- A. The proposed work under this Permit Application must be in compliance with the **Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) Utility Manual recent edition**, and ALDOT Standard Specifications For Highway Construction, recent edition. Furthermore, the most stringent code will be honored, should there be any conflicts observed between the ALDOT specifications and County Engineering Utility Permit Checklist.
- B. Open cutting of paved County roads is prohibited except by special permission of the County Engineer.
- C. All signs, flagmen, safety equipment, and procedures required by the **Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Current Edition**, shall be provided, installed, and maintained during construction on the County Right-of-Way.
- D. All information provided in this application is true and accurate. The Applicant will install its facilities in accordance with plans and specifications of the Applicant as approved by Mobile County. These plans and specifications are hereby made part of this permit by reference.
- E. All proposed work as described and submitted in the permit documents must be complete within one (1) year from the approval date of the permit.
- F. The applicant will warrant its work for a period of one (1) year following the County's acceptance. The applicant is expressly responsible for the condition of pavement, shoulders, patches, and vegetation following patching, tunneling, boring, trenching, or excavation operations. (per ALDOT Utility Manual 6.1.2)
- G. Any future road project may require utility relocation at the owner's expense.
- H. A final stand of grass shall be present before the County will accept any project.
