All bidders shall furnish a five (5%) bid bond on any contract exceeding \$30,000, provided that bonding is available for services, equipment, or materials. Bid bonds will be accepted in the form of certified checks, cashier's checks, postal money orders, or similar forms of payment.

Out of the State, Corporations shall furnish a Certificate of Authority to transact business in the State of Alabama. Out-of-state limited liability companies shall furnish proof of registration to transact business in this state. Alabama law requires a successful bidder that has employees in the State of Alabama to provide proof of E-Verify enrollment before the contract is awarded. (See enclosed notice, which must be completed, signed, and returned with your bid.)

If applicable to a contract resulting from this invitation, the successful bidder must comply with the Contractor Felony Investigation Policy, available in the Purchasing Department or at mobilecountyal.gov.

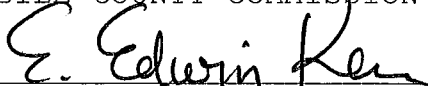

SPECIFICATIONS FOR STRUCTURAL PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE**

1. GENERAL

This specification covers the furnishing of Portland cement concrete for use in constructing concrete structures. Structures shall include but are not limited to box culverts, inlets, headwalls, retaining walls, slope paved ditches, driveways, and other miscellaneous structures. The Portland cement concrete furnished shall meet Section 501 Structural Portland Cement Concrete of the *Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction*, 2026 Edition.

Mobile County will award this bid to all qualified responsive bidders. Material purchases will be made on a project-by-project basis, considering haul distance from the supplier's plant to the project. This will be accomplished by checking the actual road mileage to the project site from each of the supplier's plants, then applying a haul cost of \$.20 per cy per mile to decide the plant with the lowest price for that project.

If the low supplier, as determined by the method described above for a particular project, cannot supply the materials we need when we need them, Mobile County reserves the right to purchase the materials from the next lowest-priced supplier.

Any political subdivision within Mobile County must be allowed to purchase off contracts resulting from this bid invitation at the same price offered to Mobile County.

2. PAYMENT

Payment will be made monthly. Invoices will be submitted weekly to the County Road and Bridge Department Supply Section, Supply Supervisor, 7511 Howell's Ferry Road, Mobile, AL 36618. Some invoices may have as few as three days or as many as eight days, depending on the day the end of the month falls. A separate invoice will be submitted for each type of material supplied to the County.

Each invoice will show the inclusive dates of the period covered by the invoice and will include the following attachments:

1. Dray tickets for each load of materials supplied, arranged in chronological order.
2. The approved mix design used in producing the material.
3. Certification of Conformity with Alabama Department of Transportation Specifications. (ie. ALDOT BMT-122)

3. RESPONSIBLE PARTY AS REPRESENTATIVE OF SUPPLIER

Upon notice of award, each supplier will provide written notice to the County Engineer of the responsible party and at least one alternate as the person to contact for placement of orders and for settlement of disputes.

4 MIX DESIGN

The supplier will submit an approved mix design for each type of concrete for each plant to the Mobile County Engineer within 10 days of notice of award of bid before any purchases can be made from the supplier.

All mix designs submitted will be approved by the Alabama Department of Transportation or a Mobile County-approved testing laboratory employed by the supplier. Mix Designs will be subject to requirements as shown in Section 501 of ALDOT *Standard Specifications for Highway Construction*, 2026 Edition.

Mobile County personnel may request verification of the job mix or material quality at their discretion.

5 SUPPLIER/PRODUCER

All concrete suppliers/producers, technicians, materials, equipment, and plants will meet the requirements as set forth in Section 501 of the Alabama Department of Transportation *Standard Specifications for Highway Construction*, 2018 Edition. All concrete batching plants shall be certified by the National Ready Mix Concrete Association (NRMCA) to be in conformance with the NRMCA Plant Certification Checklist. All batching plants shall meet the requirements of the Specifications and ALDOT-352 and must be on the ALDOT List of Evaluated Ready-Mix Concrete Plants.

6 PRICES, BONDS, PLANT LOCATION

Prices are to remain firm from date of award through September 30, 2027.
Price to be F.O.B. Mobile County Job Site. Estimated cubic yards to be used per year is 400 CY. Bid bonds are required with the bid submission.

CONCRETE PLANT MUST BE LOCATED IN MOBILE COUNTY, ALABAMA
