MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in regular session in the Government Plaza Auditorium, in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Monday, January 27, 2020 at 10:00 A. M. The following members of the Commission were present: Jerry L. Carl, President, Merceria Ludgood and Connie Hudson, Members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator/Clerk of the Commission, Jay Ross, County Attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer. President Carl chaired the meeting.

President Jerry L. Carl: Good morning. We are going to start with a prayer and then we will do the Pledge of Allegiance. We have Reverend Loren Scott to lead us in our prayer. If we will, let's get started. Thank you.

UMS-WRIGHT PREPARATORY SCHOOL
FOOTBALL TEAM/4-A STATE CHAMPIONS

Commissioner Connie Hudson: We are absolutely delighted this morning and thrilled to welcome and acknowledge the UMS-Wright Preparatory School Bulldogs Championship Football Team. These are the seniors. Let me tell you something about these gentlemen and these coaches who are filing in here today. On December 6, 2019, this team won its third (3rd) straight 4-A State Championship, beating Jacksonville Golden Eagles with a score of 28-17. These young men have been a part of the team for the last three (3) years or longer, as they have a winning streak of thirty-three (33) straight games. That is amazing and deserves a round of applause too. Symon Smith was the Most Valuable Player (MVP) Award Recipient. I also wanted to mention we have Head Coach Terry Curtis, who is the Winningest UMS-Wright Preparatory School Coach in the history of the school. He won the 2019 National Coach of the Year by the National Federation of High School Coaches Association. Also, Assistant Coach Brandon Dean, who is the Alabama Football Coaches Association Class 4-A

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Assistant Coach of the Year. We really have a distinguished group of men here this morning. We want to let them know how very proud we are as a community that they have done so well and have reflected so well in Mobile, Alabama. We do have some Certificates of Award. Coach Terry Curtis, would you like to introduce your assistant coaches?

Terry Curtis, Head Coach of UMS-Wright: How long do we have? I love having a microphone.

Commissioner Hudson: With your record, you have as long as you want.

Terry Curtis, Head Coach: Let me say we are grateful to the County Commission and the City of Mobile. You would be proud of this team. The only ones I brought today are our twelve (12) seniors. What great leaders they are going to be. One day they will be sitting up here on the front or the back as a Commissioner and they will be very well represented. Our guys are a lot better than the world thinks we are. We are molding and building some great individuals with these guys, as well as the other schools and coaches, which are doing the same thing. They love the game of football. They play it for the right reasons. They play for their town, their school, and for each other. They are very unselfish. As you can see, our running back is 5'5. Our quarterback is a junior. Will Breland, senior Linebacker, is our lead tackler and made about every All-State team that we have. This was totally a team effort. These guys accept all of these awards as a team. If you ask me why we are as successful as we are, it is because of the way we play and the reasons we play the game. I have two (2) assistant coaches here with me and as I said, the National Coach of the Year award is a terrific honor. It was quite an honor shared by a lot of people, the players, the parents, and most of all, my assistant coaches who have all been with me a long time. The ones I have with me today are Gerald Jones and Brandon Dean. We have eight (8) other assistant coaches that would have liked to be here today, but the principal would not let anyone else out. This is what we have today, a team to be proud of, three (3) time State Champions which is quite a feat. Now we will go back to work and see if we can do it again. Thank you, County Commissioners, for having us here today.

Commissioner Hudson: You're very welcome. Four (4) years in a row, you think? Maybe?

Terry Curtis, Head Coach: I don't know about that, but we'll take it.

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Commissioner Hudson: We're shooting for it. We want to recognize each of these players individually. This is a Certificate of Award from the Mobile County Commission. It says:

Will Breland, Richard Brinson, Seth Davis, Madi Hill, Eli MacKinnon, Charles Milling, Harris Pugh, John Rice, Symon Smith, Tyler Turner, Alec Wesley, Keyshawn Woodyard has earned special recognition and is hereby granted this Certificate of Award for representing UMS-Wright Preparatory School in the 2019 State Football Championship win.

It is signed by all three (3) County Commissioners. Congratulations.

I also want to recognize the coaches. Congratulations.

Again, we are so happy to have you here today and we wish all of you the very best in your futures. I know it will be bright. Thank you.

Terry Curtis, Head Coach: Thank you. We appreciate you.

President Jerry L. Carl: Thank you, guys. How many of you are going onto college to play football?

Terry Curtis, Head Coach: Keyshawn Woodyard is. A couple of them are also playing baseball.

President Carl: Oh! We have some baseball players. Now we're talking. You do not get to see that every day. A National Coach of the Year. Wow!

President Jerry L. Carl: Ronnie, usually when we see you, it is bad news. Do we have bad weather coming at us that we do not know about?

Ronnie Adair, Director of Mobile County Emergency Management Agency (EMA): We do not. I just wanted to come down this morning and say good morning to you and everyone here. I want to give you a little update about the Emergency Management Agency (EMA). We got through our first hurricane season with the new facility and we want to thank y'all more than can ever be expressed.

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The facility is fantastic. Anytime you want to come by, please do so. It is being utilized by law enforcement, the training areas for fire departments and police departments. Even Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is putting on a one-year long course where one (1) week out of every quarter, they come in and teach to people from all over the nation. It is called the Executive Course. I wanted to come down and tell you the enjoyment of every morning of coming to work in a brand new facility, it can't be expressed enough. Thank you very much and have a great day.

President Carl: Thank you. Historically, if we had a hurricane, all of the leaders of the City of Mobile and Mobile County would be put into lock-down through the storm. Fortunately, I have not had the opportunity to do that. I think Commissioner Merceria Ludgood has slept in a sleeping bag in the hall before.

Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: Yes.

President Carl: Have you?

Commissioner Connie Hudson: I never actually had to do that.

President Carl: Oh really? Well, I'm good. I am the Commission President you want if you do not want a hurricane. It's as simple as that.

President Jerry L. Carl: Good morning, Angela.

Angela Goudreault, Grand Farms Dirt Road: I'm back.

President Carl: Alright. Take your time.

Angela Goudreault: I am Angela Goudreault from Grand Farms. I came in on January 2, 2020, as it was the first business day of the year, and again submitted the Petition for Private Dirt Road to become County maintained. I am just following up to make sure, before the last day of January, if the Legal Department or Engineering Department may need more information. Hopefully I got everything done.

President Carl: Do we foresee any issues?

Jay Ross, County Attorney: We met and talked about it. There is some due diligence that Mr. Kegley's office needs to do. Hopefully everything is in order. We will see.

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Angela Goudreault: That was it. Thank y'all so much for your patience.

President Carl: Thank you.

Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: Is the magic date January 31, 2020?

Angela Goudreault: That is the deadline of anything being submitted according to the law as I understand it.

Commissioner Ludgood: Okay. Mr. Kegley, what is your timeline for reviewing and responding to her so that if she needs something else, she can do it timely?

W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer: Commissioner Ludgood, our department is supposed to review the petitions that are submitted prior to January 31st and provide a recommendation to the County Commission during the month of February. We have had an opportunity to briefly review Ms. Goudreault's petition and there may be one (1) or two (2) slight items that can be rectified between now and January 31st with the Legal Department's help. We are hoping this will be a successful petition this year.

Commissioner Ludgood: Okay. Thank you.

President Carl: Good. Very good. How many years have you been working on this project?

Angela Goudreault: I started in June 2006.

President Carl: Do not ever put me on your hate list because I doubt you ever give up.

Angela Goudreault: This is one of the things I made a promise to my neighbors. I try my very best to keep my word.

President Carl: We have all worked very hard on this, so I am proud it is coming to an end. It is one of the few roads that we have been able to identify that actually fall within these perimeters.

Angela Goudreault: There is a lot of criteria. It has very narrow criteria that you have to meet. That road falls right into the crack where we can get this achieved.

President Carl: Alright. Fantastic. Thank you.

Angela Goudreault: Thank you. Thank all of y'all very much.

We would ask you to consider declaring this a public nuisance so we can follow the next steps to try to get this hazard removed from the community.

President Carl: Without giving any names, is it a local individual that owns it or is it in a trust?

Linda Baker, Legal Secretary: It's a local individual.

President Carl: Okay.

Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: What was the address?

Tom Waters, Inspection Services Director: 10540 Smith Road. It came to us as 540 Smith Road, but the official 911 address is 10540 Smith Road.

Jay Ross, County Attorney: It's a typo.

Commissioner Hudson: We need to correct it.

Jay Ross, County Attorney: Commissioners, would you allow for it to be changed to 10540 Smith Road, Grand Bay, if that is satisfactory?

Commissioner Ludgood: Where did we send the notice?

Jay Ross, County Attorney: To the owner's address at 107 Anna H. Dixon Court, Whistler, Alabama 36612.

President Carl: You have the owner's correct address?

Jay Ross, County Attorney: Yes, sir.
