MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Monday, January 25, 2021 at 10:00 A. M. The following members of the Commission were present: Merceria Ludgood, President, Connie Hudson and Randall Dueitt, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Ludgood chaired the meeting.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: I think it is most appropriate this morning as we stand for at the end of the prayer if we'll take a moment of silence for the family of Mobile's native, Henry "Hank" Aaron, Hammering Hank. As you all know, he passed away a few days ago. We need to pray for his family and acknowledge the impact Hank Aaron had on our community after twenty-three (23) years in Major League Baseball and seven hundred fifty-five (755) career home runs. He stands as one of the greatest baseball players who has ever lived. We as a community are proud of him. We have been proud of him for a very long time. This morning we would like to acknowledge him, what he has meant to us, and ask for prayers for his family.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Minister Queen Gregory, Information Specialist, Public Affairs Department.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Commissioners, we have a presentation for Amelia Mitchell.

Commissioner Connie Hudson: For those of you who are not familiar with Amelia Mitchell, she is a very special lady who has been the Extension Service Coordinator for five (5) years. She has been such a breath of fresh air. She has done a fabulous job. We are so appreciative of her. As our resolution says, this is bittersweet because we are saying goodbye to her. She is being promoted in the Extension Service, so she is moving to Huntsville, Alabama. It is certainly our loss because she has done a fantastic job. We just wanted to acknowledge her today. I know she has someone to introduce as well.

WHEREAS, she has earned the respect of her colleagues for her commitment to maintain the highest standards of professional conduct;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Mobile County Commission joins the Mobile County Extension Office staff, along with other local leaders, civic groups, and friends from Mobile County in congratulating Amelia Mitchell on her new assignment; furthermore, we wish her good health, happiness, and blessings for years to come.

Amelia Mitchell, Extension Service Coordinator: Thank you. I would like to say a quick thank you to the entire Mobile County Commission for your support over the years. Without your help and your support for the Mobile County Extension Office, we could not do all of the things we have been able to do. While I am here, I wanted to share with you the good news of one of our newest employees, Mary Dixon. I am going to give her a moment to talk about what she does in the Mobile County Extension Office.

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Mary Dixon, Urban Regional Extension Agent: Thank you, Amelia. Good morning. As Amelia said, I am Mary Dixon. I recently joined the Alabama Cooperative Extension System. I am an Urban Regional Extension Agent. I work between the home grounds and garden systems as well as the natural resources. I am working on projects involving new and emerging crops as well as a beautification project for Booker T. Washington Middle School. Come to me if you have any questions because I am glad to help. Thank you.

Amelia Mitchell: Thanks, Mary.

Commissioner Hudson: Wonderful. We appreciate the work you both do very much.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: Our next guest speaker is Angela Goudreau for Grand Farms Road West.

Angela Goudreault, 14710 Grand Farm Road West, Grand Bay, Alabama 36541: Good morning, Commissioners. I would like for y'all to please keep my son in your prayers. He was in a severe accident over the weekend. I have been coming here for over a decade to express the concerns and worries of my neighbors and friends when they have an emergency. I am now here as a mama that couldn't get to her son and the ambulance couldn't get to her son when he had very severe burns. He's going to be in the hospital for at least two (2) to three (3) months. It was one of those things where he is old enough to know better but young enough to think he can. He used gasoline on a debris pile. I am wondering where we are at with the road for two (2) reasons. We signed the deeds so we do not really know if it's the County's to maintain or if I can get out there to try and work on the road. I looked like I was on an off-road course on Saturday when I was trying to get to the ambulance. I do not know how many times I have hit my head going down the road. Where are we at with this road?

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: First of all, let me say that I haven't met your son and your family but we will be praying for him for a speedy recovery. I think Jay Ross, County Attorney, can address the road issues and where we are at with it.

Angela Goudreault: Okay.

Jay Ross, County Attorney: As I told Ms. Goudreau earlier today, we have reached out to the owner of the property from forty (40) years ago. We are waiting on his acknowledgement to execute quick claim deeds to two (2) parcels, the Lundy and Oscar properties. I told W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer, we may be lucky enough to have that wrapped up this week. That will be the end of the

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legal side of this. We are closer than we have ever been. I consulted with Ms. Goudreau about it this morning as well as W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer and Commissioner Randall Dueitt.

Commissioner Dueitt: W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer, could you give some sort of timeline of what happens after the legal process so we know about where we are at with this project?

W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer: Certainly. Once the right-of-way is acquired, which is necessary for us to proceed, the first steps we will take will be to bid the relocation of the water lines. When the water lines are out of the way, which would probably be later this summer, we would bid the actual construction of the road. The plans are ready from what I understand. We are getting closer.

Angela Goudreault: Is there a way we could get the humps that are three feet divots knocked down or is it okay if I do that? Y'all have to see this road. Nobody has worked on it because we didn't know if it was okay for us to work on it after we signed the deeds. It is bad.

W. Bryan Kegley II: Commissioners, we have not accepted the maintenance of the road yet. It is still considered a private road so they are at liberty to do what they want to with it.

Jay Ross: I agree with that.

Angela Goudreault: Okay, so it will give me a distraction while I am waiting on my son. Most of y'all are like family here and I have known y'all for so long. Please keep my son and his doctors in your prayers. We have a road ahead of us, a different kind. It is going to be alright because it's in the good Lord's hands. I thank y'all for your time.

Commissioner Dueitt: Hopefully we will be there soon. It takes time but I think we're at the end of it now.

Angela Goudreault: Yeah. I always try to imagine and try to express to y'all my neighbors' worries and concerns, but there is no imagining on this. This mama filled those shoes this time.

Commissioner Dueitt: I understand your concerns. Everyone knows I worked at the Sheriff's Office for twenty-two (22) years before I came to the Commission. There is no doubt there has been numerous occasions where the Sheriff's Office had to respond and we were not able to respond to calls in that area.

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Angela Goudreault: It is now interfering with the phone service. I think my neighbors tried to get through fifteen (15) different times and finally two (2) of the calls came through. We have a really good, tight community when an emergency happens. Thank God a neighbor jumped the fence and was able to put my son out and that the fire truck was able to get to him to take him to the end of the road to meet the ambulance.

Commissioner Dueitt: Hopefully we are getting very close to having that project underway and finished.

Angela Goudreault: Thank y'all for your time. I am sorry, I am just trying to get this done.

Dena Pollard, Public Affairs Manager: The next guest speaker is Anne Foley. She wants to discuss Creekside and Boykin Park.

Anne Foley, 6001 Bourne Road, Theodore, Alabama 36582: Good morning. I see we are here to approve Creekside, Phase Two. I assume they did a traffic study? What were the results of the traffic study?

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: Yes, ma'am. We have and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer, can discuss that in depth.

W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer: Commissioners, Phase One and Phase Two were modified slightly from their original submittals and they changed the number of lots in each phase. We requested the designer modify the traffic study to account for the number of lots in Phase One and Phase Two. They completed the traffic study and modified the Phase Two plat to reduce the number of lots in the subdivision to fall below the conservative criteria in the engineering design calculations. We feel confident moving ahead with Phase Two.

Commissioner Dueitt: Ms. Foley, is that satisfying to you?

Anne Foley: It doesn't give us a deceleration lane, which they will need down the road for safety purposes. I wanted to know the results. I also mentioned to you Boykin Park is for sale. Has the County considered buying it? It was put up for sale at a higher price, either three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) or three hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$390,000.00). No one bought it for that price and I do not know if the County would consider purchasing the park or working something out with the City of Mobile to take apart the existing park to do

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some improvements and add some soccer fields. Especially with the neighborhood going in next door.

Commissioner Dueitt: Who owns the park? The City of Mobile?

Anne Foley: Apparently so because we are auctioning it off.

Commissioner Dueitt: I'll check into that. To address your concern, if there happens to be another phase to this subdivision and if the units meet the criteria, we'll certainly make sure to do everything to ensure the road is safe and consider adding a deceleration lane.

Anne Foley: I appreciate it. I think when people start to move into the subdivision, they will appeal for the deceleration lane. Thank you so much.

Commissioner Dueitt: Thank you.

Commissioner Hudson moved, seconded by President Ludgood, that the Board adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in significant housing instability in Mobile County, with greatest impact on low income households, and the inability to pay rent and utilities resulting from lost wages, job loss, illness, and death has had and will continue to have cascading housing, economic, social, and health-related implications (including, but not limited to, the potential for eviction); and

WHEREAS, the inability to pay rent and utilities adversely affects rental companies and individuals who own rental properties, as well as utility companies whose customers are unable to pay rent and utilities as a result of COVID-19 related financial insecurity; and

WHEREAS, Mobile County has applied for and has received grant funds from the U.S. Department of the Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) Program, as provided under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, in the amount of \$12,376,572.40; and

WHEREAS, the size of the grant award is indicative of the housing crisis resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, and 90% of funds awarded are mandated to be utilized to meet housing costs (including rent, rental arrears,

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utilities and home energy costs, utilities and home energy costs arrears, and other expenses related to housing) which low-income households are unable to meet as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, the awarded funds generally expire on December 31, 2021 and 65% must be allocated by September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, ERA Program regulations require the speedy development and administration of a rental assistance program for the use of the awarded funds, and the County lacks the staffing to do so within the timeframe established by the Program, as do local non-profit agencies with whom the County has worked and/or appropriated grant funds to develop and administer in the past; and

WHEREAS, Tetra Tech, Inc. is a leading provider of emergency management services worldwide, specifically including COVID-19 grant and program management in the area of emergency rental assistance under the CARES Act and now under the ERA Program, and maintains a Mobile County office, and is therefore able to immediately undertake efforts on behalf of the County within the compensation parameters required by the Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, the premises considered, the Mobile County Commission declares the existence of an emergency related to the inability of low-income households to pay rent and utilities as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, having significant housing, economic, social, and health-related implications; and also related to the inability of the County and local non-profit agencies to develop and administer a rental assistance program within the time frame required by the ERA guidelines, which could result in the loss of a significant portion of the awarded funds; and also recognizing that the housing emergency and noted deadline will not permit a delay resulting from bidding or publicizing a competitive solicitation for development and administration of a rental assistance program, does hereby APPROVE the award of a contract for such services to Tetra Tech, Inc., without bidding or competitive solicitation.

AND

authorize a contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. to develop and administer a rental assistance program for the grant funds awarded to the County in the amount of \$12,376,572.40, which the County lacks the manpower to do
