### MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Monday, May 22, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Connie Hudson, President, Randall Dueitt and Merceria Ludgood, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

#### INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Pastor Travis Johnson, Lead Pastor, Pathway Church, 7200 Moffett Road, Mobile, Alabama 36618.

Commission President Connie Hudson: Thank you, Pastor Johnson. I have a note that you are joined this morning by Erica Luke, your executive assistant.

Pastor Travis Johnson, Pathway Church: My assistant did not make it. This is my middle child McKenna. She will graduate from Faith Academy this week and attend college in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

President Hudson: Congratulations, and thank you both
for being here today.

The Mobile County Commission, at its conference on Thursday, May 18, 2023, presented a resolution to Eric Beck, Division Vice Commander, United States Coast Guard Auxiliary.

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# PRESENT RESOLUTION/DESIGNATE MAY 20, 2023 THROUGH MAY 26, 2023/SAFE BOATING WEEK IN MOBILE COUNTY, ALABAMA

WHEREAS, many Mobile County residents engage in boating, fishing, and other recreational activities on the navigable waters around the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, on average, six hundred (600) people die each year in boating-related accidents in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the vast majority of these accidents are caused by human error or poor judgment and not by the boat, equipment, or environmental factors; and

WHEREAS, alcohol use is the leading known contributing factor in fatal boating accidents; it was reported as the leading factor in two hundred forty-seven (247) accidents resulting in eighty-six (86) deaths nationwide in 2021; and

WHEREAS, operator inattention and inexperience are also leading contributing factors in mishaps, causing hundreds of accidents and dozens of fatalities annually; and

WHEREAS, the United States Coast Guard considers operator use of engine cut-off switches to be important because when operators of powerboats are ejected or fall overboard, the boat will typically continue to operate until it runs out of fuel, runs around, or collides with other boats/objects; and

WHEREAS, a significant number of boaters who lose their lives by drowning each year would be alive today had they worn their life jackets; and

WHEREAS, boating safety courses and boating safety campaigns can teach people how to adhere to better boating practices and help them to boat more safely; and

WHEREAS, according to statistics from the United States Coast Guard, of the accidents where the level of operator education was known, seventy-five percent (75%) of boating deaths occurred on boats where the boat operator had never received boating education instruction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Mobile County Commission designates May 20, 2023 through May 26, 2023 as Safe Boating Week in Mobile County, Alabama; in conjunction with the United States Coast Guard's Safe Boating Campaign and its year-round efforts to encourage safe recreational boating, and encourage residents and visitors to be prepared and courteous boaters, and above all, to wear approved floatation devices.

Eric Beck, Division Vice Commander: Ladies and Gentlemen, thank you all so much. Boating safety is critical in Mobile County and the State of Alabama. Many folks have come out onto the waters since the COVID-19 pandemic, and we just want to make sure that everybody's doing it safely. Folks outside driving and being on the water in a power vehicle are the same thing; they both need training. Unfortunately, folks think that all they have to do is get out there, put some gas in it, and go. Thank you all so much for working to make sure that the citizens of Mobile County need to know the value of training and safety out there on the waters. Thank you all.
