# 1. **GENERAL**

Materials shall conform to Section 801 of the *Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction*, 2018 Edition, except as noted below.

Minimum order 20 Tons

Price to be F. O. B. Mobile County Alabama

All fine and coarse aggregate furnished shall come from an approved producer who is participating in and meeting the requirements of BMTP-249, Procedure for Acceptance of Coarse and Fine Aggregates. The producer's name shall be listed in the Alabama Department of Transportation's *Materials, Sources, and Devices with Special Acceptance Requirements Manual*, List I-1. The Alabama Department of Transportation has established a list of qualified producers of fine and coarse aggregates. Refer to Sub article 106.01(f) and BMTP-355 concerning this list in the *Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction*, 2018 Edition and *Alabama Department of Transportation Testing Manual* respectively.

Section 801.02 Deleterious Substances.

The amount of deleterious substances in coarse aggregates shall not exceed the limits listed as Table II All Other Uses for items (a) thru (I).

Section 801.03 (b) PHYSICAL TESTS.

Crushed stone, gravel, and crushed gravel shall meet the requirements for "All Other Uses" for the respective physical tests:
