MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in a combined conference and regular meeting session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Thursday, August 28, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Randall Dueitt, president, Merceria Ludgood and Connie Hudson, members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, county administrator/clerk of the commission, Jay Ross, county attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, county engineer. President Dueitt chaired the meeting.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Good morning, everyone, and welcome to the August 28, 2023 Meeting of the Mobile County Commission. Today is a combined conference and meeting. I want to welcome Chaplain Mike Wilson, who is on the Seven Hills Fire Department Board and the chaplain for all 19 fire departments. He will be giving the invocation for us today, and if you do not mind, please stand and remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain Mike Wilson, Saint Elmo-Irvington Volunteer Fire Department, 8685 Half Mile Road, Irvington, Alabama.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Thank you, Mike. Next, we have a special presentation. We want to recognize some of our employees for their hard work completing some courses to gain certification through the Alabama Local Government Training Institute and the Association of County Commissions of Alabama. Lanice Shaw, Finance Department fiscal officer, completed the Basic-Level Certification. Scott Weir, Geographic Information System Department analyst III, completed the County Administration Certification. Katherine Eddy, Information Technology Department policy writer and document manager, completed the County Administration Certification. Please come forward to receive your certificates. It is always great to recognize County employees who go above and beyond what is required for the County and take advantage of these continuous education courses. Thank You all for being

dedicated employees and taking advantage of these opportunities. Any of you would like to say anything?

Lanice Shaw, fiscal officer: Thank you for the opportunity to gain such knowledge. Anyone who has an interest should attend.

Katherine Eddy, policy writer, and document manager: Thank you, Commissioners and Administration, for making this opportunity available to all of us. I like that I am not a finance person, but I learned about finance. You learn a lot about things outside of your specialized area. I encourage employees to attend.

President Dueitt: Scott is like me; he would rather not speak. Thank you guys; congratulations. We have no resolutions and no retirees. I am glad for people to retire, but I am always glad when we do not have retirees because I like to keep everybody here.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Sharee, do we have any speakers today?

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: Yes, sir, two people have signed up to address the Commission this morning. The first is Barbara Langley, who has signed up to speak about the Metro Jail. Ms. Langley? I do not see her, sir.

President Dueitt: Ms. Langley?

Public Affairs Director Broussard: She might have stepped out. I will look for her after our next speaker. Our next speaker is Mayor Henry Barnes of Bayou La Batre, Alabama.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Come on down, Mayor of Bayou La Batre, the seafood capital of Alabama, welcome.

The Honorable Bayou La Batre Mayor Henry Barnes: Of the World.

President Dueitt: Probably; welcome to the County Commission meeting, and thank you for being with us today.

Mayor Barnes: Thank you, Commissioner, and all of you for allowing me to speak this morning. The Bayou La Batre City Council adopted a resolution declaring shrimp dumping

to be a disaster. Some of you all may know what that is, and some of you all may not. Foreign countries, like Ecuador, are dumping farmed-raised shrimps into our market, which lowers the price of domestic shrimps that shrimpers catch in the Gulf of Mexico. The resolution was sent to Alabama Governor Kay Ivey along with a letter from the city of Bayou La Batre, and we ask that you all adopt a similar resolution. I have copies for each one of you all because it affects you all too. If the shrimpers do not make money, they do not spend it, and there goes the tax base. We request you all to jump on board, show some unity with the city of Bayou La Batre, and make a similar resolution and possibly a letter to Governor Ivey. I will not read it because it is over five minutes.

President Dueitt: That is fine. Would you mind, for the public knowledge, and maybe for the other two Commissioners, explaining what this does to our local shrimpers, the market, and the environment?

Mayor Barnes: Some of these imported shrimps being dumped into the market are raised in ponds with antibiotics added to the water. I will not go into details, but you cannot imagine. The last time, they dumped 750 million pounds of farmed-raised shrimp into our market. It is not just shrimp, but crab meat and other sick fish. The Gulf Coast supplies 15 percent of the shrimp consumption in the United States. We know we need to farm shrimp, but we do not need them bringing shrimp here for 50 cents to 60 cents per pound because it drops our price of 90 cents per pound. A crew unloaded 800 boxes of shrimp, which is 100 pounds per box. The crew shared less than \$5,000.00 for six weeks of work. It is ridiculous. Our federal government is sitting back, letting it happen. The tariff on Ecuador was removed, so other countries are going through Ecuador to flood the United States market with their product. China refused some of these products that they are bringing to us. Are there any other questions I can answer for you?

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: Mayor, have you had conversations directly with any state officials from economic affairs or conservation, whatever department would have some input into what is happening?

Mayor Barnes: Yes, ma'am, we met with Congressman Jerry Carl and Representative Chip Brown on Friday. They are on board. They are going to help us. I told them we were coming to you all today. Everyone seems to be surprised to find out that there is farmed seafood. I think there is a photograph out there showing shrimp from Argentina with an American flag on it, but it is not American shrimp, not Gulf Coast wild-caught. You can research on Google for the best shrimp in the world, and it will show you the Gulf of Mexico's shrimp.

Commissioner Hudson: To clarify, what exactly are you requesting?

Mayor Barnes: That you all come up with a resolution similar to ours and send it to Governor Kay Ivey.

Commissioner Hudson: The resolution is requesting what from the governor?

Mayor Barnes: Declaring shrimp dumping to be a disaster.

Commissioner Hudson: Will a resolution declaring shrimp dumping a disaster allow subsidies?

Mayor Barnes: We are asking for fuel subsidies or something similar.

Commissioner Hudson: Maybe we can get our attorney to look at it and advise us on the best direction as a body to assist, okay?

Mayor Barnes: You all have any other questions. I will leave these copies with Sharee Broussard. We mainly want to educate the public about what they are being sold in the stores and the false advertisements of putting American flags on foreign products.

Commissioner Hudson: Are they not required to label the point of origin on products?

Mayor Barnes: They are, but the labeling was under the bottom, and Representative Chip Brown introduced legislation that passed to put the label on the front so consumers can see it.

Commissioner Hudson: That sounds like a major problem.

Mayor Barnes: It is similar to the American steel industry standing against foreign imported steel years ago.

Commissioner Hudson: Thank you for being here today and bringing it to our attention.

Mayor Barnes: Thank you for listening. I appreciate it.

President Dueitt: Thank you, Mayor.

Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard: I do not see
Ms. Langley, she must have left.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: All right, Glenn, you can proceed.

Rates go up by 1.5 percent for three years. There is no terminating this five-year term, and you cannot get out of it.

District 1 Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: So, I looked at being unable to get out of it for five years. Does that mean we must still pay the lease if the building burns down?

County Attorney Ross: If the building burns down, we will not be obligated to pay the rent. There is a business interruption insurance that the lessor will provide at the lessee's expense, not to exceed \$7,000.00 per year.

Commissioner Ludgood: Wait, wait, wait.

County Attorney Ross: If the building burns down, we will not be obligated to pay the rent.

Commissioner Ludgood: Is that because the landlord is buying business interruption insurance that we will pay?

County Attorney Ross: That is true.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: Does that apply to all acts of God?

County Attorney Ross: It will apply to all acts of God: fire, flood, and hurricane. There is a triple net lease where all the expenses incurred in connection with the building built-out and maintenance for five years will be on the County, except for the structural integrity of the building and the roof. Mr. Tyler was out there and has looked at it. He gave me 10 weeks of structural integrity on the roof, which they are replacing the roof.

Commissioner Ludgood: Wait, I did not hear you; what did you say?

County Attorney Ross: Tyler has not looked at the roof because they are paying for that cost.

Facilities and Maintenance Director Tyler Martin: I just wanted to verify that the owner would replace the roof before we entered the lease, and Jay says that is the case.

County Attorney Ross: This is a triple net lease of all costs. There are ad valorem taxes of \$5,000.00 per year for the built-out, and whatever the Sheriff's Office chooses to do will be paid from their funding, not ours. That will include air conditioning and a warehouse area, and there may be some other expansions of office-type space.

Commissioner Ludgood: Does this lease obligate us to the rent, the cost of ad valorem taxes, and the business interruption insurance premium?

County Attorney Ross: Correct.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: So above and beyond the lease, an additional \$12,000.00 per year.

County Attorney Ross: It does not include utilities. We envisioned the ad valorem taxes to be around \$5,000.00; business interruption insurance another \$5,000.00, \$6,000.00, or \$7,000.00 per year; and other embedded insurance costs. We do not know the cost of utilities.

Commissioner Hudson: Is the insurance cost passed
along to us in the agreement?

County Ross: Yes. The triple net lease.

Commissioner Ludgood: Okay, but that is all in the price, or is that in addition?

County Attorney Ross: In addition to the \$6,700.00 per month for the first year, it goes up 1.5 percent yearly.

President Dueitt: Do we pay ad valorem taxes on
property we own?

County Attorney Ross: No.

President Dueitt: Are we exempt because the Sheriff's
Office will occupy the building?

County Attorney Ross: The County is exempt only for a short-term lease. President Dueitt: Commissioner Ludgood raised the question of whether there were any ordinances against housing dogs and canines inside a building in the Mobile City limits. Did anyone find out?

County Attorney Ross: We did not run that down.

President Dueitt: I do not think there will be a problem because most of the dogs go home with their handlers.

County Attorney Ross: There will not be any long-term
dog handlers.

President Dueitt: Okay, I could not remember.

County Attorney Ross: The Sheriff's Office will make some parking lot improvements, fencing and install an air conditioning system to cover the warehouse area.

President Dueitt: I can tell you that I intend to go back to the design team at Thompson Engineering and maybe reduce some things we can live without to get that price down and rebid.

Commissioner Hudson: Did the rebid include all the alternate deductibles or just the space?

President Dueitt: Matthew can probably answer the question with the exact numbers. I will throw some numbers out, and you correct me if I am wrong. Originally, this is the second time we have rejected this bid. The base bid was around \$13 million the first time, and the alternate bid was about \$15 million.

When that project gets ready, I will have to figure out where to come up with the money to put towards that project.

Commissioner Hudson: Sounds like my life for the last decade.
