Any questions or comments concerning the bid requirements must be brought to the attention of Susan Holland, Chief Procurement Officer, 251-574-8613, 205 Government St., 8th Fl. S., Mobile, Alabama 36644, to or at bid opening or will be forever waived.

All bidders shall furnish a five percent (5%) bid bond on any contract exceeding \$30,000: provided that bonding is available for services, equipment, or materials. Bid bond will be accepted in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, postal money order, etc.

Out-of-state corporations shall furnish a Certificate of Authority to transact business in the State of Alabama. Out-of-state limited liability companies shall furnish proof of registration to transact business in this state. Alabama law requires that a successful bidder, if it has employees in the State of Alabama, provide proof of enrollment in E-Verify prior to the award of a contract. (See enclosed notice which must be completed, signed and returned with your bid.)

If applicable to a contract resulting from this invitation, the successful bidder must comply with the Contractor Felony Investigation Policy, available in the Purchasing Department or at mobilecountyal.gov.

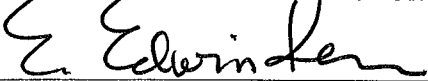

SPECIFICATIONS FOR COARSE AGGREGATE MATERIAL

1. **GENERAL**

Materials shall conform to Section 801 of the *Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction*, 2026 Edition, except as noted below.

Minimum order

20 Tons

Price to be F. O. B. Mobile County, Alabama

All fine and coarse aggregate furnished shall come from an approved producer who is participating in and meeting the requirements of BMTP-249, Procedure for Acceptance of Course and Fine Aggregates. The producer's name shall be listed in the Alabama Department of Transportation's *Materials, Sources, and Devices with Special Acceptance Requirements Manual*, List I-1. The Alabama Department of Transportation has established a list of qualified producers of fine and coarse aggregates. Refer to Sub article 106.01(f) and BMTP-355 concerning this list in the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2026 Edition and Alabama Department of Transportation Testing Manual, respectively.

Section 801.02 Deleterious Substances.

The amount of deleterious substances in coarse aggregates shall not exceed the limits listed as Table II All Other Uses for items (a) thru (I).

Section 801.03 (b) PHYSICAL TESTS.

Crushed stone, gravel, and crushed gravel shall meet the requirements for "All Other Uses" for the respective physical tests:

Section 801.11 (d) COARSE AGGREGATE GRADATION TABLE

No. 4 Coarse Aggregate Size shall meet the gradation table as shown.

No. 57 Coarse Aggregate Size shall meet the gradation table as shown.

2. **PAYMENT**

Payment will be made monthly. Invoices shall be submitted to the Mobile County Road and Bridge Department Supply Section, Supply Supervisor, 7511 Howell's Ferry Road, Mobile, AL 36618.

A separate invoice will be submitted for each type of material supplied to the County.

Each invoice shall indicate the inclusive dates of the period covered by the invoice and shall include the following attachments:

- (a.) Signed dray tickets for each load of material supplied, arranged in chronological order.
- (b.) Certification of Conformity with Alabama Department of Transportation Specifications.

3. **RESPONSIBLE PARTY AS REPRESENTATIVE OF SUPPLIER**

Upon notice of award, each supplier shall provide written notice to the County Engineer of the party responsible and at least one alternate as the person to contact for placement of orders and for settlement of disputes.
