SPECIFICATIONS FOR DRUG TESTING EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Mobile County Commission hereafter referred to as (MCC) is accepting bids for the purpose of providing drug testing through a specialized laboratory of VENDOR are to be placed in Mobile Community Correction's office. **This contract will include equipment and supplies for (1) onsite urinalysis substance abuse testing analyzer**. All the equipment will remain the property of VENDOR until and if at such time Mobile County Commission desires to purchase said equipment.

This contract is confidential and both Vendor and MCC agree to maintain the confidentiality of this contract. Release of any information contained in this contract is considered to be a breach of the contract.

Any changes to this contract during the contract period must be in writing.

Standard payment terms are net 30 days of invoice.

TERMINATION CLAUSE

From date of execution, the contract shall be for a term of thirty-six consecutive months.

SPECIFICATIONS OF AGREEMENT

MCC is making a contract for one (1) analyzer used for conducting drug screens.

Shipping expenses for the analyzer will be the sole responsibility of the Vendor.

SPECIFICATIONS

MCCC's current estimate is based on an annual number of single test performed being 60,000 to 70,000 tests per year.

The following Items will be included:

- -One (1) Pro-E Drug Testing Systems or similar to perform no less than 130 EMIT tests per hour per analyzer with two reagents. EMIT reagents shall be included with the bid for the analyzer. The consumables, calibrators and controls will be included in the bid at no charge.
- -2 Computers with Modem (Network Interface)
- -Data Management Systems for analyzer
- -Color Code Randomization Module
- -Interface with offsite or onsite server hosting for automated upload/download to Mobile Community Corrections Center's Database
- -Bar Code Printer
- -Training for staff onsite at Mobile Community Corrections Center Drug Lab's location

The drug testing software and any supporting software must be able to print individual reports, email reports and fax them directly from the computer system.

The drug testing system must use methods and output results that conform to federal and state guideline and/or laws or industry practices as well as HIPPA should that become an issue in MCC's business practices.

DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The Data Management System must be fully customizable to meet the needs of the laboratory. The Lab's reporting needs will be carefully designed to provide efficient viewing, reporting, printing, archiving and transmission/delivery of reports. Mobile Community Corrections Center requires a WinTOX6 Laboratory Information Management Software or approved equivalent.

REPORT DELIVERY

Data management software must provide automatic reporting of results to client on-site and off-site through various methods including web-based or cloud technology.

Default order data and standing order must be configurable in system preferences, donor setup, and order entry.

This screen includes drug admission, prescription information.

Calculated Tests

Easy to use calculation builder enables the user to build mathematical calculations from current previous results, including THC ratio.

Reflex Conditions

User can build multiple conditions to add, delete, or re-run assays and profiles.

Import/Export Capabilities

Builds import sets for connectivity with third party applications. Imports demographics and batch order entries. Schedules regular export of result data in real-time or time intervals via FTP, Internet, or file transfer.

Query Report Writer

Enables user to design new reports with selectable fields of information and MCC designed queries.

Quantitative and Qualitative Results

User can select the reporting method per assay to print a qualitative text message or the numeric result with or without the flag.

Bar-coding Capability

Bar coding on order entry is available for bi-directional instruments and specimen cup identification.

Chain of Custody

Chain of custody forms is available at order entry with client information and unique accession number.

Allows Off-Line Test Entry

Allows easy manual entry or off-line tests.

Unique Accession Number Tracks Specimen Record

Unique accession number on specimen cup bar code, chain of custody form and lab report tracks from order entry to instrument results.

Auto Rerun of Positives

Automatically initializes assay to receive rerun value while storing the previous result for review as well as provide barcode for re-aliquating specimen.

REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE

The drug testing system must be restored to normal operations, via repair or exchange within 24 hours after the initial call for service is placed. Manufacturer must provide company trained engineers to service the equipment. Vendor will arrange through the manufacture of equipment emergency maintenance services to keep testing down-time to a minimum. Extended down-time of more than two full working days (7:00 am thru 5:00 pm Monday-Friday) in any given month shall constitute cause to terminate the contract unless the MCC and vendor agree to mitigate the per drug screen fee as compensation for extended down-time.

TRAINING

Vendor must provide training of the MCCC employees within 30 days of the installation of the analyzer on-site. Training will include proper operation of laboratory equipment and software provided for data management.

PRICING

Pricing shall be based on a Non-capital Outlay for MCCC. Prices should be a per drug screen fee which includes use of all equipment, software, maintenance/service and management of laboratory.

A separate price for EtG may be quoted.

The price shall include, but is not limited to consumables, calibrators, and controls, pipettes and management assistance.

Pricing shall include a separate cost per assay for validity testing (Creatinine and Specific gravity).

WARRANTY

The equipment and software remain the property of the vendor and therefore a warranty is provided on the equipment throughout the term of this contract.
