MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Monday, August 14, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Randall Dueitt, president, Merceria Ludgood and Connie Hudson, members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, county administrator/clerk of the commission, Jay Ross, county attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, county engineer. President Dueitt chaired the meeting.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: I would like to welcome everyone to the August 14, 2023 regular meeting of the Mobile County Commission. If you would, please stand with me for the invocation. It will be given by Phillip Snodgrass, the chaplain for the Mobile County Sheriff's Office. Then, please remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain Phillip Snodgrass, Mobile County Sheriff's Office, 510 South Royal Street, Mobile, Alabama.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Thank you, Phillip, for being here. I do not see any retirees list or resolutions. Sharee, do we have any speakers?

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: Yes, sir, we have two speakers. The first is Mr. Earl Wayne Rowe. He will speak about Agenda Item #67, related to Hillview Acres Subdivision.

President Dueitt: Thank you. Mr. Rowe, if you do not
mind, please state your name and address for us when you
come up.

Earl Rowe, 5697 Travis Road, Mobile, Alabama: This is about water runoff. I know the Engineering Department has approved it. I am 70 years old and have lived on that property since I was two weeks old. I grew up on that

street and dirt road when there were only 12 houses, and now the houses are side by side, thousands and thousands of houses. The water runoff has been developing over the past 40 years, and it continues to get worse and worse. My property, which I sent some pictures to y'all, is inundated every time we get out-of-the-normal rain. It enters my property when we get five or six inches in one day. When lots are approved, can something possibly be done with the water runoff? The Engineering Department did a survey 20 years ago, I got water runoff from 240 acres of land. I took it upon myself to put in a culvert 20 years ago. I put in a 48-inch culvert, 300 feet long, to maintain my property, and 20 years later, it is not enough culvert. It fills up my neighbor's property, and he will not be able to use part of his property because it has turned into a retention pond. The County has placed four culverts across the dirt road, which all the water comes through, but I have my issues when it builds up high enough to come over that road. Can something be looked at, advised, or engineered to control this increase in water runoff?

Commission President Randall Dueitt: There are several subdivisions listed in Agenda Item #67. For the record, we are talking about Hillview Acres Subdivision.

Earl Rowe: The man has done an excellent job cleaning up the property. It looks a whole lot better than it did two years ago. He is subdividing it. I hope that he builds houses. I hope it does not become a trailer rental, but I have no control over that.

President Dueitt: I had some conversations over the weekend with Ms. Moody. Sandy Moody, I think she is one of your neighbors. Also, I had some conversations with Matthew Barclift, our engineer at the County who oversees these subdivisions, and I have a little understanding of what we are doing. There are already six lots on this property, and they are dividing it from six to eight, so they are only adding two new lots. If you do not mind, I am going to ask Matthew to come up and speak. I think you have been to Matthew's office before and spoken with him. I will tell you that legally when we have these subdivisions come in, if there is a variance in our regulations, then we have a little bit of authority to make decisions on it, but for the most part, when they submit their plans for a subdivision, we have to go by our regulations. If they meet the regulations and there is no variance, we have very little ability to deny them their subdivision without bringing liability and litigation on the County, but I will let Matthew explain it better to you.

Earl Rowe: I understand, and I realize what my neighbor is doing is not illegal. It is only legal because there are no restrictions. My question is, what will be

done down the road, 10 years from now, when it continues to be like this more and more?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Matthew Barclift: Good morning, Commissioners. Hopefully, you have the diagram in front of you to guide you while I am speaking on it. They are dividing six lots into eight lots. There was a trailer park there before, and there are a significant number of existing structures, at least two or three, but the heart of it is that this is the last batch of subdivisions that will be approved under the old Subdivision Regulations. Under the new Subdivision Regulations, we might have a little more flexibility and a little more authority to look at this from a drainage perspective, but under our 2004 and 2005 Subdivision Regulations, we did not have any authority to ask them to do the drainage. I have sent a request to the professionals to talk to their owners about voluntarily providing some detention for any increase that the subdivision might create. I have not received a response, but from our perspective, it meets the Subdivision Regulations, so we believe it would be appropriate to approve it.

President Dueitt: Thank you, Matthew. Mr. Earl, thank
you for being here today.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Sharee.

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: We have one more speaker this morning from the Mobile Extension Office, Cindy Knowlton, and she has handouts up there for y'all.

Cindy Knowlton, extension coordinator, Alabama
Cooperative Extension Service, Jon Archer Agricultural
Center, 1070 Schillinger Road, Mobile, Alabama: Good
morning, Commissioners. I want to take this opportunity to
invite you all or an assistant of yours or an assistant to
that assistant to an upcoming Agricultural Leadership
Program that will be on Tuesdays in October 2023. I am in
my third year in Mobile County. I am invested in the
County's urban and rural areas, but I have noticed that
many of our urban citizens are not aware of the diverse
agricultural industry in Mobile County. We have over
100,000 acres of farmland and approximately 52,000 jobs
related to agriculture, directly and indirectly, for a
total impact of nearly \$6.5 billion annually. I put
together a program in hopes of sharing the agricultural
industry with Mobile County citizens. I was very
conscientious of not doing full days. It will be from

8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., four Tuesdays in a row in October 2023. I hope you all consider sending someone from the Commission. I am reaching out to many of our organizations and agencies, such as the Mobile Chamber, the Mobile County Board of Education, the City of Mobile, the Mobile's Innovation Portal, and our universities. Hopefully, they will send a representative and learn about our agricultural center. On the last note, I would like to invite all of you to the County Agent's Kitchen that we will have next week at the annual convention of the Association of County Commissions of Alabama in Orange Beach, Alabama. The County Agents will provide two meals: lunch on Wednesday at noon and breakfast on Thursday at 7:30 a.m. I will have the opportunity to be there and look for each of you to say hello and thank you as well. Are there any comments or questions?

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: Thank you, Cindy. Every year, that is a highlight of the convention, having the extension service representatives there supporting the convention with meals, which are excellent. I just wanted the opportunity to say thank you for all that you do for our community.

Cindy Knowlton: Thank you.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: I would like to say the same: Thank you for everything you do to bring awareness about the large agricultural community in Mobile County, and thank you for all your hard work in putting the stuff together for us. Thank you.

District 1 Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: Is this Agricultural Leadership Program series open to the public?

Cindy Knowlton: Yes.

Commissioner Ludgood: If you could send us a flyer in a digital form with dates and times, we can add them to our newsletters and the County information site.

Cindy Knowlton: Sounds great, thank you.

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: There are no more speakers.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Thank you. Glenn, you can proceed.
