Public Hearing - Amendments PY2017, PY2019 and PY2023 Action Plans

The purpose of this notice is to solicit citizens' comments and to give notice of a public hearing regarding the proposed amendments to the Mobile County Urban County PY2017, PY2019 and PY2023 Action Plans. The Public Hearing will be held prior to final adoption by the Mobile County Commission at the regular County Commission meeting to be held at 10:00 a.m. on August 14, 2023, in the auditorium, located on the ground floor of the Mobile Government Plaza, at 205 Government Street in Mobile, Alabama.

**Proposed amendments:**

1. Reallocate CDBG funds of \$46,970.97 (PY2017) and \$123,029.03 (PY2019) for a total of \$170,000 from the project Creola Street Improvements-Hurst Street to the East Elm Street Improvements-Utility Relocation project 2. Include HOME Program Income accumulated from around April 1, 2023 to June 30, 2023 to the PY2023 HOME budget for administration and development of rental housing.

A complete and detailed copy of the proposed amendment will remain on file at the offices of the Mobile County Commission and will be available for public examination and copying upon request at the Mobile County Government Plaza, 205 Government Street, Mobile, Alabama between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. The proposed amendment is also available on the County web page, [mobilecountyal.gov/grants/public-notificationshearings/](http://mobilecountyal.gov/grants/public-notificationshearings/) under Grants Department.

A 30-day public comment will commence beginning July 5, 2023 until August 4, 2023. Written comments are to be sent to Director of Grants Management, Mobile County Commission, 205 Government Street, Mobile, AL 36644.
