All bidders shall furnish a five (5%) bid bond on any contract exceeding \$30,000, provided that bonding is available for services, equipment, or materials. Bid bonds will be accepted in the form of certified checks, cashier's checks, postal money orders, or similar forms of payment.

Out of the State, Corporations shall furnish a Certificate of Authority to transact business in the State of Alabama. Out-of-state limited liability companies shall furnish proof of registration to transact business in this state. Alabama law requires a successful bidder that has employees in the State of Alabama to provide proof of E-Verify enrollment before the contract is awarded. 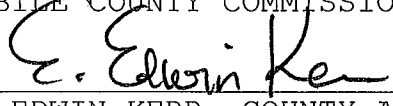

SPECIFICATION FOR

FAST DRY, READY-MIXED WATERBORNE TYPE 11 TRAFFIC PAINT

1. GENERAL

This specification covers the requirements for a durable, fast-drying 100% acrylic Waterborne type 11, adverse conditions, traffic paint coating as follows and conforming to Federal Specification TT-P-1952D.

2. CHARACTERISTICS

- i. Standard colors are white and yellow
- ii. Application with or without heat. (When heated, recommended temperatures are 100 120 degrees Fahrenheit).
- iii. Drying time 1 to 3 minutes at ambient temperatures above 50 degrees Fahrenheit.
- iv. Non-Red Label (Non-Flammable).
- v. V. O. C. Less than 100 Gm/Liter
- vi. Meets EPA Toxicity Test
- vii. Easy clean-up with water.
- viii. Excellent bead adhesion throughout the life of the line.

3. COMPOSITION

- i. 100 percent Acrylic Resin as vehicle.
- ii. Pigment 60% $\pm$ by weight.
- iii. Total Solids 70% minimum by weight.
- iv. Volume Solids 60% minimum by volume.
- v. White paint - 2.0 pounds per gallon Rutile TiO₂ minimum.
Yellow paint - 0.2 pounds per gallon Rutile TiO₂. maximum.

4. PHYSICAL TESTS

- i. Viscosity: 80-95 KU.
- ii. Drying Time at 15 mils: Unheated: 3 minutes maximum
Heated (100-120 Degrees Fahrenheit): 1 minute maximum.
- iii. Hiding: 0.92 minimum.
- iv. Reflectance: White - 85% minimum.
- v. Freeze-Thaw Stability: 5 cycles ($\pm$ 5 KU).
- vi. Shelf Life: 9 months minimum.

All paint shall be packaged in new 250 Gallon Totes meeting all D.O.T. requirements.

6. CONTRACT LIFE
