The undersigned, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11-80-10 of the Code of Alabama (1975) and the regulations promulgated thereunder, hereby applies for renewal of a license for a junkyard which is located 1,000 feet of the nearest edge of the right-of-way of a highway or County maintained right-of-way and furnishes the following information to support this application:

12. Complete and enclose a copy of the Inspection Check List.
13. Complete and enclose the Junkyard Application/Reapplication Check List.

Junk Yard Application Check List

Please complete the following check list in order for your junkyard application to be processed. If items from this list are missing from your application package, it may result in a permit not being issued or reissued.

- Completed application form.
- Application fee of \$500.
- Map of the property showing dimensions. Please include name and location of any school, hospital or church within 400' of a property line.
- Copy of business license.
- (If new application) A commercial site plan to be submitted to County Engineers Office.
- Copy of ADEM NPDES permit.
- Copies of all DMRs submitted for the previous year. (Not applicable for first time applicants)
- Copy of stormwater management/BMP plan which must include the name and distance of nearest stream or river.
- Vector control Plan.
 - List of vectors that may be associated with the junkyard.
 - Description of the techniques that will be used to control these vectors.
 - Schedule of monitoring for these vectors.
 - List of chemicals to be used to control these vectors.
 - Copy of contract with the operator who will be performing the inspections and treatments or narrative of how the junkyard will be performing these functions.
 - A log of the dates, who made the application and what chemical was applied for preventative treatments for the previous 2 years to present.
- Completed site inspection check list.

Any false statements or misrepresentations made by the applicant on any application or renewal forms may cause the license fee forfeited and no license will be renewed or issued potentially causing additional action under the Junk Control Ordinance.
