MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama on Monday, January 23, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Connie Hudson, President, Randall Dueitt and Merceria Ludgood, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Hudson chaired the meeting.

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INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Pastor Vincent Robinson, Right Way Christian Center Church, 4712 Moffett Road, Mobile, Alabama 36618.

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**President Connie Hudson:** Thank you, Pastor Robinson. We appreciate you being here with us today.

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**President Connie Hudson:** This morning, the Commission has a number of honored guests that we would like to recognize. We have invited members of the law enforcement representatives from across Mobile County to join us this morning in order to express our grateful appreciation and to give our thanks to them for their service, their dedication in serving and protecting our community and all of our citizens.

Typically in the month of January, we have Law Enforcement Appreciation Day. It's Law Enforcement Appreciation Month, and really, every month should be. We just thought this was a great opportunity. It's certainly a very appropriate opportunity to invite all of you representing your departments to be here today so we can express our very deep appreciation for all that you do. We know that you put your lives on the line every day. It does not go unnoticed or unappreciated. We have for each of you a Law Enforcement Appreciation Day resolution, and I'll read that.

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PRESENT RESOLUTION/PROCLAIM JANUARY 23,  
2023 AS LAW ENFORCEMENT APPRECIATION DAY

**WHEREAS**, National Law Enforcement Appreciation Day was founded in 2015, to recognize officers across the country for the daily sacrifices they make for their communities; and

**WHEREAS**, last year, two hundred twenty-nine (229) law enforcement officers lost their lives in the line of duty nationwide, nine (9) of them from the State of Alabama; and

**WHEREAS**, the loss of a law enforcement officer is truly tragic and heartbreaking. It is imperative that we encourage and support all members of law enforcement as they confront dangerous and uncertain situations while on duty; and

**WHEREAS**, members of law enforcement show extreme bravery as they risk their own lives to save the lives of others while protecting our families, neighbors, and businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to educating the community about the importance of public safety, law enforcement members are committed to continued training, skill enhancement, and working with residents to achieve peace; and

**WHEREAS**, we greatly appreciate the extraordinary efforts and sacrifices made by officers and their family members daily in order to protect our community and residents;

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the Mobile County Commission proclaims January 23, 2023 as:

**LAW ENFORCEMENT APPRECIATION DAY**

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in Mobile County. We say, "Thank you" to the men and women in uniform who protect and serve our communities. Furthermore, we encourage residents to show members of law enforcement how much we value their service and protection. Be assured, "We've got your six."

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**President Hudson:** We want to also present you with a challenge coin from the Commission as well. Commissioner Dueitt, if you'll help me hand these out. Would anybody like to say a word? You don't have to. I don't want to put you on the spot.

**William Jackson, Mobile Police Department Assistant Chief:** It's an honor to be here. Thank you for recognizing us.

**President Hudson:** Absolutely. Please take our heartfelt feelings back to the members of your departments and let them know how much we appreciate their services as well. We do want to get a picture with you.

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**President Connie Hudson:** Of course, as you know, our Mobile County Sheriff, Sam Cochran, recently retired. I was reading the information about you, and it appears, if my math is correct, that you have been in law enforcement either with the City of Mobile or Mobile County for forty-seven (47) years. Is that correct?

**Samuel Cochran, Retired Mobile County Sheriff:** Since 1975.

**President Hudson:** Okay. You must have been very young.

**Samuel Cochran:** I was.

**President Hudson:** We could not let today go without a special recognition for those forty-seven (47) years and everything you have done in your service to the County. We want to let you know how much we appreciate that.

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PRESENT RESOLUTION/COMMENDATION FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENT/DECLARE  
JANUARY 23, 2023 AS SAM COCHRAN DAY

**WHEREAS**, the Mobile County Commission recognizes former Sheriff Sam Cochran for his many years of dedicated service to Mobile County. He officially retired from law enforcement on January 16, 2023, after serving as Sheriff of Mobile County for the last sixteen (16) years; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2006, Sam Cochran was elected Sheriff of Mobile County and re-elected to four-year terms in 2010, 2014, and 2018. He has received countless accolades and awards during the course of his career. One of his most distinctive honors was being appointed by Governor to serve as a Commissioner on the Alabama Police Officers Standards and Training Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout his law enforcement career, Sam Cochran has performed a myriad of duties, including thirty-one (31) years of service with the Mobile Police Department (MPD). He began his career with MPD as a Police Cadet and worked his way through the ranks to become Police Chief, a position he held for ten (10) years; and

**WHEREAS**, Sam Cochran is a native of Mobile County. He graduated from McGill Institute and earned both a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in Criminal Justice and Public Administration from the University of South Alabama. He also has certification from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) National Academy;

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the Mobile County Commission declares January 23, 2023 as:

**SAM COCHRAN DAY**

in Mobile County, Alabama. Furthermore, we express our gratitude and appreciation to former Sheriff Sam Cochran for his dedication, leadership, and commitment to Mobile County. Congratulations on your accomplishments, and best wishes to you and your wife, Sabrina, on your retirement. We salute you, Sam.

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**Samuel Cochran:** Thank you.

**President Hudson:** We are going to be recognizing our retirees a little bit later. I think some are still arriving. We'll call you back up then.

**Samuel Cochran.** Okay.

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**President Hudson:** Alright. Do you need to leave? You're retired now, right?

**Samuel Cochran:** I'm retired now.

**President Hudson:** Do you want to speak?

**Samuel Cochran:** Thank you, Commissioners. Thank all of y'all. I'm very honored to serve for so many years. I like to tell people I'm homegrown and home-educated with both degrees from the University of South Alabama. I've had two (2) full-time jobs with the City of Mobile and Mobile County. I have been here all of my life. I'm so proud of it. It's funny because I have been retired for about four (4) days, and I've developed a sense of humor. I didn't know I had it. People say you're so dang serious all of the time, but I have a sense of humor. I have been waking up the last four (4) days, and I'm still plugged in trying to catch up on stuff. I said I don't have to make those decisions anymore. The hardest decision I made this morning was how do I tie my tie? The ladies don't understand this, but the men may appreciate it. You have four (4) major decisions that you have to make. Is it a long tie or a short tie? Is it a thick tie or a skinny tie?

**Commissioner Randall Dueitt:** Or no tie.

**Samuel Cochran:** Or no tie like Commissioner Dueitt. Based on those four (4) things will determine whether your tie comes out too long or way up here on your chest. With those four (4) decisions, you have to try to get it right. If you don't get it right, you get to retie. As Sheriff, when you make those decisions, you don't get to rethink or retie. I'm learning every day how to develop a sense of humor and to think of things a little bit differently. My big thing this morning was tying a tie. Thank y'all so much.

**WHEREAS**, on January 12, 2023, Mobile County experienced one tornado, identified by the National Weather Service (NWS), as Northern Mobile County Tornado, which included tornadic winds up to 125 miles per hour, uprooting trees and snapping trees and power poles, damaging roofs and structures, and tossing debris along paths identified by the NWS by latitude and longitude; and

**WHEREAS**, debris resulting from the tornadoes has been piled upon Mobile County rights-of-ways, causing risks to the traveling public and the public in general;

**WHEREAS**, the Mobile County Commission is informed and believes that many residents and business owners have no means of removing the debris from the rights-of-ways;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the premises considered, the Mobile County Commission, finding and determining that a public purpose will be served thereby, DIRECTS the Public Works Department to undertake removal of tornado debris, not to include household garbage, appliances, or hazardous waste, along county rights-of-ways, within the impacted areas identified by the NWS, as expeditiously as may be possible.


