**Glenn L. Hodge, County Administrator:** Is there still consideration on Bid #100-21?

Jay Ross, County Attorney: Commissioners, at the Commission Conference on Thursday, September 23, 2021, a question was asked about the bid for the annual concrete. After reviewing it, the Commission has every right and privilege to not accept the bid and to reject it. I talked to Richard Mitchell, Public Works Director, and as long as the Public Works Department stays under \$15,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2022, there should be no problem with the bid. Neal Howard, Deputy Public Works Director, and I spoke a few minutes ago. At the halfway mark of Fiscal Year 2022, if they feel like they anticipate going over that amount, then they can bid the item separately. The Commission has the authority to reject the bid if it chooses to do so.

**Commissioner Connie Hudson:** There is concurrence that by rejecting the bid and completing the work project by project for purchase, it may result in a substantial cost savings?

Jay Ross: I don't know about that.

Commissioner Hudson: I was asking Public Works.

Richard Mitchell, Public Works Director: If we can buy it off the street price that anybody can buy it for, which we should be able to without a bid, then yes. It would give us a substantial savings.

Commissioner Randall Dueitt: When I looked, I discovered another thing after the discussion at the Commission Conference on Thursday, September 23, 2021. This is the only company to bid on this during the last ten (10) years. It's no wonder they are charging the County three (3) times what they charge a regular person for concrete. I want to say right now that this is a notice to everybody. W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer and I have had a conversation about some other bids and the prices we are receiving. If you're going to bid on a project for Mobile County, know we are going to look at it and know you will treat the County Commission right. You are not going to gouge the County just because you can. I feel like some of the prices and some of the bids we are getting back recently are high. I understand material costs are a little higher now. W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer told me that some of our jobs are coming back and we may not even be able to do some of the Pay-As-You-Go Program projects because they are coming in at fifty percent (50%) and sixty percent (60%) higher than the original price. I am putting everybody on notice for bid jobs for Mobile County, you are going to treat the County Commission right. You're not going to charge the County more just because you think you can.

**Commissioner Hudson:** I think we have always operated under the assumption that having a competitive process would get the County the best value for the money. If this is an example that the County is potentially being overcharged or gouged, then I think it might be a good idea to examine all of the other contracts we have in comparison with the street prices. If any of those fall below the threshold, then maybe we need to look at handling those in the same fashion. Are there others?

**Commissioner Dueitt:** I am certainly going to keep an eye on them.

**Commissioner Hudson:** W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer, are there others?

W. Bryan Kegley II, County Engineer: Commissioners, not right now. We did receive one (1) bid a couple of months ago that came in substantially higher than what we estimated it at, even at an increased value prior to going to bid. We increased

the estimated cost a couple hundred thousand dollars. The bid came in about seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000.00) over that. There is no way we can award bids of that nature. Especially whenever there is possible collusion or something of that nature. We are going to evaluate every bid whenever they come in. If we see something that is out of line or inappropriate, we will make a recommendation to the County Commission to not award the bid.

**Commissioner Hudson:** Right. I guess the question is why? Is it because the cost of materials and everything else has gone up substantially? If there's a legitimate reason it has happened and it is a competitive price, then it's one thing. If it is not, then that's something else to take into consideration.

**W. Bryan Kegley II:** Absolutely. We take all of that into consideration when we come up with our estimated cost prior to going to bid, Commissioner Hudson.
