MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Tuesday, December 28, 2021, at 9:30 A.M. The following members of the Commission were present: Merceria Ludgood, President, Connie Hudson and Randall Dueitt, Members. Also present were E. Edwin Kerr, Deputy County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Ludgood chaired the meeting.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain Phillip Snodgrass, Mobile County Sheriff's Office.

Larry Andrews, Director, Miss Mobile Bay Scholarship Organization: Thank you for having us this morning. I hope everybody had a Merry Christmas and will have a Happy New Year. I am the director of the Miss Mobile Bay Scholarship Organization. We are affiliated with Miss Alabama Organization and Miss America Organization. We are happy to say in 2022, Miss Alabama and Miss America are celebrating their one hundredth (100th) anniversary. Just a couple of weeks ago, we crowned our one hundredth (100th), who was Miss Alaska. She took home over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) in scholarships. Even more proud than that is Miss Alabama, who is from Gulf Shores, Alabama, was first runner-up and took home over forty-two thousand dollars (\$42,000.00). It's quite different today to have a crown and a banner sitting in front of you, where you think she is more of a beauty queen. Miss America is a service organization. It started out as a public relations (P.R.) to bring new business to the Jersey Shore in New Jersey. It has turned into the number one (#1) women's scholarship awarding company in the world. We are very proud of their accomplishments in the Miss America Organization. A couple of years ago, we started the Miss Mobile Bay Scholarship Organization. here today to introduce our winners for this year. I am also asking for your support to support our young women and our future leaders of the City of Mobile, the State of Alabama, and the United States of America. We are very excited with that. We are working on gaining and getting more scholarship money. We would like to thank Commissioner Connie Hudson for the support she gave us this year. If you are looking for some wonderful young leaders and wonderful young women to help you in the community in the City of Mobile and in the Mobile Bay area, I have three

(3) for you who are very excited to work. They all have a platform. It's called the Social Impact Initiative. It is something they feel strongly about and that they educate the public with. They go out to schools and businesses. I am going to let each of these young women tell you a little bit about themselves, what they are working on, and how they prepare for the Miss Alabama competition. The Miss Alabama Competition is in July 2022 and the Outstanding Teen Program is in March 2022. We would love for you to follow these young women and our organization on our Facebook page. If you would like to hear more about it, I would love to share that with you. Now, without further ado, we have three (3) wonderful young women to speak to you.

Brianna Burrell, Miss Mobile Bay 2022: Good morning, everyone. I have the honor of serving and representing our great city as Miss Mobile Bay 2022. Before we get started, I would love to interact with you guys. I am going to ask a series of questions. If you answered yes to any of them, raise your hand. Raise your hand if you have ever spent a hot Mobile, Alabama summer playing with a Super Soaker Water Gun. Raise your hand if you have ever placed a call on speakerphone. Raise your hand if you have ever stopped at a red traffic light? All hands need to be raised. you raised your hand to any of these questions, congratulations. You have benefited from inventions previously crafted by the minds and hands of people of color. This is monumental, especially because at their creation, education and career opportunities were not accessible to them. Years have passed and much progress has been made, yet we still face similar inequalities in education. As we progress to new frontiers in education in science, technology, engineering, and math grow in interest, but not in opportunities. My social impact is Save-A-STEM, encouraging students of color to get into Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) engagement. I focused on three (3) points: funding, representing, and encouragement. We must advocate for adequate funding and resources for their classrooms. We must increase representation of minorities in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) career fields. We must have a positive and engaging learning environment for the students. My plan of action is a three (3) step phase, which is achievable with the support of each and every one of you. Step one begins with #TourTheSTEM. It is Mobile County Public School System (MCPSS) for local businesses, companies, and organizations that work in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) careers to expose our students to the world of opportunities right here on the Gulf Coast. Step two focuses on raising funds for scholarships for students of color in pursuit of Science, Technology, Engineering,

and Mathematics (STEM) degrees. It also raises funds for supplies for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) teachers so their attention is on their students, not their bank account. Step three (3) is a development of volunteer teams that go out into schools to help our students firsthand to show that their education is a valuable quality and it is valued by us. We as a community must invest in the future generation of engineers, doctors, technology, Chief Executive Officers (CEOs), inventors, and creators. The world flourishes when educational exploration is awarded to all. I ask you today to join the change and help my social impact by connecting with me. We can work together by connecting with me on my social platform. Thank you for your time. Together we can build the tomorrow of Mobile, Alabama today.

President Merceria Ludgood: Thank you.

Sydnee Cantley, Miss Mobile Bay's Outstanding Teen 2022: Thank you so much. Good morning, everybody. Thank you for having us. We really appreciate it. I am a junior at Fairhope High School. I recently won the title of Miss Mobile Bay's Outstanding Teen and I will be competing at Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen in March 2022, which is all a part of the Miss America Organization as Larry Andrews, Director, Miss Mobile Bay Organization, said. It's about empowering young women as the number one largest provider of scholarships to young women today. My platform is adolescent wellness checkups where it promotes the importance of parents taking their children to their yearly wellness checkup. This also applies to adults as well but I mainly specify on children. When I was a freshman in high school, I went to my yearly wellness checkup. My doctor noticed that one side of my neck was larger than the other. After many tests and biopsies, I was diagnosed with thyroid cancer and Hashimoto's Disease. Thyroid cancer is extremely rare in children and is usually only found in adults. Hashimoto's Disease is an autoimmune disorder that destroys the thyroid. I had a double whammy. I had two (2) surgeries. One (1) was in November 2019, where I had the left side removed. In April 2021, I had my second surgery. If it wasn't for a wellness checkup, we would be talking about a completely different story. I am blessed to say today that I am cancer-free. The importance of going to your yearly wellness checkup is because it can diagnose diseases in early stages, you can get preventative care, learn healthy behaviors, keep immunizations current, and improve your quality of life. Not only does this go for physical health, but mental health is just as important. Ever since the first wellness checkup I went to during my freshman year of high school, I have talked to my friends, my friends' parents, and teachers about how important it is. Even one of my closest friends will ask

her doctor to check her thyroid at her wellness checkup because she is now more aware of this situation. Even though there are people who do not go to their yearly wellness checkup, ninety-nine percent (99%) of insurance companies offer free wellness checkups because it is a form of preventative care. It is so important. My journey has inspired me to go into the medical field and become an endocrinologist one day. I want to attend the University of Alabama in Birmingham, Alabama. Thanks to the Miss America Organization and their scholarship program, I believe I will be able to get there one day. Hopefully sharing my story with others can help prevent waiting too long for a diagnosis. I hope you can share my story with others to help prevent a late diagnosis. Thank you so much for having us today.

Finley Richardson, Miss Coastal Alabama's Outstanding Teen 2022: It is nice to meet all of you. I am a junior at Saraland High School. I live in District 1 in Saraland. I am happy to represent the whole coast down here. Something that is heavy on my heart is reading and how it impacts children. I never see my dad without a book. At football games, he will come to support me as the school's mascot and he is reading a book. I have always had a very prominent example of what it is like to have a good book on hand. I started Reading Empowers Achievement and Development (READ). What I have tried to do so far is get into the school systems around me. I have been in Saraland and in Chickasaw. I want to incentivize reading. Kids will ask me questions and they'll get candy and books. have been collecting a lot of books and a lot of sponsorships to help provide for these kids and to help them create a desire to read like I have. I think it's a real fire and imagination you get when you pick up a good book. In the future, I would like to get into the Mobile County Public School System (MCPSS). I am always looking to connect with people. I am hoping to also spread into Washington County and get into their school system. I am looking into getting into middle schools since I have been primarily in elementary schools. I think I am ready to tackle the fifth, sixth, and seventh graders. I hope through this process of getting ready for Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen competition in March 2022, that I can inspire children and anyone else I come across to know that reading is the way to get the best version of yourself. Thank you.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: I'd like to thank Larry Andrews, Director, Miss Mobile Bay Organization and these young ladies for joining us here today. It is just amazing

to see such young women who are so well spoken, who have such composure, and have a focus on things in our community and in life that are so very important. They seem very wise and mature well beyond their years. We wish you the very best in all of your future endeavors and in your scholarship program. We will stay tuned. We support you and look forward to your next step. Thank you for being here today.

Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff: Good morning, Commissioners. I'm sorry I was late. I thought the meeting started at 10:00 A.M.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: She did too.

Sam Cochran: Okay. I'm keeping good company.

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: Don't feel bad.

Sam Cochran: I will be very brief. I want to thank you for taking the time to examine the issues behind the referendum you're going to vote on this morning. Thank you for getting involved in that. I think it's very important to our community. There's probably not a day that goes by that I don't see where we utilize this as a tool. I saw yesterday in the City of Mobile where there were some car break-ins and some people ran into the woods. Of course, one of them had a gun, which was probably stolen from a I'm not sure, but it allowed them to arrest him for no pistol permit while it was determined where the gun came from and things of that nature. I know we had another murder last night in the City of Mobile. I am concerned for our youth and we have to keep the guns out of their hands. Thank you very much.

Commissioner Hudson: Thank you.

Commissioner Dueitt: Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff, thank you. You're taking a beating on this. It's nationwide and all over the county. I am in the same ship as you. Being a former law enforcement officer, I think pistol permits are a tool that law enforcement uses every day. I know why the stance you're taking and other sheriffs across the State of Alabama are taking is not a popular stance with some people. I want to thank you because I read the articles from as far away as the Houston Chronicle. This week I read articles bashing you and your almost fifty (50) years of law enforcement for standing up for what is right. I appreciate it.

Sam Cochran: Thank you.

Commissioner Hudson: This is a matter the County Commission doesn't have legal authority to approve or disapprove. Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff, contacted us to take a position in support of him opposing any legislation that would eliminate permits for concealed carry. Two (2) of the three (3) of us on this Commission do not have boots on the ground law enforcement experience where we have been out making car stops and investigating guns that may be encountered. All we can do in terms of formulating opinions is to rely on the people who do have that experience, who do have boots on the ground such as the sheriff, the district attorney, and others who do this on a daily basis. I know there is discussion both ways about whether it follows the Constitution and whether it should be legal or not. For me, it really boils down to if this is a tool, any tool that law enforcement can use to keep citizens safe, then I would prefer to err on the side of supporting that position to continue these permits. I don't have the personal experience in dealing with it, but all I know to do is to rely on those who do. Because Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff, has asked us to step up and address this in terms of a statement, I think that is where we are today. Our attorney has drafted a statement that he will read when we get to that item on the agenda.

President Merceria Ludgood: Let's take Agenda Item #3 out of order, so if Sam Cochran, Mobile County Sheriff, wants to leave, then he can go on and handle the rest of his business today.
