we have a way of working through that. We would have to change some rules in order to do it but we could take advantage of those and make them into places to live. I hope you all come out to the grand opening on May 8, 2021.

Dena Pollard: Excuse me, Mr. Bridgman. You have one (1) minute.

Ed O. Bridgman: I have one (1) minute to say thank you very much for your time. Are there any questions?

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: No, but I'll make a comment. I have had an opportunity to camp in the past and still camp some now. I have been out to his facility and it is phenomenal. If you get an opportunity to go out for the grand opening or before. I want to thank you. You could have went anywhere in the country and built this facility. I want to thank you for coming to Mobile County. You're not a native of Mobile. A lot of people do not know that here, but you chose Mobile. You chose to build your facility here and we appreciate you doing that.

Ed O. Bridgman: I am honored to be here. Thank you.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: Thank you.

President Merceria Ludgood: Are there any other speakers?

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Yes. We have Arthur Weaver to speak on road frontage issues.

Arthur Weaver, 6051 McCrary Road, Semmes, Alabama 36575: Good morning.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: Good morning.

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: Good morning.

Arthur Weaver: Thank you all for letting me speak. My name is Arthur Weaver and I live on McCrary Road in Semmes. I have been out there since 1985. Since I have lived there, I picked up a piece of property up behind me that joins my property. It is a two-story studio apartment with a mobile home that I lease out. Right now my grandson and his dad live there. They are getting ready to move out and go into a house. I am having an issue with the people that bought the property next door to mine. Their entrance is from McCrary Road and the property was listed on McCrary Road. They choose to use the dead-end street behind them on the frontage of the house that I own and am paying taxes on to get in and out. They also allow their son and his family that lives on another street adjoined to the property to also use that entrance. I took some pictures and you can see that the drive that I'm using to enter the property that I'm paying taxes on is also a drive to enter his piece of property. I am the one who has to keep everything up out there. I always felt that if you're paying taxes, you ought to have access to the road frontage. I always kept it up on McCrary Road and I always kept it up back there. It is a dead-end street. When they left it, they left it as what they call a hammer head. People used it for a turn around site. I had an issue with them coming up in the yard and tearing it up, so I put two (2) posts up and stretched a cable across there to stop them from getting up on the grass and to divert them from even coming down. The neighbor I am speaking of is Mr. Patrick O'Brien. We have not gotten along and nobody who lives over there gets along with him. I know he's not here and there are two (2) sides to everything. If you mention anything to him, it turns into an argument. I just leave him alone. He put an electric gate there. If he's coming out or going in, then I can't use my entrance to my property. I have to wait. When they leave out of there, they'll come out of the gate and they'll drift all the way over to the right side where the mailbox is to keep it muddy right there because it's a low spot that holds water when it rains. I've had a big issue with that and thanks to you, they are out there working on it. Mr. Price knew about this way back and he didn't address it. I sent you some pictures and you sent Neal Howard, Deputy Public Works Director, out to speak with me and I appreciated that. We spoke on it and he seemed like he is trying to help me with it. They are out there working on some other issues other than the issue I am having with the driveway. There are some bad areas out there that needed to be filled in and fixed. When they come out and fix this, they throw dirt on the shoulder of the road. It was washed out really bad and could cause someone to have an accident. I have been riding motorcycles all of my life. A lot of people don't ride motorcycles. They do not respect motorcycles. They

do not understand how unsafe it can be for a motorcycle for these areas to stay like this. That's dangerous for a motorcycle rider. When you address it with the people you feel like can help you with it and they ignore it, then it's kind of irritating when you pay taxes. There was a hole out there on McCrary Road that they kept throwing dirt in. The concrete cover going through there had a hole in it.

Dena Pollard: Excuse me, Mr. Weaver, you have one (1) more minute.

Arthur Weaver: I think the pictures speak for themselves. If there is any way y'all can help me detour the gentleman using the driveway? He has two (2) entrances he can use. He can use his son's entrance on another street or he can use his entrance off McCrary Road which was his entrance from the beginning. I spoke to Mr. Wild, my ex son-in-law, and he is going to move into a house and I lined somebody up to rent my property. When I explained to them the situation, they withdrew. They said they would like to rent it if I could get the issue resolved. They do not want to share a driveway with anyone. The fence is down right now because I took all of the fencing down. I'm getting ready to put it back up and fix it to where children and a dog can stay in it. Once they do that and the gate hasn't stayed close when they come into the driveway, they will have to stop to get out and open the gate. This family does not wait. They even speed down through there. If kids are out playing on a dead-end street, you'll have to grab them really quick and get out of the way. They will speed up like they want them out of the way. I need some help.

Commissioner Hudson: Thank you, Mr. Weaver. I appreciate you emailing the pictures last week. I know you had contacted my office and my District Administrator had asked for you to provide as much information and pictures as you could about the concerns. It's important we do it that way so I have an understanding that I can share with our Public Works Department or Engineering Department or whomever I would turn to for them to look at the issue and see what we could do to help resolve it. I know Neal Howard, Deputy Public Works Director, did go out and speak with you within a couple of days of you calling the office. Based on the information you provided, we were able to have a better understanding. I think the two (2) issues primarily are that we have some erosion and standing water, particularly when you have a lot of rainfall and that's because it has been rutted out from people running off of the road and what have you. Then there is the right-of-way access issue. Those were the two (2) issues I asked our Public Works Department to focus on and look to see what we could do to help resolve any problems or if there was any unlawful activity in terms of access and anything like that. Richard Mitchell, Public Works Director, do you want

to respond to both of those issues? Or Neal Howard, Deputy Public Works Director, or both of you?

Richard Mitchell, Public Works Director: No, I'll respond.

Commissioner Hudson: Okay.

Richard Mitchell: We have a current service request to handle the standing water on the edge of the road and the turns at Agee Road and Alice Road and Agee Road and McCrary Road. Those are in the works to be repaired. As far as the access, the right-of-way goes all the way to the property line. Any individual that abuts the right-of-way has the right to access the right-of-way. Just like we wouldn't want to stop Mr. Arthur Weaver from accessing the road on the right-of-way in front of his property, we cannot deny access to Mr. Patrick O'Brien. We cannot deny that.

Arthur Weaver: I disagree with that because his entrance is off McCrary Road. His son's entrance is off another street. They are all using the entrance back there and I'm the one keeping it up. I pay taxes on that place. If I can't use the road frontage, then if you want to buy it, then you can buy it and let Mr. Patrick O'Brien do what he wants to. Or Mr. Patrick O'Brien can buy it, but it can't stay like it is. There's no way. I'm sixty-five (65) years old and I'm trying to get out from under stress, not stay under it.

Richard Mitchell: This road was paved in the 1996 Pay-As-You-Go Program and the right-of-way is not necessarily maintained all the way to the property line of the next person. It is maintained to the point of use and that is what we were maintaining it to. That's what it was paved to back on the 1996 Pay-As-You-Go Program. Neal Howard, Deputy Public Works Director, did talk with Mr. Arthur Weaver in that if that is something needed, we can maintain to that property line. It will be difficult if the gate is closed. We can't get a piece of machinery past it to work up to the fence. We can get as close as we can get. We're willing to do that and it is not a problem. In the past, it has not been used. That does not mean it cannot be used.

Arthur Weaver: So you all understand, it's not just because I'm in a contest with Mr. Patrick O'Brien. The right-of-way out there, if he was to move his entrance over to the right more, then he would be out of my driveway. I would not have to sit there and wait for him to move to get out of my driveway. That is what we're having to do. They will sit there sometimes just deliberately for you to have to wait. This is wrong. I'm paying taxes on that place. It is wrong for me to have to sit and wait for somebody to move so I can get out of my driveway.

Richard Mitchell: That sounds like an issue between you and your neighbor, not a right-of-way issue.

Arthur Weaver: What am I supposed to do? I asked him if he would use his entrance and he said he had an easement to get in and out of there. Both Mr. Price and Neal Howard, Deputy Public Works Director, told me he does not have an easement because they didn't give him one.

Richard Mitchell: There is not an easement. His land touches the right-of-way. He has the full right-of-way width access too.

Arthur Weaver: The County maintenance stops about seventy (70) feet from his property line.

Richard Mitchell: Correct.

Arthur Weaver: Okay. I'm the one back there with shovels and rakes. If you look at some of the pictures where the water comes out from under his gate, since he is on an incline, you can see it has been washed out. Then you can see where it is not right now because I have to maintain it.

Richard Mitchell: As I said, we are willing to maintain to that property line.

Arthur Weaver: Okay. I appreciate that. Is there anyway you can get him to move his gate entrance to the right a little bit? It'll still be on the right-of-way.

Richard Mitchell: No, sir. We can't. We do not dictate exactly where they enter or exit the right-of-way.

Arthur Weaver: Then what is going to happen with the place when I can't rent it? I have been told by a gentleman who wants to lease the place that he will not live there under those conditions and he won't rent it. I use my hard-earned money to purchase the property because it's a good investment to help me with my retirement. Between me and my girlfriend, we're raising four (4) grandkids. They're three (3), four (4), five (5), and thirteen and half (13.5). We like for them to be able to go back there and be able to play on the dead-end street without any interference. When they're back there, and you can't keep your eye on the kids all of the time, the neighbors will speed up when they're coming in and out. I'm not exaggerating. They speed up and make you grab your kids and run with them. This is just not right.

Commissioner Hudson: Mr. Weaver, I understand your concerns. I think we have an issue of what the law allows. We are bound by State law in terms of what we can and cannot do and what we can require. I'll be happy to have our Legal Department take a closer look at this. We cannot

violate State law. We have to stay within the requirements of the law. That is the issue we have here. We cannot keep a citizen off a public right-of-way. I think that is where the misunderstanding is coming in. I'll have our attorney take a look at the situation and we'll provide a letter to you so you know exactly what the law says and what the County can and cannot do legally, okay?

Arthur Weaver: Thank you, Commissioner Hudson. If y'all will keep in mind that his tax assessment is still listed on McCrary Road and not Alice Drive. He stuck a mailbox back there and started using that just because it was more convenient for him. He then started to let his family use it even though they live on a different street. I don't think that's right. I respect what you're telling me and I appreciate it if you'll look into it to see what y'all can do. Even if you could just get him to understand if he moves his gate down a little bit more so we won't have to stop when each other's coming in or out. That would help a whole lot. Please.

Commissioner Hudson: Thank you, Mr. Weaver.

Arthur Weaver: Thank you, ma'am.

Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator: First, I would like to read the 2021 County Legislative Achievement Report.
