MOBILE COUNTY COMMISSION

The Mobile County Commission met in a combined conference and meeting session in the Mobile Government Plaza Auditorium in the City of Mobile, Alabama, on Thursday, July 20, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The following members of the Commission were present: Randall Dueitt, president, Merceria Ludgood and Connie Hudson, members. Also present were Glenn L. Hodge, county administrator/clerk of the commission, Jay Ross, county attorney, and W. Bryan Kegley II, county engineer. President Dueitt chaired the meeting.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Good morning, everyone. I would like to call to order and welcome everyone to the July 20, 2023, combined conference and meeting of the Mobile County Commission. This morning, we have Pastor Andric Daugherty, the executive of Pathway Church, who will give the invocation. If everyone will please stand and remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Pastor Andric Daugherty, executive pastor of Pathway Church, 7200 Moffett Road, Mobile, Alabama.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: We do have one resolution this morning in recognition of National Healthcare Week. To receive the resolution are Angela Jones Jackson and Carol Wagman from the Mobile County Health Department. I will now turn it over to Commissioner Hudson to present that resolution.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: Members, if you will join me down front.

PRESENT RESOLUTION/PROCLAIM AUGUST 6, 2023 THROUGH AUGUST 12, 2023 AS NATIONAL HEALTH CENTER WEEK

WHEREAS, for over 50 years, Community Health Centers have provided high-quality, affordable, comprehensive primary and preventive health care in our nation's medically underserved communities, delivering value to and having a significant impact on America's health care system; and

WHEREAS, as the country's largest primary care network, Community Health Centers are the healthcare home for over 30,000,000.00 Americans in over 14,000 communities across the nation. One in every 11 people in the United States gets their care at a Community Health Center; and

WHEREAS, Community Health Centers are a critical element of the health system, serving rural, suburban, frontier, and urban populations and often providing the only accessible and dependable source of primary care in their communities. Nationwide, Community Health Centers serve one in every five residents of rural areas; and

WHEREAS, every day, Community Health Centers develop new approaches to integrating a wide range of services beyond primary care, including oral health, vision, behavioral health, and pharmacy services, to meet the needs and challenges of their communities. Health centers have more than doubled their behavioral health workforce in the last decade to meet Americans' growing needs for behavioral health services; and

WHEREAS, during National Health Center Week, we celebrate the legacy of America's Community Health Centers and their vital role in shaping the past, present, and future of America's healthcare system;

in Mobile County; furthermore, we applaud the vital role that local health centers play in shaping the future of the healthcare system in Mobile County; we encourage all Americans to take part this week by visiting their local health centers and celebrating the important partnership between America's Community Health Centers and the communities they serve.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Before we move any further, I would like to take a minute to recognize guests of the Commission and the guests of our attorney, Jay Ross, and his firm, Adams and Reese. He has four interns here with him today, and I would like to recognize them real quick. Ava Ringhoffer, Daniel Perkins, Blaze Naman, who happens to be Judge Naman's son, and Katie Sullivan. Welcome to the Mobile County Commission Meeting, and thank you guys for being here.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Kelsey, I guess we will move forward. Do we have anyone signed up to speak?

Public Affairs Deputy Director Kelsey Gallahar: Yes, we have three speakers, the first being John Cannon, and he is going to speak on behalf of a group on Agenda Item #45. I believe they all are going to join him by standing behind him while he speaks.

Commission President Randall Dueitt: Mr. Conner, when you come to the microphone, if you do not mind, will you state your name again and address, please?

John Cannon, 2750 Belle Fontaine Boulevard, Theodore, Alabama, Agenda Item #45, Michael Wayne Morris Subdivision: My name is John Cannon.

President Dueitt: I am sorry, Mr. Cannon.

John Cannon: No problem. Good morning y'all.

President Dueitt: Can we get your address, please?

John Cannon: Yes, sir, it is 2750 Belle Fontaine Boulevard, Theodore, Alabama.

President Dueitt: Go ahead.

John Cannon: Okay, as a developer of Skyview Estates Subdivision, I built two County-approved private roads: Skyview Way and Windhover Drive, and during the process, I followed all of Mobile County's regulations and requirements. The Michael Wayne Morris Subdivision desires to access and use these two private roads. The Michael Wayne Morris Subdivision does not meet Mobile County's regulations, which makes it an illegal subdivision. I feel those regulations should be applied equally to all. Therefore, I oppose any variance allowing the Michael Wayne Morris Subdivision to use Skyview Way and Windover Drive private roads. I have also talked to the Skyview Estates Subdivision landowners, who use and maintain those roads, and all of them are opposed to any variance as well. Several of them came here today and would like to express that as well.

President Dueitt: Thank you, sir.

Public Affairs Deputy Director Gallahar: Our next speaker is Joanna Mariano.

Joanna Mariano, 14020 Mars Avenue, Bayou La Batre, Alabama, Agenda Item #45, Michael Wayne Morris Subdivision: I am a new owner in the Skyview Estates Subdivision. I feel like everybody needs to follow the regulations. It is not fair that one is not. Thank you.

President Dueitt: Thank you.

Public Affairs Deputy Director Gallahar: The last speaker is Randy Spann.

Randy Spann, 8655 Ramsey Road Grand Bay, Alabama, Agenda Item #45, Michael Wayne Morris Subdivision: We are new owners in the Skyview Estates Subdivision. I would like for everybody to abide by all the rules and regulations the same as we do.

President Dueitt: Thank you.

President Dueitt: If we may, so they do not have to sit through the entire meeting, I would like to take this agenda item out of order. I just want to have Matthew come down. I have a few questions. I understand this is not a typical subdivision plat, and the requestor asks for a variance from our regular Subdivision Regulations. Is that correct?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Matthew Barclift: That is correct. They are asking for a waiver of the Subdivision Regulations with regard to the frontage along a road. In this case, it is a privately maintained paved road. Typically, we would require 25 feet.

They only have 15 feet and are asking for a variance or a waiver of that section for the subdivision.

District 1 Commissioner Merceria Ludgood: Does the owner of the private road oppose their use of it?

President Dueitt: Everyone here is a property owner. Is that correct? Does everyone here own property on that private road and maintain the private road yourselves?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: Correct, the landowners have a fee simple ownership. There is a 50-foot non-exclusive ingress and egress easement on the road; the property owners are the ones who maintain it.

Commissioner Ludgood: Is it nonexclusive?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: Nonexclusive.

District 2 Commissioner Connie Hudson: What is the purpose of reducing the right-of-way?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: There was a family split of the property, and it was sold outside the family. Now, it has to comply with the Subdivision Regulations. When it was in the family subdivision, they were exempt from the Subdivision Regulations. It has gone outside the family and is required to come into compliance.

Commissioner Ludgood: Was the existing owners of Skyview Way originally developed as a family subdivision?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: Mr. Cannon sold one of the pieces along Skyview Way, about a 10-acre piece, to one gentleman and one family. That family took the large pieces and split them among themselves as part of the family.

Commissioner Hudson: What is the primary objection, other than that the rules and regulations have changed because it is outside the family? I do not understand why there is an objection to the 10 feet.

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: When they divided it among the family, they did not keep all the pieces among the family. They do not have the required amount of frontage, which would not have been applied, and in this case, it only has 15 feet as opposed to the standard required 25 feet.

Commissioner Hudson: Right, keep it consistent with the regulations the same for everybody.

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: Yes.

President Dueitt: That was my question. Once it went outside the family, did they all fall under the Subdivision Regulations? Has anyone else been granted any kind of variance in this subdivision?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: I am not aware of any other variance.

Commissioner Ludgood: Selling outside the family was a variance.

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: Selling outside the family would trigger the need to bring it into the required Subdivision Regulations.

President Dueitt: If we could, Glenn, I would like to take this item out of order before you read it because I know I probably will not be voting. I am a no-vote. I think the other residents in this subdivision have followed the County rules. I think this is asking for a variance that violates our regulations.

Commissioner Hudson: You said you would not be voting.

President Dueitt: Well, I can.

Commissioner Hudson: You are voting now.

President Dueitt: I can, but I assumed you would. I vote no.

Commissioner Hudson: Well, that is an automatic vote.

President Dueitt: Okay, well, I vote no.

Commissioner Hudson: Okay, that will be good.

Commissioner Ludgood: Okay, I am just trying to be clear; please bring Matthew back. When this subdivision was originally developed, did it benefit from our waiver provision?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: The Skyview Estates, the larger one, did not initially benefit from our waiver provision. One of the people who bought the property from Mr. Cannon bought a lot in the Skyview Estates. They divided it among the family, which state law provides an exemption for families to transfer property to one another. Once it has transferred outside the family, for it to be considered legal in the law on record, it would need to come into compliance with the Subdivision Regulations. In order to do that, they would need to plat the lot, and it would need to meet the Subdivision Regulations or be granted a waiver.

Commissioner Ludgood: Is the person to whom the lot was sold now behind the eight ball?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: As I understand it, I think the third person in the chain is now behind the eight ball.

Commissioner Hudson: Has the lot been sold already, or is it under option?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: I think the lot has been sold at least twice outside the family.

President Dueitt: I want to understand if they ask for a variance outside our Subdivision Regulations. Is that what this agenda item is asking?

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: That is correct. They are asking for a waiver of the Subdivision Regulations.

President Dueitt: We send out letters to all adjacent residents. If they have any objections, they can come and speak about them. I think they are here speaking against us approving something outside our Subdivision Regulations.

Engineering Development and Inspections Manager Barclift: Yes, we notify the public, who are all immediately adjoined to the utilities, to give them an opportunity to be aware of it.

President Dueitt: All right, thank you. If there are no other questions, Glenn, we will take this out of order if that is okay. I vote no.

Commissioner Ludgood: There is no motion yet.

Commissioner Hudson: I will make the motion to oppose the waiver.

President Dueitt: I vote no also.

Commissioner Hudson: Right, and you vote to second the opposition.

President Dueitt: Second to the opposition.

Commissioner Ludgood: I will abstain.

President Dueitt: That was confusing, sorry.

Commissioner Hudson: That is okay.

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President Dueitt: Give me a break; I am new. **Commissioner Hudson:** I think we got there.

AGENDA #45

CONSIDER WAIVING SECTION 4.42-3/SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS/APPROVE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT/MICHAEL WAYNE MORRIS SUBDIVISION

The Engineering Department has no objection to the granting of this waiver.

County Administrator Glenn L. Hodge: The request for a waiver of Section 4.42-3 Subdivision Regulations is denied.

Commissioner Ludgood abstained.
