SPECIFICATIONS FOR UMPIRE AND SCOREKEEPING SERVICES TO OFFICIATE ADULT LEAGUE SOFTBALL GAMES AT WEST MOBILE COUNTY PARK

As Mobile County desires to seek competitive bids among interested and <u>qualified</u> parties in order to provide umpires to officiate Adult League Softball Games at West Mobile County Park. This public announcement hereby proclaims our intention to accept bids from interested parties based on the following listed strict specifications.

Bids will not be considered valid unless submitted/administered by an individual with at least five years of softball umpiring experience and who is currently a sanctioned umpire, regardless of affiliation.

ALL umpires who officiate independent league softball **MUST** be sanctioned umpires by any of the existing national organizations.

In addition to officiating the game, the umpire will be responsible for keeping a running tally of runs scored for each team. At the end of the inning, the umpire will need to confer with the head coaches of each team to validate the score. Any discrepancies in the score should be addressed at this time. Once a coach agrees to the score, an inning is closed out, and it is final. No protests can be made on the score once a game is finished. Each team will be advised to keep a book of their own to avoid any discrepancies.

Umpires will be responsible for dropping scorecards for all games officiated at the end of the night into the drop box located across from the concession stand. Umpires will need to sign off on the score to signify that it is correct. Umpires will be paid according to score cards submitted.

The group/organization which bids for this umpiring duty must have a minimum of 12 official/sanctioned umpires at their command. These umpire names must be submitted to West Mobile County Park prior to beginning duties for approval.

All umpires are required to be uniformed. Matching hats, shirts, pants same color, shoes black.

Umpires must conduct themselves in a professional manner. Profanity, aggressive behavior or confrontation with players, coaches, fans or the general public will not be tolerated. Mobile County will have the right to reject the bid and award to the next lowest bidder.

The use of tobacco products (including, but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, electronic cigarettes, dip and chew) is not allowed on the playing field or inside the building.

Any umpire that is a no show for more than three games during league play will be terminated from umpiring at West Mobile County Park.

Payment for all umpiring services will be made to the umpire organization/group for disbursement to the respective working umpires and not the individual umpires.

The umpire group or association who is awarded the bid for duty agrees to administer the rules of play and park rules proclaimed by West Mobile County Park. Rules will be described to the group/organization upon awarding of the bid.

Mobile County, West Mobile County Park, nor Mobile County employees will not be held liable for any injuries sustained by umpires. The group/organization who is awarded the bid to umpire at West Mobile County Park must provide proof of insurance for all of their umpires while on Mobile County premises.

Mobile County reserves the right to reject any bids submitted which do not adhere to the above described specifications.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR BIDDING:

Bids will be accepted at the Mobile County Commission's Purchasing Department until the date of deadline.

How much will your organization charge Mobile County, specifically West Mobile County Park to provide acceptable, experienced, sanctioned, insured and qualified umpires to officiate all adult league softball games as scheduled according to the following description.

- A. Cost when providing two umpires per game.
- B. Cost when only one umpire officiates per game.
- C. Cost when game is forfeited.
 - 1. One umpire.
 - 2. Two umpires.

Item (A) will be considered as a 50% factor, Item (B) and Item (C) will be considered as 25% factors each.

REGARDING FORFEIT PAY:

Forfeit pay will be paid under the following stipulations:

- 1. The game that an umpire is scheduled to call is forfeited.
- 2. There is not another game (playoff, previously scheduled or added) that needs to be called during the time slot of the forfeited game.
 - a. If another game (on any field) during the forfeited time slot has only one umpire, the umpire whose game was a forfeit will be required to join that game as a second umpire in lieu of forfeit pay.
 - b. The umpire filling in (in lieu of forfeit pay) will be paid as if their original game had not been a forfeit. (The original umpire will be paid at a single rate of pay.)
 - c. If there are no other games in need of an umpire, umpire will be paid forfeit pay.

ITEMS TO BE CONTAINED IN THE SIGNED AGREEMENT

Mobile County/West Mobile County Park reserves the right to disqualify any umpire of the awarded group who we feel does not meet our criteria for acceptability. This will <u>not</u> be based on judgment calls made during a play but instead will be based upon reliability, willingness to follow procedures and directives as proscribed by West Mobile County Park, soundness of character, and ability to maintain acceptable standards (taking prescribed tests/classes) as required by the Independent Umpire Organization who officiates Adult League Softball at West Mobile County Park.

The Independent Softball Association awarded the right to officiate League softball games shall be responsible for properly training and certifying all of their Umpires by means of clinics, test to insure that the highest reliable standards of officiating are met and maintained.
