

GULF COAST RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT (RC&D) COUNCIL
United States Code, House of Representatives, Public Law 87-703, September 27, 1962

Established:

The Food and Agriculture Act of 1962 established the Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D).

Purpose:

The purpose of the Gulf Coast (RC&D) is to accelerate the conservation, development and utilization of natural resources, improve the general level of economic activity, and to enhance the environment and standard of living.

Board Appointment:

Mobile County Commission as a whole appoints (1) council member and (1) member-at-large.

The newly appointed council member can select a proxy to serve in his/her place.

Term:

The term of office shall be two (2) years beginning on January 1st, for the council member, member-at-large and proxy.
