MOBILE BAY CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU (MBCVB)

Amended and Restated By-Laws, March 23, 2009

Established:

The City of Mobile created Board by Resolution 65-095 on September 6, 1988, and amended by Resolution 65-123, December 20, 1988.

Purpose:

To serve as a channel of communication between the City Council, Office of the Mayor, and City agencies involved in developing and promoting the convention center and enhancing tourism with the city. The Board will make recommendations to the City Council to enable the Council to be fully informed of the areas in which the council may more fully support efforts to develop Mobile into a major convention and tourist center.

Board Appointments:

The Mobile County Commission has up to three (3) members they shall appoint.

The selection of the member of the Board of Directors being appointed shall be initiated by soliciting nominations from the entire membership of the Mobile Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau.

The Nomination Committee shall interview and evaluate each nominee and recommend nominees to the Board of Directors for election to its membership.

No person shall be eligible to serve as a member of the Board of Directors unless they are a resident of the State of Alabama, have no criminal record and are not a current or former employee of the corporation.

Term:

Three (3) years.
