1. GENERAL

This specification covers the requirements for a durable, fast dry 100% acrylic Waterborne type 11- adverse conditions- traffic paint coating as follows and conforming to federal specification TT-P-1952D.

2. CHARACTERISTICS

- i. Standard colors are white and yellow
- ii. Application with or without heat. (When heated, recommended temperatures are 100 120 degrees Fahrenheit).
- iii. Drying time 1 to 3 minutes at ambient temperatures above 50 degrees Fahrenheit.
- iv. Non Red Label (Non-Flammable).
