NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR
PY2024 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT

This notice provides a minimum of 15-days comment period for citizen participation regarding the Mobile Urban County PY2024 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) for the HUD programs, including CDBG-CV funds. The comment period begins December 26, 2025 and ends on January 10, 2026. A complete and detailed copy of the PY24 CAPER is available at the offices of the Mobile County Commission and will be available for public examination and copying upon request at the Mobile County Government Plaza, 205 Government Street, Mobile, Alabama between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. Citizen participation and comments are encouraged and will be accepted during the comment period. Comments or suggestions concerning the CAPER should be made in writing and sent to Mr. Edwin E. The Public Hearing will be held at the Mobile County Commission conference at 10:00 a.m. on January 8, 2026, in the Commission Conference Chamber, located on the ground floor of the Mobile Government Plaza, at 205 Government Street in Mobile, Alabama. The County Commission will consider adopting the CAPER at the Mobile County Commission meeting at 10:00 a.m. on January 12, 2026. The public hearing will be accessible to all.
