This is an ALL or NONE Bid.

TYPE-1 BARRICADE STANDS

- I. BARRICADES SHALL CONFORM TO THE DESIGN REQUIREMENTS OF THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND NCHRP 350. (Fabricated from wood and fully assembled and ready for use.)
- II. BARRICADE SHALL BE 24" IN WIDTH.
- III. BARRICADE SHALL BE 36" IN HEIGHT TO TOP PANEL.
- IV. BARRICADE SHALL HAVE 12"H X 24" TOP PANELS WITH REFLECTIVE SHETING HAVING ALTERNATE 45
