Mobile, AL – In response to the Governor declaring the statewide State of Emergency and the Mobile County Commission declaring a countywide State of Emergency and pursuant to CDC guidelines, Mobile County License Commissioner Nick Matranga has closed the lobbies of the Mobile County License Commission until further notice.

“We value customer service here at the License Commission, but public health needs to come first at this time,” said Commissioner Matranga. “We will continue to work hard behind the scenes to provide the best service possible without risking the transmission of Coronavirus,” Matranga continued.

The Commission will continue to perform its core functions by phone, email and online interface, including issuance of business licenses, registration of vehicles purchased from dealers in the State of Alabama, renewing vehicle registrations, and collecting sales taxes. The Alabama Department of Revenue has temporarily waived penalties for late registration of vehicles through April 15, 2020.
