#### MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, January 10, 2022, at 10:00 A.M. The following members of the Commission were present: Merceria Ludgood, President, Connie Hudson and Randall Dueitt, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and Kim Sanderson, Assistant County Engineer. President Ludgood chaired the meeting.

#### INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Chaplain Phillip Snodgrass, Mobile County Sheriff's Office.

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# PRESENTATION/LOVE YOUR COMMUNITY/PROJECT GRANT AWARDS

President Merceria Ludgood: We have some guests with us this morning. First, we would like to call to the podium Evelyn DeAngelo, Project Coordinator, Love Your Community, for Love Your Community project grant awards. Did you have anything you wanted to say, Commissioner Connie Hudson, as she is coming?

Commissioner Connie Hudson: I am very proud that she is here today along with two (2) of our teams that will be receiving grant money. These are the first two (2) to receive the money and they have some great projects. I know Evelyn DeAngelo, Project Coordinator, Love Your Community, is here today to talk about them and she has brought some checks along with her. At the appropriate time, we'll all step down and have our picture taken with the teams.

Evelyn DeAngelo, Project Coordinator, Love Your Community: Thank you so much. Good morning. I appreciate you guys having us today. Love Your Community has been growing since we relaunched in April 2021. I am so excited to announce that we currently have sixty-one (61) teams serving all across Mobile County. Today we are going to recognize two (2) of our teams who have earned fifty (50) or more hours collecting litter and working on beautification projects in their communities.

The first team we are going to recognize today is the Litter Ladies, who work in our Oakley Community. They work so hard to help pick up and clean up along their streets.

They are selflessly donating their grant project funds for recycling bins at Wilmer Hall to help their sustainability program and education program that we're working on with the families and children at Wilmer Hall. We are excited for that team and for their project. They have already started more hours. They're not slowing down. They're going right back to work more.

Our second team is working on Dauphin Island. They have a big heart for our beaches and for cleaning them up. They have spent all of their time and hours down there. Their project will go towards beautification around a memorial bench that will be placed at the Dauphin Island Marina.

We're very excited to have this across Mobile County. We're excited for the teams that have reached their goals. We have so many other teams that have reached the fifty (50) hour mark, but they keep going. They have their eyes on a bigger prize. I cannot wait to recognize those other teams at a later date. Today we have Sally Irving with the Litter Ladies and Courtney Latham with Dauphin Island Team A.

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#### PRESENTATION/VIGOR HIGH SCHOOL/ 2021 4A STATE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONS

The Vigor High School Football team and coaches were presented with certificates to congratulate them on their 2021 4A State Football Championship win.

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Theodore Arthur, Jr., Clotilda Direct Descendants Association: Good morning. I would like to say thank you for allowing me to speak this morning. I came to talk to you about our situation with music in Mobile, Alabama. We are one hundred fifty (150) miles from New Orleans, Louisiana. On any given day, there are at least three thousand (3,000) musicians playing over there and are making money. I doubt there are five (5) or six (6) in Mobile, Alabama who are able to do that. I would like to start a foundation to recognize those who have gone before me, like my band director, Fred Wesley, and others who have played with some of the most famous people in the world. Fred and I have probably played with more professional artists in the world than anybody. There was John "Jabo" Starks and several others that also came before us. want to do is see if we can raise the level of musicianship here. We are so far behind everybody that we can't get paid unless we have something to offer. It's unfortunate that the music scene is fading away. I want to do something about that. I want to help keep the name of

jazz, blues, gospel, and country music so it'll continue to be on the scene in this part of the country. We need to train our people about the art of the music business. It's the business, not just a play thing. It's serious business. People come to Mobile, Alabama and make large sums of money, but we can hardly get a piece of bread for our people here. I want to see that change because we are not professional enough. We don't have anything to offer that will demand a decent salary. It's something that can be taken care of. With a little hard work and some dedication, I'm looking for some real talented people to train and show them what we have learned. We have people like Fred Wesley, who was James Brown's band leader, that are willing to come back and help us with this. We need a lot of assistance, money, grants, and anything we can get. We need buildings and a whole lot of instruments. They cost a lot of money. That is why I am here today. I was doing okay until my mother became sick for thirteen (13) years and passed away. She didn't want to go to a nursing home. I had to give up my career to come home and take care of her. That's the reason why I am here asking for some help today. Otherwise, I would have done it myself. Thank you and I hope we can get some help.

President Merceria Ludgood: Thank you, Mr. Arthur. We appreciate all that you have done both now and throughout the years. You have been telling the same story for a while and have been trying to bring awareness. You have done what you can to show the quality of musicians that we have here in Mobile, Alabama. You have shown yourself and you have also encouraged the younger artists. I just want to say that we really appreciate the efforts you have made in that regard to this community.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: Thank you for sharing your music with us this morning.

Theodore Arthur, Jr.: It's a pleasure. Y'all take care. Everybody be safe and be kind to each other because we are judged by the way we treat others.

Andrew Counts, Windtree Home Owners Association: Good morning. I am here to represent the Windtree Home Owners Association. It is at the south end of Schillinger Road. What I am here to do today is to express concern over the traffic situation on Schillinger Road. I have three (3) points to make. The most important one to our subdivision has to do with speeding and visibility. Windtree Subdivision is probably at the highest point on the south end of Schillinger Road. Because of the retaining walls that were built when Schillinger Road was renovated, the visibility is somewhat limited by cars that have a lower stance. In December 2021, someone was hit while they were coming out of the subdivision. I believe that is a twofold problem. One that has to do with speeding; in other words,

speed control, which is a problem on Schillinger Road. The other one is just visibility. I wanted to bring that to the Commission's attention and perhaps get some feedback or be referred to somebody like Matthew Barclift, Engineering Development Manager or Tom Waters, Inspection Services Director for some other feedback that I can give back to the residents of Windtree Subdivision.

The second point I would like to make is on the south end of Schillinger Road, there is now a center lane for turning to both the west and east. Coming in and out of the subdivision, some of that creates a traffic conflict where vehicles are head-on. That has been pretty well mitigated at the north end. A good example of how to mitigate that inexpensively is the Walmart at Airport Boulevard and Schillinger Road. They moved the traffic light and put a little soft partition in there so drivers can only enter and exit from certain directions. That certainly would help where you have people trying to enter Schillinger Road from the east and the west and from those subdivisions.

The third point I would like to make is that sometimes we have drag racing on Schillinger Road. You're probably aware of that. It typically happens on the weekends. I have personally witnessed it twice. I was almost hit head-on because someone was in the center lane turning and one of the drag racers was trying to use the center lane to race. To avoid traffic, he went into the wrong lane. Fortunately, he didn't hit anybody thanks to the vehicle that was next to me who did a stunt driver maneuver. One of the ways to mitigate that is not just traffic control and the police would be to do something like what was done to one of the highways to the north, where we could score the center lane with divots in the middle that warn people they are not supposed to be there.

Those are the three (3) points I wanted to bring to your attention. We have already had accidents. We have had fatalities. We had at least one (1) fatality last year. We had this recent accident in December 2021. My concern is just to help the folks in our subdivision, some of which are older, get in and out of the subdivision without getting hit by people who are driving at excessive speeds. If you have any feedback for me that I can take back to the Windtree Home Owners Association, I would appreciate that now.

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: My assistant, Dani Moore, District 3 Administrator and I have been in communication with you and some other people in your subdivision as well as the subdivision just to the south of you. We have started to take some actions and if you have a moment, I would ask Kim Sanderson, Assistant County Engineer, to address some of the actions we have taken and some other actions that we are going to look at in the future. I am sure she has taken notes on some of your advice and things that may help.

Andrew Counts: Okay. Do you want to do that
afterwards?

Commissioner Dueitt: I think Kim Sanderson, Assistant County Engineer had some things prepared to speak about this morning.

Andrew Counts: Good.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: About this issue?

Commissioner Dueitt: Yes.

Commissioner Hudson: Okay.

Commissioner Dueitt: It'll be brief.

**Commissioner Hudson:** If you can speak now or meet with Andrew Counts after the Commission Meeting. Whichever you prefer.

Kim Sanderson, Assistant County Engineer: We can do both. I can speak a little bit and then we can meet afterwards.

Andrew Counts: Yes. Perhaps you can clarify now and I'll go sit down and listen.

Kim Sanderson: For your knowledge, I am the Assistant County Engineer. W. Bryan Kegley II is the County Engineer and he is out of town today. He and I along with Brad Whitman, Traffic Engineer, are aware of the excessive speed problems on Schillinger Road. We have been talking about what we can do to slow people down. The issue is not a design flaw with Schillinger Road. It is designed correctly if people drive according to the posted speed limit. Unfortunately, a lot of people are choosing not to. One of the things we have done is a traffic study at the subdivision south of yours to see if a traffic signal may be warranted. At this time, it's not. We're in the process of doing a traffic study around Windtree Subdivision to see if a traffic signal would be warranted there. I can't answer that yet as we are not done with it. That is one thing we have been looking at. Another thing I think you have seen is that we painted the speed limit onto the lane itself to make it more visible. As you know, sometimes people choose to not see those things. We have on order flashing beacons that will flash your speed if you're speeding over a set amount, such as five (5) to ten (10) miles over the speed limit. It will flash the speed being driven and warn the driver to slow down. It has been on order for a little bit now. Once they come in, they will be installed. We are going to give those a little bit of time and then we'll go back and do the speed studies again. We'll look at the data and we will stay on that to

see if traffic signals are warranted. As of right now, they are not. That's what we have in the works.

Andrew Counts: I think those are good suggestions. As I said, there are some other soft things you can do. I don't know if you have thought about or if people have addressed the situation with traffic going into the median lane as they are turning different directions along with how people enter it to travel on it like it's a third lane. If some soft barriers could be constructed or if you would consider that, it might be an option. Maybe there's something negative associated that we don't understand. It would be appreciated.

Kim Sanderson: We have not that I am aware of. That
is something we could look into.

Andrew Counts: You know the S barrier at Walmart? That's an excellent soft barrier that's not expensive.

Kim Sanderson: Sure. We're looking at kinds of ideas because we are aware of the speeding.

Andrew Counts: It also prevents speeders who want to use that as a passing lane.

Kim Sanderson: Yes, sir.

Andrew Counts: Thank you for your time. I appreciate the input.

Kim Sanderson: If you want to talk more, we can get together after the meeting.

Andrew Counts: I think I'm fine with this. We'll communicate with e-mail. I think we've been doing that.

Kim Sanderson: I think you have been talking with Brad Whitman, Traffic Engineer. Again, I am Kim Sanderson, Assistant County Engineer, and you can talk with any of us.

Andrew Counts: It's nice to meet you folks and we look forward to dealing directly with you. Thank you.

Commissioner Dueitt: Mr. Counts, thank you for coming and taking your time to come down to speak with us today.

The updated boundary lines were prepared in accordance with the 2020 Decennial Census with the guidelines for redrawing districts, which require boundaries to be contiguous and comply with Federal Voting Rights Act requirements.

The Commission district boundary goal is for equal representation at one-third of the County population in each district. Between 2010 and 2020, the following took place:

- District 1 lost 10,182 persons
- District 2 gained 6,884 persons
- District 3 gained 5,115 persons

Therefore, the Mobile County Commission district boundary lines have been redrawn to even out the population in each district.

- District 1 will have 138,197 persons
- District 2 will have 138,175 persons
- District 3 will have 138,437 persons

which represents 0.04% difference between district populations. New Mobile County Commission boundaries will take effect immediately and will remain in effect at least through the 2030 Census.

Kim Sanderson, Assistant County Engineer: The Rebuild Alabama Act (Act 2019-2) provides funding for expenditures on materials, construction, and the inspection of the

construction of roadway and bridge projects. For FY 2021 Mobile County expended \$2,361,866.00 on Rebuild Alabama projects.

The status of FY 2021 projects is as follows:

- Dawes Road (Scott Dairy Loop Road northward to Cottage Hill Road) will utilize Federal Aid Exchange Funds in the amount of \$400,000.00 from FY 2020 and FY 2021 for a total of \$800,000.00. This funding will be combined with remaining federal aid funds that were previously made available to Mobile County through Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), and also 2014 Pay-As-You-Go funding, if needed. The project was bid March 26, 2021 and is currently under construction. It is expected to be completed this Spring. There were no Rebuild Alabama expenditures for this project in FY 2021.
- Sollie Road Resurfacing was bid October 14, 2020, and construction is almost complete. Total expenditures in FY 2021 were \$1,909,954.00.
- Sam Lewis Road Resurfacing was bid September 30, 2020 and construction is complete. Total expenditures in FY 2021 were \$481,108.00.
- Fiber Road Widening & Resurfacing was assigned to an engineering consultant and plans are complete. Mobile County has been working with the Norfolk Southern Corporation and Federal Railroad Administration for approval of an agreement prior to proceeding to construction. There were no Rebuild Alabama expenditures for this project in FY 2021.
- Sand Ridge Road Resurfacing was assigned to an engineering consultant and plans are complete. Mobile County will take construction bids on January 19, 2022. There were no Rebuild Alabama expenditures for this project in FY 2021.
- Sunset Road Bridge Replacement was bid March 31, 2021, but due to labor and material issues, the start of construction was delayed. Construction began January 3, 2022. There were no Rebuild Alabama expenditures for this project in FY 2021.
- Creola-Axis Loop Road North was assigned to an engineering consultant and plans are nearly complete. The County will take construction bids later this year. There were no Rebuild Alabama expenditures for this project in FY 2021.
- Road Construction Material purchases were made in the amount of \$789,804.00 during FY 2021, for resurfacing of county roads by county public works crews. The County purchased materials from four (4) contractors.

In accord with Act 2019-2, we request that the entire engineering report be entered into the Commission Minutes. We will have the report posted on the County's website. There were a lot of projects. Thank you.

Commissioner Hudson moved, seconded by Commissioner Dueitt, that the Board accept the County Engineer's written report of the FY 2021 Mobile County Transportation Plan expenditures. Preliminary engineering costs for the noted projects are funded by the County's general fund. Construction and construction inspection costs are funded by the County Rebuild Alabama Fund (CRAF) and the Federal Aid Exchange Fund (FAEF), provided by ACT 2019-2 (Rebuild Alabama Act).

They allow it to sit for a certain amount of time, so

Commissioner Hudson: No, this is for Phase Two and the two (2) fields that will be built in it.

Commissioner Dueitt: Okay.

Commissioner Hudson: This is a lot of money to spend for that, but fortunately, these are the only fields that are going to require it.

Commissioner Dueitt: I appreciate that. I had not
had an opportunity to read it.

Commissioner Hudson: I have never heard of the word surcharge as associated with any kind of groundwork until this project popped up. I know it well now.
