## Bid Specifications Asphalt Rejuvenator Sprayer

#### GENERAL

The purpose of these specifications is to describe a computerized spray system that is specifically designed for and shall be capable of applying BIORESTOR® Asphalt Rejuvenators at application rates determined by manufacturer. It may be used for the application of bio-based emulsions for sealants or as preventative maintenance on HMA asphalt. This unit shall be the manufacturer's current production model. The machine shall be capable of applying product accurately at rates 0.01 to 0.04 gallons per square yard. All qualified bidders must have and maintain a complete inventory of repair parts and have experienced service personnel for this equipment. A comprehensive parts breakdown and instruction manual shall be supplied with each unit. A factory-trained person shall be made available for initial start-up and training in the operation of the spray system. The applicator/spray system shall have continuous agitation or circulation to mix material uniformly and a minimum, three unit selectable bar widths. Do not attempt to apply petroleum based or varying bio-based products with this system.

#### **REQUIRED SAFETY FEATURES**

The applicator shall have a safety shut-off feature on the intake and return side of the centrifugal pump to allow operator to effectively shut off flow of material. Applicator shall have a master shut- off switch on the control console to shut off the spray bar from in the cab of the vehicle.

#### TRUCK MOUNTING

This applicator shall be versatile to allow mounting to flat bed, dump truck or equivalent bed types. The predrilled holes in the base allow the applicator to be installed on a multitude of vehicle types.

#### PRESSURE GAUGE

Applicator shall have a visible pressure gauge, capable of 100PSI to accurately monitor the pressure in the system.

#### PUMP SYSTEM

The pump system shall be of a centrifugal pump capable of 110GPM. Suction intake shall not be less than 1-1/2" for sufficient material flow. A strainer shall be in place with a maximum 80 mesh screen to filter out in debris. The filter shall be accessible to ease the need for service or cleaning.

#### INTEGRATED CONTROL SYSTEM

The applicator shall have Raven SCS 450 Monitor or equivalent to precisely monitor application of product. Monitor shall be linked to the control oscillating valve to control product flow. The controls shall operate the spray bar in a minimum of three sections. They shall be activated by a single power switch, which will then turn on the regulating valve and open the boom valves.

#### AGITATION

A continuous circulation design shall mix the material prior to application. This feature ensures that material remains in complete suspension and that the emulsion is uniform. For additional agitation, a stainless steel mixer paddle shall be supplied with each application unit to be used in conjunction with the pump circulation.

#### ENGINE

The unit shall be equipped with a Honda engine complying with the following specifications: Electric Start 4 Stoke single cylinder OHV engine 3.54" (90mm) Stroke Cylinder Sleeve type cast iron sleeve Bore x Stroke 68 x 45mm Displacement 163m<sup>3</sup> Net power 3.6 kW (4.8Hp)/3600 rpm

#### PAINT

All painted surfaces shall be coated with gloss black powder coating.

#### TRAINING

An authorized, factory-trained representative will be made available for training at a facility designated by the bidding agency. At this training session a complete operational, mechanical and safety overview will occur. The website videos will be viewed and discussed with all concerned personnel. Additionally, the representative will be available at that time for "on the job" safety and field training.

#### PARTS

Mobile County may require bidders to show proof that a large stock of parts at their facility for that model of equipment. Assembled Honda engines, Raven Controls, Ace Centrifugal pumps, valves, as well as plumbing parts shall be on hand to assist in any replacement of defective parts under warrantee period.

#### AWARD

Equipment is for use by the Mobile County Public Works Department and must meet the requirements of that agency as interpreted by the County Commission. Prior to award, the Purchasing Agency may require a visit to the supplier's facility to assure supplier has plant capacity to manufacturer and deliver equipment on time as required. If it is determined that the supplier cannot supply as requested, this is just cause for cancellation.

#### WARRANTY

The manufacturer shall warranty the equipment for one year or as otherwise noted in the manufacturer's standard warranty policy.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS**

No bid will be considered unless the bidder can meet the following conditions:

1. That it is bidding upon original model that meets the requirements of the specifications without application rate changes or modifications.

- 2. The model is regularly advertised and sold as having a capacity of not less than called for herein.
- 3. The bidder has been engaged in the manufacture of equipment of the type bid upon for at least twenty-four months.

#### APPROVED EQUAL

The approved make and model for this specification is a BIORESTOR<sup>®</sup> Computerized Spray System for asphalt rejuvenation. Bidders offering to supply other than the approved make and model must supply a detailed description of the equipment being offered. For purposes of comparison a separate list of all deviations to this specification must be attached to your bid document.

Prior to bid award an on-site demonstration of the equipment offered may be requested. All bidders offering other than the approved model listed will be required to provide an on-site demonstration to verify that their unit complies with all specification requirements before their bid will be considered. Mobile County may choose to accept any or all of the above listed items. Items not chosen to be received by Mobile County, will not be delivered or charged to Mobile County.

Failure to carry out the provisions noted herein is deemed sufficient reason to reject the bidder's proposal.
