MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, December 13, 2021, at 10:00 A.M. The following members of the Commission were present: Merceria Ludgood, President, Connie Hudson and Randall Dueitt, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Ludgood chaired the meeting.

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INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain Phillip Snodgrass, Mobile County Sheriff's Office.

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**Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sherriff:** Good morning, Commissioners. I am here to talk to you on behalf of Mobile County. I recently sent you a request that you pass a resolution to oppose a gun bill that is pending in the State of Alabama Legislature. I want to speak to you on it this morning to explain why I think it is a very dangerous bill. House Bill #6, as well as some other bills, is commonly referred to as Constitutional Carry. It would, in essence, do away with the requirement of having a Concealed Carry Permit, which is a background check on individuals before they are allowed to carry a concealed weapon. If you do away with the Concealed Carry Permit requirement to have an issuance by the sheriff, you'll do away with background checks. People try to say you have a background check when you buy a firearm, but that is not true. All National Instance Criminal Background Check System (NICS) does is check to see if someone is a convicted felon or if someone has been convicted of domestic violence. It doesn't say if someone has been arrested for four (4) or five (5) domestic violence incidents or four (4) or five (5) drug related issues or drinking related issues. It does not say if someone is the town drunk or if someone has been committed to a mental institution. We estimate in Mobile County, there are as many as ten thousand (10,000) firearms stolen out of automobiles over the last few years. Many of which are still floating around on the street. If you do away with this law, many people, especially teenagers and including people who pose a public safety, would be able to carry these weapons. If a police officer stops someone and saw a weapon in the automobile, there would be no reason to seize the weapon to run a check on it and see if the weapon is stolen as they would have a right to possess it. This is dangerous. It's very dangerous.

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That is why myself, Ashley Rich, District Attorney, and every police chief in Mobile County are opposing this bill. If the bill passes, you'll see mayhem unlike what we have seen before. The opponents will say they have studies that state there is not a rise in crime and not an increase in violence, but this is not true. They have not shown any published reports, but I found two (2) published reports. One is from Arizona and one is from Alaska. They have shown a thirteen percent (13%) increase in serious assaults with weapons after they did away with the requirement of Concealed Carry Permit. They'll tell you the people want to have this right, but they're being misleading in the sense they did a poll on Constitutional Carry, which is not a legal term. We have a constitutional right to bear arms, but this is a made-up term that catches people's attention. There are studies that show eighty-eight percent (88%) of people in this country, including Republicans and Democrats equally, believe people should have a background check before having a firearm under concealed carry. I have a few other stats. Last year during 2020, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) recorded the highest increase in murders in this country since 1965. Everyday there are gun shootings, including in the City of Mobile and within Mobile County. This will only get worse. The term Constitutional Carry is a good catchphrase. The right to keep and bear arms is a Second Amendment right, which I think we all support, and it is not an unlimited right. I think it's best put in the words of Antonin Scalia, former Associate Justice of the Supreme Court. He said in a court ruling that states have a right to enact the Constitutional right to keep and bear arms is not unrestricted; no more than the right to freedom of speech that says someone cannot yell fire in a movie theatre and the right to religion does not give someone the right to do a human sacrifice. The law is on our side. This has been a good law and we need it to stay on the books. We don't need this to pass so a few people can take us down. We are asking the County Commission to take a stand with the police chiefs, the district attorney, many others across this country, and myself. Thank you very much.

**Commissioner Randall Dueitt:** Will you address an issue or a concern that's coming up? Can you explain to us what the money from pistol permits is spent on?

**Sam Cochran:** Yes, I can name several things. We issued sixty-three thousand (63,000) permits last year. We turned down seven hundred (700) requests. The seven hundred (700) would consist of the very people I spoke about that do not need to carry a concealed weapon in restaurants, clubs, or sports bars. The money brings in about one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000.00) a year. The money is discretionary as some would say, but we use it on several things that are not discretionary. One of the biggest things that jumps out is the thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000.00) a month we pay

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for smart phone fees, something that can easily be put into a budget. It gave us the opportunity to test smart phones out several years ago to see what type of tool or benefit it would be to officers in the field. Now it is a must-have type of situation. We also use the money to start the drug testing program in Mobile County Public School Systems (MCPSS). We provided the first seed money to get the program started. We buy police gear and things like that. We use it for undercover drug purchases and products. The list goes on and on. There is also the Yellow Dot Program for seniors who may become disabled. We provide support to that program. All of these funds are audited by the State of Alabama every other year, just like our regular funds are. It is not a slush fund. No one personally benefits from it. It goes towards training of our officers. We have proven we have some of the best trained police forces in the southeast because of a lot of abilities to train people to become experts while we get our supervisors and administrators together.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Thank you.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** Just for clarification, the total amount is approximately sixty-three thousand (63,000) permits per year that are issued, is that correct?

**Sam Cochran:** That number is what is current. Permits can be issued for one (1) to five (5) years. We have sixty-three thousand (63,000) current permits. You can estimate it brings in about one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000.00) every year.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Approximately one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000.00) is expended on all of the programs you have?

**Sam Cochran:** Some years will be higher, some years will be lower. It depends on the need. When the Coronavirus 2019 Pandemic began, we didn't have funds to support us initially. We were able to use some of these funds. A few years ago when the Commission cut back on things, we bought automobiles and other items with the funds. When things get tight, we can rely on the permit money. It's not there to supplement the budget, but the reality is that it does supplement the budget from time to time.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Okay.

**President Merceria Ludgood:** Anything else?

**Commissioner Hudson:** That's all the questions I have. I see Shane Stringer, Alabama Representative, District 102, is present at the meeting. I don't know if he would like to offer a few comments. I know Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sherriff, has requested the County Commission to pass a

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resolution in opposition to permitless carry. Certainly, there is a compelling argument. Like everything, I know there is another side.

**Sam Cochran:** Sure.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Before any action is taken, we should hear both sides.

**Sam Cochran:** Of course, the biggest thing is safety of our officers and our citizens. The money is irrelevant.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Safety is our number one concern. You won't find anyone on this Commission who is not in support of safety, both public safety and safety for our law enforcement and first responders. We are completely behind that in any way we possibly can be.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** I have no issue with that. I would love to hear what Shane Stringer, Alabama Representative, District 102, has to say about his bill and his thoughts.

**Sam Cochran:** I think the Association of County Commissions of Alabama (ACCA) has already taken a stance on this as well.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Yes.

**Sam Cochran:** Thank you, Commissioners.

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**President Merceria Ludgood:** We are going to invite Shane Stringer, Alabama Representative, District 102, to speak. We have heard Sam Cochran's, Mobile County Sheriff, position on the matter. We will hear Shane Stringer's position. Then we'll do whatever we have to do. This is not a debate between the two. We are hearing them both out and then whatever is discussed amongst us.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** Right. It may be that we won't be ready to take action today. I don't know what the timeline is. Maybe Shane Stringer, Alabama Representative, District 102, can tell us.

**Shane Stringer, Alabama Representative, District 102:** The session starts on January 11, 2022. We still have a little bit of time.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Okay. Thank you.

**President Ludgood:** Good morning. How are you?

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**Shane Stringer:** Good morning. I am blessed. Thank you for having me. The Constitutional Carry bill I am trying to pass is pretty simple. If someone is legally allowed to purchase and own a gun in the State of Alabama, then the person will be legally allowed to concealed carry without a permit. This bill does not do away with permits. Many people are misleading it to we are getting rid of permits. I have done a lot of homework on this bill before I drafted it. I reached out to all of the sheriffs in all of the states that have Constitutional Carry criteria. Almost every state that has it, permits did not drop. Some dropped, but not much. I do not think this is going to have a major impact on how much money comes into the Sheriff's Department. Many people will continue to purchase permits to cross state lines. At some point, there may be an issue where the United States Supreme Court deems that permits are unconstitutional. At that point, it could have a major impact on our funding. That is not happening at this time. The State of Alabama is already an Open Carry state. There is not a lot of change with this bill. This bill addresses handguns. It does not address long guns such as rifles, assault rifles, shot guns, or anything like that. It only addresses handguns. The same criteria that applies carrying a gun with a permit now in certain places will continue to apply to those same people that are able to carry after that. The truth of the matter is criminals do not adhere to laws. They don't get permits. Criminals are criminals for a reason. They break laws and they do not follow laws. A twenty dollar (\$20.00) piece of plastic is not going to stop a criminal from committing an act against a cop or against anyone else. I have talked to sheriffs in other states. They said crimes against cops did not go up. Crimes dropped in some places as well. Out of twenty-one (21) Constitutional Carry states, only two (2) showed an increase in crime; Alaska being the worst and Arizona being the other. Arizona was very small. I do not have those numbers here with me. I will say the states that have Constitutional Carry have lower crime rates than the states that do not. This bill will not affect us. I was a police officer for thirty (30) years. I have a son who is a cop. I have cousins who are cops. I have thousands of friends who are cops. This absolutely will not affect them. If I thought it would, I would not do it. Last year in the Legislature, we passed a bill for a lifetime permit that included a Prohibited Person Database. In that Prohibited Person Database, cops will now be able to run a tag or a person's name and it will show if someone is not supposed to have a gun. That is what law enforcement needs. As it stands right now, out of the sixty-seven (67) counties throughout the State of Alabama, the sixty-seven (67) sheriff's departments have different permits. If you ask any officer in the county or city, most of them cannot even tell you what the permits look like. If they were shown a fake permit by a convicted murderer with a gun after-hours, they would not know if it's a valid permit. They would most likely allow that

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person to drive off with that gun. Most of the permit offices throughout the State of Alabama are not open after-hours. They are open Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. With most of them, there is not a way for the officers to confirm if the permits are even valid. As far as officer safety, I don't believe that is a valid point. Whenever I pulled over a suspect when I was a police officer, I did not know if they had a permit or a gun in the car unless I asked. Occasionally you would see a gun in the floorboard or something. But what is to stop that person from lying to us? What is to prevent them from saying there is not a gun in the vehicle, they don't have a permit, or they don't need a permit? With the permit system, there was no system in place for officers to run someone that was consistent across the State of Alabama. We attempted to do a database system in the Legislature to give the police officers a better resource. In doing so, we came up with the Prohibited Persons Database instead of tracking legal citizens that own guns. I met with Ashley Rich, Mobile County District Attorney, and went over the scenario and all of the information with her. She agreed that the Prohibited Person Database will be a better tool in the end. Instead of arresting someone on a misdemeanor no pistol permit, a forbidden person on a felony will be arrested instead. That is a better scenario. The other example I'll use is if I came home and left a legally owned gun in my vehicle. If my wife took my vehicle somewhere and was pulled over, she does not have a pistol permit. She would then be arrested on a misdemeanor and taken to jail. My wife is a professional educator. She could lose her job and her career over that arrest. We are arresting law-abiding citizens for situations like that when we should be arresting criminals. That is all I have unless you have any questions. I appreciate you allowing me to speak. Whatever decision you make, I appreciate and respect.

**President Ludgood:** I find it really compelling that law enforcement seems to be standing lockstep against this. What is the importance of this that we need to just go with it as opposed to following the direction law enforcement is providing on it.

**Shane Stringer:** The perception of a few here is very misleading because I get contacted everyday by law enforcement officers thanking me for this. I have been contacted by a lot of sheriffs across the State of Alabama that said this is a good bill. They do not feel there is anything wrong with it and that money is the issue. I don't think we should be taxing people to carry a gun and exercising their right. If we want to continue with that, let's do away with the fee. Let's do it for free. The County Commission pays the Sheriff's Department's expenses. We have done polls and seventy-one percent (71%) of the people polled believe they should be able to carry their weapons without a permit. They feel they should be able to

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carry their weapons without getting permission from a sheriff. That's where the importance is. We as elected officials represent the people. We have to step back sometimes and take away our opinions and what we believe because we represent people. We represent our constituents and we should do what they want. That is exactly what I am doing here. I explained that to Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff. I agree he is doing good things with the money such as the Yellow Dot Program and cell phones for officers. These are good programs. If the Sheriff's Department needs better funding, then we need to find ways to better fund them. It shouldn't be through the legal and law-abiding citizens. That is not the way we should be funding these programs. If we could poll the law enforcement, you would see it isn't as big of a majority as you would think.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Something Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff mentioned that is a concern is if there is a weapon on the floorboard of a vehicle that has been stopped. If your bill were approved, then the law enforcement would not have the ability to check on the weapon as to whether the person is authorized to have it. There is no permit so there would be no reason to check. I think that is a concern. From what I understand with the law and permits being issued the way it is now, if it's determined that is not their weapon, then that would be reason to potentially bring them in. Maybe that person has other charges. You'll have to forgive me as I do not understand all of the ins and outs of what happens when a stop takes place and if a weapon is discovered. My concern is if the law enforcement's hands would be tied to be able to address an issue of a gun that shouldn't be in the possession of that person.

**Shane Stringer:** There are two (2) answers to that. One would be the Prohibited Person Database would address that. If you run someone's name in the car, they're not on the Prohibited Person Database list, and if they have a gun in the car, then that's your probable cause to search their car to address it. The other is law enforcement has been conducting investigative stops since the beginning of time. We do it now and not necessarily for guns. We do it for drugs and for anything else. We hold people on the road for thirty (30) minutes to two (2) hours to conduct an investigative stop. This will not take away that tool. The State of Alabama is already an Open Carry state. The only two (2) places a person cannot carry a gun legally and without a permit is outside of their person if it is covered by a jacket or some other form of clothing or if someone puts it in a vehicle. It doesn't make sense. The only thing being taken away is a person can carry a gun in a car and can carry it on their person covered. As far as locations such as courthouses, schools, or anywhere that has signs up and says people cannot carry now, people will not be able to carry then. This is only going to address a

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very small amount and that is basically carrying in a car and covered.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Something you said that is an issue of concern, if it's happening, is if someone has a permit to have a weapon in the vehicle and someone else is driving the vehicle, if that person is stopped for whatever reason and the weapon is discovered, then that person can be charged with a misdemeanor. Is that sort of thing happening?

**Shane Stringer:** Absolutely.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Do you have any statistics on how many innocent people who just happened to get into a husband's truck, drove off, and then was arrested for a no pistol permit?

**Shane Stringer:** No, I have not been keeping track of the calls that are coming in. I can start.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Maybe this is a state law issue, but maybe the law should address that. People may be innocent and not even realize there is a weapon in the vehicle. They shouldn't be held liable for that and for not having a permit themselves.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** I was a cop for twenty-five (25) years and I have never pulled someone over and found a husband's gun under the seat. There's a lot of officer discretion involved in that.

**Commissioner Hudson:** That is the concern though.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** I would like to see some statistics, if you can get them for me on how many innocent people have been arrested.

**Shane Stringer:** I'll try.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** I have some questions, if you're done.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Go ahead.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Who is going to create and manage the Prohibited Person Database?

**Shane Stringer:** Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA).

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Okay. Are you aware that about ten (10) years ago, there was a law passed for a Scrap Metal Database? As of a year ago, that database is still not being maintained?



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**Shane Stringer:** Yes. I'm also aware that there is a Sex Offender Database that we put them in charge of, and it works. I understand your concern there. The sheriffs may not have any confidence in Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA), but I do. I believe they will get the job done. We have monitored that progress and we are continuing to monitor it.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Okay. If the purpose of your bill is to not get rid of pistol permits, then what is the purpose of your bill?

**Shane Stringer:** The purpose of the bill to not make it a requirement. It should not be a requirement.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** So you want to get rid of pistol permits?

**Shane Stringer:** You can say what you want to say, but no, absolutely not. It's so law-abiding citizens that are legally allowed to purchase and own firearms should not have to get permission from a sheriff to carry their guns.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Okay.

**President Ludgood:** Thank you.

**Shane Stringer:** Thank you.

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**Commissioner Randall Dueitt:** No one will be here to dispute what Danny Corte, Executive Director, Mobile Sports Authority, has to say.

**Danny Corte, Executive Director, Mobile Sports Authority:** Thank you, Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff, for the set up. Good morning, Commissioners and staff. Thank you for allowing me to come in front of you today. What I would like to do today is tell you what our Fiscal Year 2021 was all about. As you know, our fiscal year runs concurrently with both city and county with the October 1st new year. Today I am here to report we had a very good Fiscal Year 2021. The Mobile Sports Authority attracted, supported, or hosted thirty-one (31) sports events during the recently completed year with what generated an estimated twenty-two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$22,400,000.00) of economic impact to our area. That is substantial because it is up from the Coronavirus Pandemic year in Fiscal Year 2020, where we hosted twenty-one (21) events that had a seven million six hundred thousand dollars (\$7,600,000.00) economic impact. As you can see, sports tourism has really come back strong. We believe that will continue. The thirty-one (31) different events involved eighteen (18) different sports, including all age

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brackets. It comprised of events such as cross-country, gymnastics, volleyball, basketball, football, cycling, a turkey calling championship, and an ultimate frisbee tournament. We try to run the gambit on different types of sports. Of the thirty-one (31) events, seventeen (17) are either first or second time events for us here in Mobile County. Fourteen (14) of the thirty-one (31) were youth-oriented events. When I say youth-oriented, it means some or all of the participants are twenty (20) years old or younger. Youth sports are what attracts parents and grandparents and those are economically the gold standard of the sports event industry. That is important as we go forward. As an average over the last five (5) years, even with the down year of Fiscal Year 2020 included, the Mobile Sports Authority has hosted an average of thirty (30) sports events per year. That has generated an estimated economic impact to the Mobile, Alabama area of about eighteen million six hundred thousand dollars (\$18,600,000.00). I know I'm throwing a lot of numbers here, but as you can see, sports tourism is a very strong component of our overall tourism business. It will probably continue to be an even more important part. To cap off Fiscal Year 2021, our largest event was held on September 25, 2021 at Ladd-Peebles Stadium. It was the Gulf Coast Challenge, which had Tuskegee and Alabama A&M playing here. We had roughly seventeen thousand (17,000) attendees, which generated about five million six hundred thousand dollars (\$5,600,000.00) in economic impact to the Mobile, Alabama area. It was very substantial. It is our largest annual event in the area and for Mobile Sports Authority. We are proud of what we have done, but we couldn't do it without the investment of the Mobile County Commission and the City of Mobile helping us in what we do. We try to turn that money around. In this past year, the return was twenty-two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$22,400,000.00). We could not do this without your support, not only financially but also logistically, physically, emotionally, or however you want to say it. Again, I want to thank you very much. We will probably release these results publicly tomorrow. I wanted to mention this to you first. Thank you so much.

**President Merceria Ludgood:** Thank you, Danny Corte, Executive Director, Mobile Sports Authority. Congratulations.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** It's always good to hear the good news.

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**President Merceria Ludgood:** I just want to suggest we add the resolution regarding this legislation to our December 28, 2021 agenda.

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**Commissioner Randall Dueitt:** I'll second that motion.

**President Ludgood:** I'm not making a motion. I am just asking we put it on the agenda and we'll deal with it then.

**Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator:** Okay.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** The only thing I want to add is that I appreciate the deputies being here. Y'all are welcome to come here anytime for whatever reason you're here. I appreciate what you guys do every day.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** I second that. Thank you.

**President Ludgood:** I think Commissioner Dueitt speaks for all of us. We appreciate you.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Shane Stringer, Alabama Representative, District 102 and Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff, thank you guys for being here.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Absolutely.

**Commissioner Dueitt:** Thank you for what you do for our state.

**Commissioner Hudson:** People may not always agree, but I think in their hearts, everyone is trying to do the right thing. They're trying to do it for the right reasons. I think everyone concerned here is looking to improve the safety of not only law enforcement but the citizens. I appreciate you. Sometimes it's good to have a difference of opinions so you can learn.
