Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, county administrator/clerk of the commission, Jay Ross, county attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, county engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

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**Commission President Connie Hudson:** Do we have any speakers signed in this morning?

**Public Affairs Director Sharee Broussard:** Yes, we have one speaker signed in this morning, Cindy Knowlton from Alabama Cooperative Extension Services, and she brought a flyer for each of you.

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**Commission President Connie Hudson:** Good morning.

**Cindy Knowlton, county extension coordinator, Alabama Cooperative Extension Services:** I thank all of you for your continual support of our programs and everything you do for us. I just really want to express one of our programs, the Master Gardener Volunteer Program. I just wanted to share with all of you the presence that they have here in Mobile County, not only within the city limits but outside as well. I am just going to read a quick list of some of the places where they are doing great things as far as programs, demonstrations, gardens, and workshops. We have a presence at the James T. Strickland Youth Center, Market in the Park, Mobile Japanese Garden, Youth at Taylor Park Community Center, Ben May Main Library, the Semmes Senior Center, the Satsuma Community Garden Park, and Bragg-Mitchell Mansion. We are part of Keep Saraland Beautiful, Full Life Ahead Foundation with the Mobile Arts Council, the Grow More Give More Program, Mobile Urban Growers, the Highpoint Park, Bellefontaine Garden Club, Methodist Inner City Programs, Feeding the Gulf Coast, Leflore High School, many, many schools, and the Mobile Botanical Gardens. We also have a presence at the Festival of Flowers annually, and one of our newer projects will be gardening with the residents at the Mulherin Home, so they are doing great things. They are, and we are getting ready in August to start our new intern class for the fall, and the class is full. We have 25 to 26 interns, and we are just excited to have all of those new interns come in and then, after a 14-week program, they go out and work with their programs in their communities. Another thing I would like to share is that I recently had a great visit with Mobile County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) and spoke with Doug Cooper. We are partnering to work together on programming weather radio distributions, preparedness, and awareness. So, I am looking forward to that, and we know that residents throughout the County, whether in Bayou La Batre, Semmes, Mount Vernon, Wilmer, Georgatown, downtown, or the metro area. Some folks benefit from our programs, so I look forward to working with Doug Cooper and his team. Another thing is that we have our Annual 2023 Grassroots Meeting, and rather than have our annual formal meeting, it will be an open house where you can just pop in and meet our agents. We will have refreshments, and share your



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needs with us. We are going to have a DOT-voting with posters throughout the auditorium area and share with us some of the needs that they feel they have, whether they be small or large here in the County or in specific communities where they feel our agents could be of service as far as educational programs or possibly workshops demonstrations. Come and meet our agents. We have several new agents. Our urban center side has grown with the hiring of three new agents recently, and so that will be on Thursday, July 13, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. either pop in before you go to lunch or pop in when you have finished your lunch if you have the opportunity. We would love for you to come out and visit. One last thing I want to share is that this Thursday, June 29, 2023, is our annual Watermelon Promotion, so we will descend on Mobile Government Plaza and visit all of you with our watermelons from Grand Bay. Thank you again for your continual support. We appreciate it very much. Any comments?

**President Hudson:** Thank you so much for being here. I knew the Master Gardeners were a busy group, but I did not realize they had a presence in so many different places throughout the community.

**Cindy Knowlton:** We do.

**President Hudson:** Great work.

**Cindy Knowlton:** Thank you.

**President Hudson:** How many members overall do you have in the program?

**Cindy Knowlton:** Our list is about 300, Commissioner Hudson, but active, we have about 100 super active.

**President Hudson:** So they are very active then, and their presence is in all the places you mentioned, but it sounds like there is plenty of interest in people coming through the program.

**Cindy Knowlton:** Yes.

**President Hudson:** Those programs, are they annually? How often do you have a Master Gardener planting program?

**Cindy Knowlton:** It had been annually because our regional agent was serving Baldwin and Mobile Counties, but within the last two months, Baldwin County hired an individual horticulture agent, so now we have Jack Lee Kroy all to ourselves, plus three more smaller counties like Washington, Clark, and Monroe. I think he may be looking at doing two annual intern classes, which would be great.

**Cindy Knowlton:** Wonderful, great, and thank you.

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to join and participate in a joint application with Blount, Bullock, Butler, Calhoun, Chambers, Cherokee, Chilton, Choctaw, Cleburne, Coffee, Cullman, Elmore, Etowah, Greene, Hale, Henry, Jackson, Lamar, Lauderdale, Lawrence, Lee, Macon, Madison, Marion, Marshall, Perry, Pike, Shelby, St. Clair, Sumter, Tuscaloosa, and Winston Counties (Partnership) to develop, through the help of an engineering consultant AECOM of Birmingham, a Planning Grant for the Bridge Investment Program; and that the County understands and agrees to the following:



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1. The expected cost to participate in the joint Planning Grant application is \$1,212.00 per county; and
